

Bonanza Integration-User Guide 0.0.1

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1. Overview

The **Bonanza Integration for Magento store** helps the Magento store owners to boost their business and generate the revenue as it interacts with Bonanza API's to connect the Magento store to Bonanza. It provides an opportunity to cover a wide range of customers.

Admin gets authority to create Bonanza Categories and the dependent attributes on the Magento store. It also enables the store owner to establish a mapping of the desired product category on the Magento store for automatic submission of the selected product to the same category on bonanza.com.

This extension interacts with the Bonanza Marketplace to integrate the synchronized product listing between Magento store and the bonanza.com retailers.

Synchronizing orders, products, pricing, and inventory is possible through establishing the communication between Bonanza APIs and the Magento store.

It enables the admin to manage the Bonanza orders on the seller's Magento stores without making any significant changes to operational functionalities.


Key Features are as follows:

- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Admin can map many categories of the Magento store to the single category of Bonanza.
- **Bulk Upload System:** The merchant has the flexibility to upload any number of products on bonanza.com using bulk product upload feature.
- **Low Stock Notifications:** Whenever Stock diminishes lower than threshold, notification is sent informing the status
- **New Order Notifications:** Whenever a new order is fetched from the Bonanza website, the admin receives a notification.
- **Rejected Products Notification:** If any invalid product is rejected by bonanza.com, then its information is fetched from the automatically synchronized requests along with the error due to which it is rejected.
- **Update Products Status:** Enables the Store owner to track the product status on the Bonanza website and know whether the products are live or in a pending status.
- **Synchronized Inventory:** Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and the listing of the products along with all the details are established between Magento store and bonanza.com.
- **Shipment Automation:** Merchant can enter shipping carrier, shipping method, and the tracking number to send shipment or can automate the shipment process with Shipstation, Shipworks, Stamps.com, Linnworks.
- **Creation of Magento store Orders:** The newly placed orders on Bonanza.com are automatically created in the Magento store with all the required details as it is on Bonanza.com.

2. Bonanza Integration Extension Installation for Magento store

To install the extension

1. Go to the **Magento Store Admin** panel.
2. On the top navigation bar, move the cursor over the **System** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Point to the **Magento Connect** menu, and then click **Magento Connect Manager**.

4. Scroll down to the **Ced_Bonanza** Package.
5. In the **Actions** column, select the **Install** option from the list.
6. Click the **Commit Changes** button.
Auto-scroll console contents screen appears and the extension is installed after the process.

3. Retrieve API Credentials from the Bonanza Seller Account

Once the extension is successfully installed in the Magento store, the **Bonanza** menu appears on the top navigation bar of the Admin Panel. The store owner has to fill out the retrieved the **Bonanza DEVELOPER ID** and **BONAPITIT CERTIFICATE ID** details in the respective fields displayed on the **Bonanza Configuration** page of the admin panel.


To retrieve the API credentials from the Bonanza Seller Account

1. Go to the [http://www.bonanza.com/\(http://www.bonanza.com/\)](http://www.bonanza.com/(http://www.bonanza.com/)) link.

The login page appears as shown in the following figure:


- Enter the login credentials to log into the Bonanza seller account.


- Copy the **DEVELOPER ID** and the **BONAPITIT CERTIFICATE ID** values.
- Save the corresponding values in some text editor or the in Word file to use it later on while setting up the configuration in the Magento store admin panel.

4. Bonanza Configuration Settings

After obtaining the **API Key** values from the Bonanza Seller account, the Magento store owner has to paste it in the respective field displayed on the **Bonanza Configuration** page of the admin panel.

To set up the configuration settings in the Magento Store Admin panel

- Go to the **Magento Store Admin** panel.
- On the top navigation bar, point to the **Bonanza** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




- Click the **Bonanza Configuration** menu.

4. Under **Bonanza Configuration**, click the **Bonanza Setting** tab.

The tab is expanded and the relevant fields appear under the section as shown in the following figure:



5. Under **Bonanza Setting**, do the following steps:

- In the **Enabled** list, select the **Yes** option to enable the extension features.
- In the **Developer Id** box, enter the corresponding value copied from the Bonanza Seller account.
- In the **Certification Id** box, enter the corresponding value copied from the Bonanza Seller account.
- Click the **Get Token** button to create the token and complete the synchronization process.
- Click the **Verify Token** button to verify the token and complete the synchronization process.
The verified token value appears in the **Verified Token** box.

f. In the **Select Store** list, select the single store.

