## 1. Overview

This guide covers the process of how to migrate Jet-Magento from 0.3.3 version to 0.3.4 version.

**Caution:** Before starting the migration there are some pre-requisites that the admin has to follow.

### Pre-requisites

*Here are some following pre-requisites:*

- Take proper backup of your old Magento database
- Disable cache
- Disable Compilation

## 2. New Features

*The following are the new features available in the 0.3.4. version:*

- Profile based product upload
- Easy Jet Attribute Mapping
- Easy Category Mapping
- Validating products before uploading them to jet
- Improved Inventory and Price Synchronization

## 3. Mapping Categories and Attributes Based on Profile

### 3.1. Mapping Variant Attributes and Identifier

Admin has to configure a few new settings.

#### *To map attributes and identifier*

1. Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
2. Open the **Configuration** page of the Jet-Magento Integration extension.
3. Click the **Minimum Jet Attribute Mapping to List Mapping on Jet.com** tab.  
The tab is expanded as shown in the following figure:

▲ Map Identifier with your magento attributes if already exist.

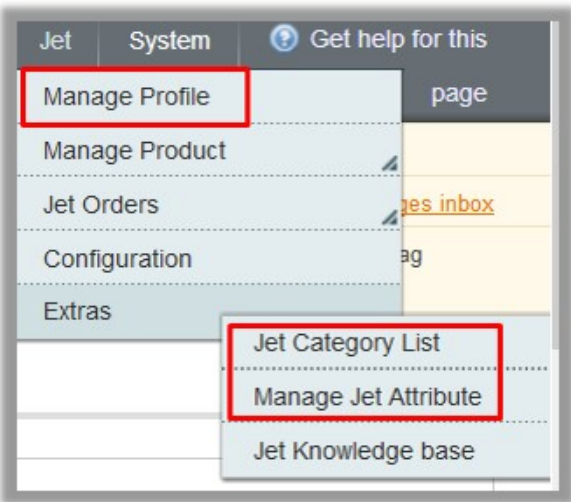
- In the **Variant Attribute** field, select the corresponding Jet Attribute from the list to map it with Magento Attribute.
- Under **Identifier Mapping**, select the corresponding existing Magento Attribute from the list to map it with Identifier.

### 3.2. Magento Jet Integration Menu

Here are some of the differences between the Magento Jet Integration Menu of 0.3.3 version and 0.3.4 version.

**Version 0.3.3**

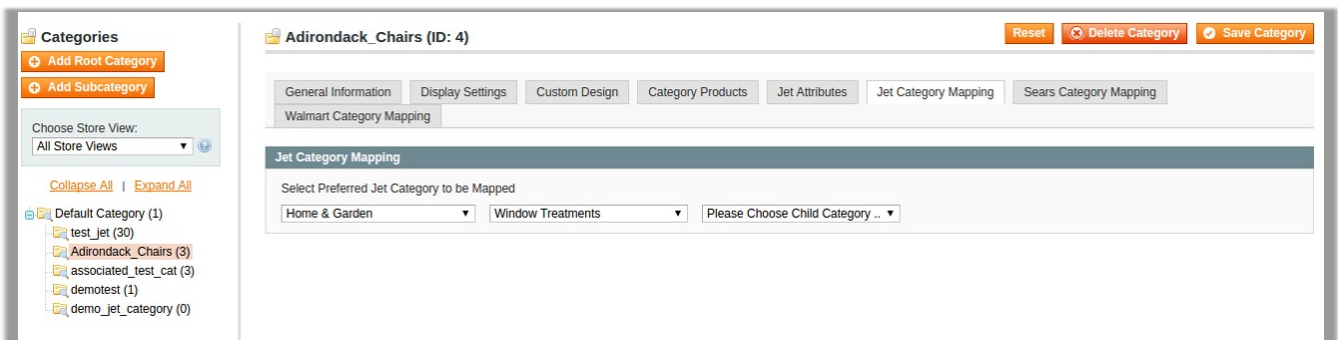
**Version 0.3.4**



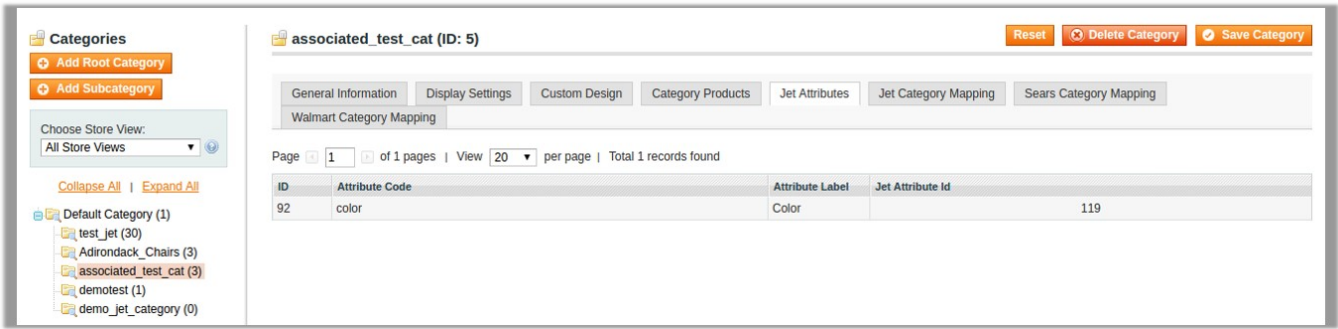
In the Version 0.3.4, the Jet Category List and Manage Jet Attribute menus are moved to the Extras menu as highlighted in the figure. A new menu, Manage Profile, is added on the Jet menu as highlighted in the figure.

