
	Overstock Integration for Magento Guide 0.0.1
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1. Overview

Overstock was founded in 1997 and launched in May 1999. Overstock.com initially sold exclusively surplus and returned merchandise on an online e-commerce marketplace, liquidating the inventories of at least 18 failed Dotcom companies at below-wholesale prices.

Overstock.com deals in home decor, furniture, bedding, and many other goods that are closeout merchandis and also new merchandise. For online store owners, Overstock.com is the ultimate place because of its customer-pleasing feature as 'bargain hunter's delight'. Hence, attracting a unique demographic in the online sales arena.



CedCommerce Overstock Integration for Magento extension interacts with the Overstock Marketplace to integrate the synchronized product listing between Magento and the overstock.com retailers. It enables the admin to manage the Overstock orders on the vendor's Magento stores without making any significant changes to operational functionalities.

Merchant can create Overstock Categories and its dependent attributes on the Magento store. The process enables the merchant to configure the desired product category in the Magento store for automatic submission of the selected product to the same Category on overstock.com. Synchronizing orders, products, pricing, and inventory is possible through establishing the communication between Overstock APIs and the Overstock Integration for Magento extension.

Key Features are as follows:

Creation of Magento Orders: The newly placed orders on overstock.com are automatically created in the Magento store with all the required details as it is on overstock.com.

Profile based product upload: Admin can create a profile and map the overstock category and attributes to the respective Magento category and attributes. After categories and attributes mapping, admin can very easily assign the products to the profile and upload products to the overstock website.

Synchronized Inventory: Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and the listing of the products along with all the details is established between Magento and overstock.com.

Synchronized Pricing: Real time synchronization of Price for every product between Magento store and the Overstock marketplace.

Simple and Configurable Products Upload Admin can upload the Simple and Configurable types of Magento product on overstock.com. The configurable product in Magento is treated as the Variation product on overstock.com.

Bulk Upload System: The merchant has the flexibility to upload any number of products on overstock.com using bulk product upload feature.

Automate Shipment: Automate the shipment process with Shipstation, Shipwork, Stamps.com, Linnworks, Xtento, Shiprush.

New Order Notifications: Whenever a new order is fetched from the *ca* website, the admin receives a notification.

Rejected Products Notification: If any product containing some invalid details is rejected by overstock.com, then its information is fetched from the automatic synchronized requests along with the error due to which it is rejected.

Low Stock Notifications: Whenever Stock diminishes lower than threshold, notification is sent informing the status.

Crons: Cron job automates the process for Inventory, Price and Order management.

• Easy Debug: Easy debug process for hassle free products upload on the Overstock website.

Caution: Extension is heavily dependent on Crons for running various automated processes. So, make sure that Cron Job is properly configured and working on the server.

2. Overstock Integration Extension Installation

To install the extension

- 1. Log in the ftp, and then go to Magento root folder (generally present under the public_html folder).
- 2. Overwrite the app, skin, is and var folders in the same sequence as illustrated in the following steps:
 - a. Drag and Drop the app/code, app/design, js, skin and var directories.
 - b. Finally, upload the *app/etc* directory.

 After the folders are loaded successfully, the extension is installed or upgraded.


3. Create Seller Account on Overstock.com

The admin has to create a seller account on the seller panel of the Overstock marketplace before starting the process of integration. The created username and password are used while setting up the configuration settings.

To create a seller account

 Go to the https://www.supplieroasis.com/Pages/UserRegistration.aspx (https://www.supplieroasis.com/Pages/UserRegistration.aspx) link.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:



- 2. Enter the values in the Username, password, and other required fields.
- 3. Click the **Create** button.

 The account is created. After account creation, the account needs approval for further use.

4. Configuration Settings

Once the extension is successfully installed on the Merchant's store, the Overstock tab appears in the Magento Admin Panel.

The admin has to set up the configuration settings for establishing the connection between the Magento store and the overstock marketplace.


To set up the configuration settings in the Magento Admin panel

- 1. Go to the **Admin** panel.
- 2. On the top navigation bar, click the **Overstock** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click Configuration.


The **Overstock Configuration** page appears as shown in the following figure:



- 4. Under Api Overstock Settings, do the following steps:
 - a. In the Enabled list, select Yes.
 - Note: The No option disables the Overstock Integration extension.
 - b. In the **Select Store** list, select the required store.
 - c. In the Orders Fetch Start Date box, click the Calendar icon to select the required date.
 - d. In the **Environment** list, select **Sandbox** or **Production** as per the requirement.