6. Scroll down to the **Product Data Mapping** tab, and click the tab.

The tab is expanded and the expanded section appears as shown in the following figure:

7. Under **Product Data Mapping**, do the following steps:

- a. In the In the **Product Title** list, select the required attribute.
Note: Select the Text-Type attribute. Limitation on the attribute value is 5 to 500 characters.
- b. In the product **Description** list, select the required attribute.
Note: Select the Text-Type attribute. Limitation on the attribute value is 1 to 2000 characters.
- c. In the **Free Shipping** list, select the **Yes** option to enable the free shipping or the **No** option to disable the free shipping.
- d. In the **Product Price** list, select the required option to set a different price for all the products.

A user can set the price on the following basis:

- **Increase by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Enter Amount field appears.
 - **Increase by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Enter Percentage field appears.
Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the **Bonanza** product price by the entered value % of Magento price
For Example, Magento price + 5% of Magento price.
Magento Price = 100
Select **Increase By Fixed Percentage** option
Enter Percentage = 5
 $100 + 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 + 5 = 105$
Thus, Bonanza Product Price = 105
 - **Decrease by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the **Enter Amount** field appears.
 - **Decrease by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Enter Percentage field appears.
Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Bonanza product price by the entered value % of Magento price
For Example, Magento price – 5% of Magento price.
Magento Price = 100
Select **Decrease By Fixed Percentage** option
Enter Percentage = 5
 $100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$
Thus, Bonanza Product Price = 95
5. In the **Manufacturer part number** list, select the required attribute.
Note: Select the Text-Type or the Select-Type attribute. Part number provided by the original manufacturer.
 6. In the country **Of Manufacture** list, select the required attribute.
Note: Select the Text-Type or the Select-Type attribute.
 7. Move to the **Item Specifics** area.

8. In the **Item Specifics** area, do the following steps:
 - i. Under **Magento Attribute Code**, select the required attribute codes.
 - ii. Click the **Add Attributes** button to add more attributes.
8. Click the **Save Config**
The configuration settings are saved.

5. Manage Bonanza Categories

The user has to Map the Bonanza Category to the Magento Store Category to upload products on Bonanza admin panel.

The admin can perform the following tasks:



5.1. Map the Bonanza Categories

To map the Bonanza categories to the Magento Store categories


1. Go to the **Magento Store Admin** panel.

A menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click **Category Mapping**.





The selected categories and the sub-categories are saved and the success message appears as shown in the following figure:





3. Click **Bonanza Products**.






6.2. Submit Bulk Action on the Selected Products

The user can submit the following actions on the selected product:

- **Product Upload on Bonanza:** To upload the selected product on the Bonanza Website.
- **Delete Bonanza Product:** To remove the selected product from the Bonanza Website.
- **Bonanza Product Sync:** Synchronize the selected products with the Magento store and get the request from Bonanza to update the status of the products in the Magento store.

To submit the Bulk action on the selected products

1. Go to the **Magento Store Admin** panel.
2. On the top navigation bar, move the cursor over the **Bonanza** menu.
A menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click **Bonanza Products**.






- c. Click **Delete Bonanza Product**, and then click the **Submit** button.



7. Manage Orders

The admin can manage the bonanza.com orders and can perform the following tasks:



: On this page, the store owners can view all the failed orders details. They can also delete the failed orders based on requirement.

7.1. Bonanza Orders Listing

The user can fetch and view all the order details fetched from Bonanza. Admin can acknowledge or reject the orders fetched from Bonanza. Later on, the admin can proceed further for shipment.

To view, acknowledge, or reject the Bonanza Orders


1. Go to the **Magento Store Admin** panel.



4. To fetch the new orders from Bonanza, click the **Fetch Bonanza Orders**
If the order is imported successfully, then the new fetched orders appear in the **Bonanza Order Listing** table.
5. To acknowledge the selected fetched orders, do the following steps:
 - a. Select the check boxes associated with the required orders.
 - b. Click the **Arrow** button or anywhere in the **Actions**
A menu appears as shown in the following figure:



- c. Click the **Acknowledge** option, and then click the **Submit**
The selected orders are acknowledged and a success message appears on the page.
6. To reject the selected fetched orders, do the following steps:
 - a. Select the check boxes associated with the required orders.
 - b. Click the **Arrow** button or anywhere in the **Actions**

7.2. Bonanza Failed Orders Listing

The users can view the list of failed Bonanza orders on the Bonanza Failed Order Listing page.


Orders cannot be imported from Bonanza due to the following conditions:

- If any product in the Bonanza Order is Out of Stock in Magento Store.
- If any product in the Bonanza Order is disabled in Magento Store.
- If any Product does not exist in Magento Store or is deleted from Magneto after uploading on Bonanza.
- If the selected Payment Method in Bonanza System Configuration Setting is not available in Magento Store.

To view or delete the failed orders

1. Go to the **Magento Store Admin** panel.
2. On the top navigation bar, move the cursor over the **Bonanza** menu, and then point to the **Bonanza Orders**

A menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click **Bonanza Failed Orders**.