#### Mapping Category in 0.3.3 version

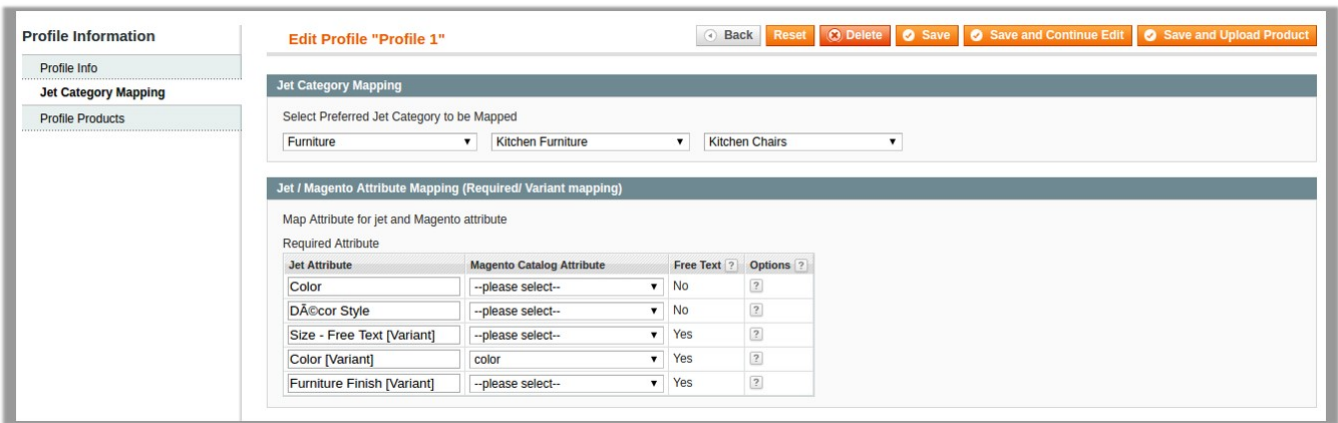


### Mapping Attribute in 0.3.3 version



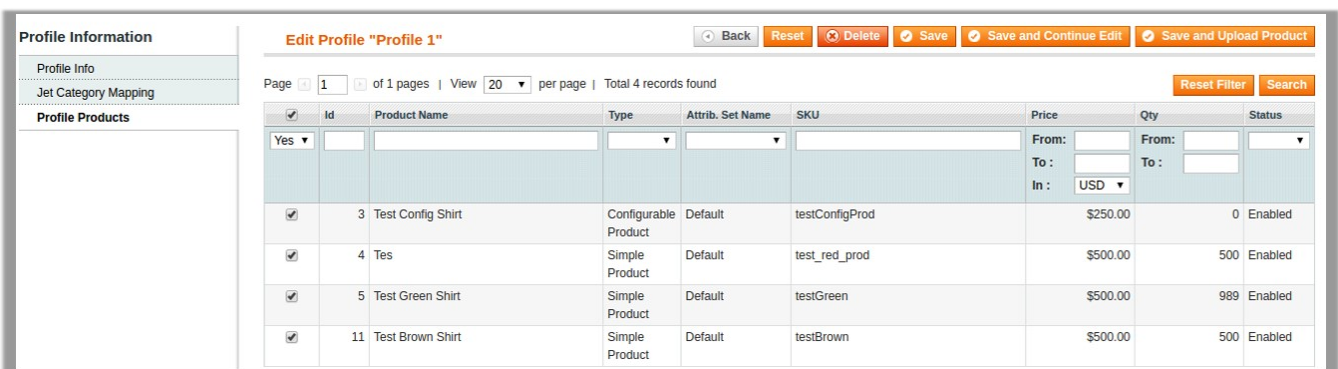
### Mapping Attributes and Categories in 0.3.4 version

Now, in the 0.3.4 version, admin can map the categories and the attributes on the profile level. The admin can perform both the tasks on the single page as shown in the following figure:



### Assigning Products to Profile and Uploading to Jet in 0.3.4 version

After mapping the category and attributes, the admin can assign the products to a specific profile on the profile page as shown in the following figure:



After assigning the products to the profile, admin can upload the products to jet.

**Note:** If the admin assigns the parent configurable product, then all the associated children products are auto

assigned to the profile.