 Note: Sandbox environment is used for the testing purpose; Production is to make it live.
 - e. In the **Overstock Username** box, enter the Overstock Seller Account username.
 - f. In the Overstock Password box, enter the Overstock Seller Account password.
 - g. In the Store Admin Email Id box, enter the email id.
 - h. In the Overstock Debug Mode list, select Yes to enable Overstock Debug Mode for logging.
 - i. In the Overstock Customet Email box, enter the email id for which the customer is created for Overstock orders.
 - j. In the **Choose Default Payment Method for Overstock Orders** list, select the required payment method.
- 5. Click the Overstock Product Global Settings tab.

The Overstock Product Global Settings tab is expanded as shown in the following figure:



- 6. Under Overstock Product Global Settings, select the appropriate option in the corresponding fields:
 - Auto Sync With Overstock: Enables or disables the automatic Cron syncing of all products.
 - **Update Price**: Enables or disables the price update of the product whenever the product is edited or synched from admin panel.
 - **Update Inventory:** Enables or disables the inventory update of the product whenever the product is edited or synched from admin panel.
 - **Update Other Details**: Enables or disables the other details of the product including images, description, and so on whenever the product is edited or synhced from admin panel.
 - **Select Store**: Select only single store.
 - Update Inventory on Overstock on Product Save After: Enables or disables the inventory update of the product on saving the product.
- 7. Click Overstock Product Advanced Price Settings tab.

The Overstock Product Advanced Price Settings tab is expanded as shown in the following figure:



- 8. Under Overstock Product Advanced Price Settings, enter the values in the corresponding fields.
 - Overstock Product Price: This is to set a different price for all the products as shown in the following figure:

User can set the price on the following basis: -

- Increase by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Enter Amount field appears.
- Increase by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Enter Percentage field appears. Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the the Overstock product price by the

entered value % of Magento price

For Example: Magento price + 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100

Select Increase By Fixed Percentage option

Enter Percentage = 5

100 + 5% of 100 = 100 + 5 = 105

Thus, Overstock Product Price = 105

- Decrease by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Enter Amount field appears.
- Decrease by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Enter Percentage field appears.
 Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the the Overstock product price by the entered value % of Magento price

For Example: Magento price – 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100

Select Decrease By Fixed Percentage option

Enter Percentage = 5

100 - 5% of 100 = 100 - 5 = 95

Thus, Overstock Product Price = 95

9. Click the **Cron Settings** tab.

The **Cron Settings** tab is expanded as shown in the following figure:



- 10. Under Cron Settings, do the following steps as per the requirement:
 - a. In the Enable Product Price Update list, select Yes to enable the product price update cron.
 - b. In the **Enable Product Inventory Update Cron** list, select **Yes** to enable product inventory update
 - c. In the **Enable Order Cron** list, select **Yes** to enable order cron.
- 11. Click the Overstock Inventory Rules tab.


The Overstock Inventory Rules tab is expanded as shown in the following figure:



- 12. Under Overstock Inventory Rules tab, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Send Inventory on the Basis of Threshold** list, select **Yes** to send the inventory based on threshold.

Note: Only when the admin selects Yes, the other fields appear.

The section appears as shown in the following figure:



Note: Inventory Threshold Value is the minimum quantity of the inventory that the admin wants to have in hand.

- b. In the **Inventory Threshold Value** box, enter the required value.
- c. In the Send Inventory for Lesser Than Threshold Case box, enter the required value.
- d. In the Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case box, enter the required value.
- 13. Click the **Save Config** button.

5. Manage Overstock Profiles

Admin can create a new profile and assign the required products to the profile. While creating and editing the profile, admin can map the Magento attributes to the Overstock attributes. These attributes are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

5.1. Add New Profile

To add a new profile

- 1. Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- 2. On the top navigation bar, click the Overstock menu.

The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click the Manage Overstock Profiles menu.

The **Overstock Profile Listing** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Click the Add New Profile button.



- 5. In the right panel, under **Profile Information**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Profile Code** box, enter a profile code.
 - *Note:* It is only for the internal use. Use the unique profile code with no spaces. Start with small letters
 - b. In the **Profile Name** box, enter the name of the profile.
 - Note: Use the unique name to identify the profile.
 - c. In the **Status** list, select **Active** to enable the profile.
 - **Note:** The **Inactive** option disables the profile.
- 6. Click the **Save and Continue** button.

7. In the left navigation panel, click the **Profile Configurations** menu.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:



- 8. In the right panel, under Overstock Product Global Settings, do the following steps:
 - a. In the Select Store list, select the single store.
 - b. In the **Update Inventory on Overstock on Product Save After** list, select **Yes** to enable the inventory update of the product on saving the product.
- In the right panel, under Overstock Product Advanced Price Settings, enter the values in the corresponding fields.
 - Overstock Product Price: This is to set a different price for all the products as shown in the following figure:

User can set the price on the following basis: -

- Increase by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Enter Amount field appears.
- Increase by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Enter Percentage field appears.



Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the the Overstock product price by the entered value % of Magento price

For Example: Magento price + 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100

Select Increase By Fixed Percentage option

Enter Percentage = 5

100 + 5% of 100 = 100 + 5 = 105

Thus, Overstock Product Price = 105

- Decrease by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Enter Amount field appears.
- Decrease by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Enter Percentage field appears.
 Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the the Overstock product price by the entered value % of Magento price

For Example: Magento price – 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100


Select Decrease By Fixed Percentage option

Enter Percentage = 5 100 - 5% of 100 = 100 - 5 = 95Thus, Overstock Product Price = 95

- 10. In the right panel, under Overstock Inventory Rules, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Send Inventory on the Basis of Threshold** list, select **Yes** to send the inventory based on threshold.

Note: Only when the admin selects Yes, the other fields appear.


The section appears as shown in the following figure:



Note: Inventory Threshold Value is the minimum quantity of the inventory that the admin wants to have in hand.

- b. In the Inventory Threshold Value box, enter the required value.
- c. In the Send Inventory for Lesser Than Threshold Case box, enter the required value.
- d. In the Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case box, enter the required value.
- 11. Click the Save and Continue button.
- 12. In the left navigation panel, click the **Overstock Category Mapping** menu.




- 13. In the right panel, under Overstock Category Mapping, do the following steps:
 - o In the category list, select the preferred Overstock category that the admin wants to map.
- 14. In the right panel, under **Overstock / Magento Attribute Mapping (Required/Optional mapping)**, do the following steps:
 - In the **Magento Catalog Attribute** column, select the required Magento attribute to map it with the corresponding Overstock attribute.
 - b. Repeat the mapping of all the required or optional Magento attributes listed with the corresponding Overstock attributes.
 - c. Click the Add Attribute button to add more attributes.

15. In the right panel, under **Overstock / Magento Attribute Mapping (Additional Attribute Mapping)**, do the following steps:

Note: Map configurable attributes to magento atribute.




- a. In the **Magento Catalog Attribute** list, select the required Magento attribute to map it with the corresponding Overstock attribute.
- b. In the **Default Value** list, select the required option.
 Note: In the **Action** column, click the button if the admin wants to delete the corresponding attribute.
- 16. Click the Save and Continue button.
- 17. In the left navigation panel, click the **Profile Products** menu. The page appears as shown in the following figure:



Since no products as assigned to the profile, there are no products listed in the table.

18. Click the Reset Filter button.

All the products are listed in the table as shown in the following figure:




19. Select the check box associated with the required product that the admin wants to assign to the new profile.

The created profile is saved and listed on the Overstock Profile Listing page.

















5.5. Product Manager

On this page, admin can view, edit, and upload the individual product. Also, the admin can view the error message if any error exist in any product details. The admin can also submit certain actions on the selected products available on the **Product Manager** page.

Thus, on the Product Manager page, the user can perform the following three tasks:

- Upload Single Product: The user can upload the products that are listed on the Product Manager page, to the Overstock website.
- View the Error Log: If the product is invalid, then an Invalid button appears, and the admin can view the error log using the Invalid button.
- *Edit Product Information*: Edit the information of the product that the user wants to upload on the Overstock website.
- **Submit Actions**: The user can submit the respective action on the selected product before uploading it to the Overstock website.

To upload single product

- 1. Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- 2. On the top navigation bar, click the **Overstock** menu.

The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click the Manage Overstock Profiles menu.



- 4. Scroll down to the required profile.
- 5. In the **Action** column, click the **Arrow** button, and then click **Upload Products**.

- 6. Scroll down to the required product.
- 7. In the Upload column, click the Upload link.

If the product is uploaded successfully, then the success message appears on the top of the page. If there is an error, then the error message appears on the top of the page.

To View the error log

- 1. Go to the **Product Manager** page.
- 2. Scroll down to the required product.
- In the Validation column, click the INVALID button.
 The relevant error message appears as shown in the figure.



4. Click the Validate link that appears below the Invalid button.
If the product is validated, then a success message appears on the top of the Product Manager page and the Invalid button is changed to the Valid button. Otherwise an error message appears on the top of the Product Manager page as shown in the following figure:




To edit the product information

- 1. Go to the **Product Manager** page.
- 2. Scroll down to the required product.
- 3. In the **Edit** column, click the **Edit** link.

The **Product Information** page appears as shown in the following figure:




4. In the left navigation panel, click the **Overstock** menu. The page appears as shown in the following figure:



5. Make the changes as per the requirement, and then click the **Save** button.

Actions on the Product Manager page



The user can submit the following actions on the selected product:

- Validate Selected Product: Validates the product before uploading it to the Overstock website. It displays the corresponding validation error, if any. If there is no error, it confirms that the product is ready to upload.
- **Product Inventory Update**: Updates the inventory of the product on Overstock. This action completes all the job related to the product inventory and also it manages the quantity related issues.
- Retire Selected Product(s): To withdraw the selected product so that it is neither used nor ordered. On submitting this action, the product is not listed on Overstock is retired. Thus, nobody can order them from Overstock.
- Mass Product(s) Upload: Uploads all the validated products on Overstock at one time in a bulk. It means, the user can upload all the validated products on one click.
- Sync Overstock Product Status: To get the request from Overstock to update the status of the product on the Magento store. It helps the user to view the status of the product. For example, unpublished, transmit, data fix, system error, or so on.

To Submit an Action

Go to Product Manager page.
 The Product Manager page appears as shown in the following figure:




- 2. Select the check box associated with the required product.
- 3. In the **Action** list, select the required action.
- 4. Click the Submit button.

6. Manage Product Feeds


After uploading the product on Overstock or after updating the product inventory, the user can check the products feed details on the **Overstock Feed Details** page.

To view product feeds details

- 1. Go to Magento Admin Panel.
- 2. On the Overstock menu, point to Manage Product, and then click Product Feeds.



The selected feeds are deleted.

5. To export all the feeds through CSV, click the **Export** button.

7.1. View Overstock Orders

The user can fetch and view all the order details fetched from Overstock. Also, later on can proceed further for shipment.

To view Overstock Orders

- 1. Go to Magento Admin panel.
- 2. Click the **Overstock** menu, and then click **Overstock Orders**. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click View Overstock Orders.

The Overstock Orders Details page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Click the Fetch Latest Overstock Orders button.

If the order is imported successfully, then a new record is found in the **Overstock Order Details** table as shown in the above figure.

Notes:


- Orders are automatically imported through CRON in every 10 minutes.
- Whenever the latest orders are imported from Overstock, a Notification appears in the notification area of the Admin panel for those orders and they are Auto-Acknowledged as soon as they are imported in the Magento admin panel.
- If no Order is imported, then check the Failed order log on the Failed Overstock Orders Import Log
- Order are auto rejected on Overstock in the following conditions:
 - When Overstock Product SKU does not exist in Magento.
 - When Product is Out of Stock in Magento.
 - When product is disabled in Magento.

To submit the shipment for the selected order

- 1. Go to Magento Admin panel.
- 2. On the **Overstock** menu, point to **Overstock Orders**, and then click **View Overstock Orders**. The **Overstock Orders Details** page appears as shown in the following figure:



- 3. In the Magento Order# column, click the link associated with the required order.
- The page appears as shown in the following figure:
- 4. In the left navigation menu, click **Ship By Overstock**. The page appears as shown in the following figure:



Note: Orders imported from Overstock uses Payment Method depending on the System Configuration Settings of Overstock extension.

- 5. Under **Shipment Info**, enter the corresponding values in the following fields:
 - a. In the **Shipping carrier used** list, select the required option.
 - b. In the Service Level Code list, select the required option.
 - c. In the Tracking Number box, enter the tracking number of the package
 - d. In the **Ship Date** box, enter the date of shippment.
- 6. Under **Shipment Items**, enter the corresponding values in the following fields:
 - a. In the Quantity to Ship box, enter a value.
 The number of quantity that the user can ship. The value cannot be greater than the Qty Available for Ship value.
 - b. In the Quantity to Cancel box, enter a value.
 The number of quantity that the user wants to reject. The value cannot be greater than the Qty Available for Ship value. The success message appears, if the order is shipped successfully.
- 7. Click the **Submit Shipment** button.

Notes:

- a. Order **Shipment** is sent to Overstock.
- b. Order **Invoice** and **Shipment** is created automatically in Magento.
- c. Order Status changes to Complete on Overstock.
- d. The **status** of order changes to **Completed** on Magento.

7.2. View Overstock Failed Orders

The users can view the list of failed Overstock orders on the Failed Overstock Orders Import Log page.


Note: To clear all the failed import order logs at once, click the Clear Failed Import Order Logs button.

Orders are not imported from Sears due to the following conditions:

- If any product in the Overstock Order is Out of Stock in Magento.
- If any product in the Overstock Order is disabled in Magento.
- If any Product does not exist in Magento or is deleted from Magneto after uploading on Overstock.
- If the selected Payment Method in Overstock System Configuration Setting is not available in Magento.

To view Overstock failed orders

- 1. Go to Magento Admin Panel.
- 2. On the **Overstock** menu, point to **Overstock Orders**, and then click **View Overstock Failed Orders**. The **Failed Overstock Orders Import Log** page appears as shown in the following figure:



This page displays the failed orders with the order id and the reason for the failure.










