

# **Shopify Integration for Magento - User Manual**

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## 1. Overview

To make your selling experience more lucrative and comprehensive, CedCommerce presents to you the Shopify Integration for Magento. With this innovative extension, now the sellers can feature and sell their products from Magento store to Shopify store. Once the products get exported to the Shopify store, the products can be sold from their and all the necessary actions can be taken for the products.

### Key Features of the Extension:


- It Auto Synchronizes your order and provides you the coherence in your work.
- Due to the Automated Order Acknowledgement functionality, you can always hit the order without any failure.
- Auto Synchronization of the Order Management periodically – at fixed times, dates, or intervals.
- You can easily ship your order from one place.
- Crons help you to automate and synchronize your orders and shipments at a certain interval of time.

## 2. Getting the API Details


For the configuration to be completed, you need the API details which you need while doing the configuration.

### To get the API details,


- Go to your Shopify admin panel which looks as shown in the image below:




- Click on Apps which is highlighted in the above image. You will be navigated to a page as shown below:




- Scroll down and you will see **Manage Private Apps** option as shown in the above image in red box. Click it and you will be taken to page which appears as:




- Click on **Create a new private app** as shown in the above image.
- On clicking it, you will be navigated to a page as:




- Now enter your private app name, as you want its name to be.
- Enter the contact email which is optional. Once details have been entered, select the access options in next section, as shown in the red boxes in the image below.




- Now click on **Save** button as shown in the image below:



- On saving it, the message appears on the same page, as shown in the image below:



- Now on this page, you may get the API details as:



- You may copy them by keeping them open in a separate tab and paste in the corresponding fields in the API settings under configuration.


### 3. Configuration Settings

Once the Extension of Shopify Integration for Magento is installed, the configuration needs to be done in order to

proceed further.

**To do the Configuration,**

- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- On the top navigation bar, you can see Shopify which appears after the extension’s installation.
- Place the cursor on it and the menu appears as:




- Click **Configuration** from the menu and you will be navigated to the configuration page as shown below:



**API Settings**

- Click on API Settings and the section will expand as shown below:



- In **Enabled**, select Yes to **enable** the extension. On enabling it, the section further expands and appears as:

- In **Mode**, select between Private App or CedCommerce.
- In **Shopify Domain**, enter your Shopify Domain as has been shown in the example in image above.
- In the **API Key**, enter the API Key which you may get from your Shopify admin panel.
- In the **API Password**, enter the API Password which you may get from your Shopify admin panel.
- In the **Shared Key**, enter the Shared Key which you may get from your Shopify admin panel.
- Now click **Validate API** button for API Validation. A message would appear as shown below:

- In **Choose default payment method for Shopify order**, select the payment method for the orders placed for your products on Shopify.
- In **Magento store admin email**, enter the email id on which you want notifications to be sent when a new Shopify order is imported.
- In **Enable automated shipment**, select **Yes** if you want automated shipment to be processed which is supported for ShipStation and ShipWorks. If you don't want automated shipment to be enabled, select **No**.

- Click Product Settings and the section expands as:


- In **Select Store**, select the store from which you want data to be sent to Shopify.
- In **Profiling**, select **Yes** if you want Profile-based product upload to be enabled. If you do not want it, select **No**.

- Click Product Price Settings and the section will be expanded as:


- In **Shopify Product Price**, you have the following options for price that you want to be sent to Shopify for your products.




- Select **Default Magento Price** if you don't want any difference in the price of your Magento products on Shopify.
- **Increase By Fixed Price:** By selecting it, you may increase the price of your Magento products on Shopify. On selecting it, a box appears as:



- Suppose in the box, you enter 50. Now if your product is for \$100 on Magento, it will be available on Shopify for \$150 as you have increased the product price by 50, by entering 50 in the corresponding box.
- **Increase By Fixed Percentage:** By selecting it, you may increase your Magento product's price on Shopify by a certain percentage. On selecting it, a box appears as:



- Suppose in the box, you enter 50. Now if your product is for \$100 on Magento, it will be available on Shopify for \$150 as you have increased the product price by 50%, by entering 50 in the corresponding box. Since 50% of 100 is 50, 50 will be added to 100.
- **Decrease By Fixed Price:** By selecting it, you may increase your Magento product's price on Shopify by a certain percentage. On selecting it, a box appears as:



- Suppose in the box, you enter 50. Now if your product is for \$100 on Magento, it will be available on Shopify for \$50 as you have decreased the product price by 50, by entering 50 in the corresponding box.
- **Decrease By Fixed Percentage:** By selecting it, you may decrease your Magento product's price on Shopify by a certain percentage.
- Suppose in the box, you enter 50. Now if your product is for \$100 on Magento, it will be available on Shopify for \$50 as you have decreased the product price by 50%, by entering 50 in the corresponding box. Since 50% of 100 is 50, 50 will be deducted from 100.
- **Select individually for each product:** You may set the price for products individually as well by selecting

this option. On selecting it, the box appears as:

- In order cron, enter the time in minutes after which the order cron will run, periodically.
- In **Enable Inventory Cron**, select **Yes** if you want to enable the cron for orders to run, and the box will appear as:

- In **All Product Inventory Sync**, enter the time in minutes after which the all product inventory sync cron will run, periodically.
- In **Enable Price Cron**, select **Yes** if you want to enable the cron and the box will appear as:

- In **Product Price Update Cron**, enter the time in minutes after which the product price cron will run, periodically.
- In **Enable Feed Sync**, select **Yes** if you want to enable the feed syncing and the box will appear as:

- In **Feed Sync Cron**, enter the time in minutes after which the feed syncing cron will run, periodically.

- In **Debug Mode**, select **Yes** if you want to enable the Shopify debug mode for logging. Otherwise, select **No**.

- In **Product Upload Chunk Size**, enter the quantity of products that you want to be sent to Shopify in one batch.
- In **Product Inventory Chunk Size**, enter the number of inventory of products that you want to be sent to Shopify in one batch.
- In **Product Price Chunk Size**, enter the number of product price that you want to be sent to Shopify in one batch.
- In **Category Sync Chunk Size**, enter the number of categories that you want to be sent to Shopify in one batch.


Once you have completed the steps mentioned above, under all the sections, click on **Save Config** button. All your configuration will saved.

## 4. Manage Products

While integratiing Magento store with Shopify, the management of products can be done easily in some simple steps as will be shown in this section.

**To take actions for the products,**

- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- Put the cursor on the top navigation bar on Shopify. The menu appears as:



- Click Manage Products. You will be navigated to a page as:




### To See the Validation and Upload Errors

- Click on the status that appears under **Validation** column, adjacent to the product. The status appears as:




### To Edit a Product

- On the Product Listing page, click on the **edit sign** as shown in the image below in the red color box, adjacent to the product, in the last column.




- On clicking it, you will be navigated to the page as shown below:




- On this page, you may edit the product details under different sections from the left panel.

- Click on the **Validate** button in the last column adjacent to the product that you want to validate, as shown in the figure below:




- The product will be validated and a message will appear as shown in the image below:




### To Upload a Single Product

- To upload a single product, click on upload sign as shown in the image below, adjacent to the product in the last column:




- The product will be uploaded and a message will appear on the screen as:




### To Upload Products in Bulk

- To upload multiple products, select the products and from **Actions** on the top of page, select the option of **Upload Product(s)**.




- Click **Submit** button next to it. You will be navigated to page with product sync status, as shown below:




- The product gets uploaded.

- Click on Actions on top of the page and choose **Price Update** as shown in the image below:




- Click on **Submit** button. The status of the price updation will appear as:




## To Update Inventory

- From **Actions**, select Inventory update and click on **Submit** button.




- You will be navigated to a page as shown below, with inventory update message:




## To Update the Status

## To Delete Product(s)


- Select the products that you want to delete.

## 5. Manage Order


After the Magento store gets integrated with the Shopify store, the admin may manage the Shopify orders easily from the Magento admin panel itself.

### To Manage the Shopify Orders.


- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- Place the cursor on Shopify on the top navigation bar.
- From the menu that appears as shown in the image below, click on **Manage Orders**.



- On clicking it, you will be navigated to the page as shown below:




- To get the Shopify orders on the Magento admin panel, click on **Import Shopify Orders**.
- On clicking it, the order will be fetched from Shopify and listed as shown in the image below:




- On this page, you may see the details of the Shopify orders such as **Magento Order Number**, **Shopify Order ID Number**, **Order Status**, etc.

### To Delete Shopify Order.

- Select the order that you want to be deleted.




### 6.1. Category

To take certain actions relevant with the Shopify Categories.

- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- Place cursor on **Shopify** on top navigation bar and then on **Developer**. The menu appears as:




- Click on **Categories**.
- The page that you will be navigated to will look like shown in the image below:




**To sync the categories.**





## 6.3. Shopify Logs


The logs created while sending the Magento products on Shopify get created and can be seen and managed from the Magento admin panel.

### To see or manage the Shopify Logs.

- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- Place cursor on **Shopify** on the top navigation bar.
- When menu appears, place cursor on **Developer** and then click **Activity Logs**.



- On clicking it, you'll be navigated to the Shopify Logs page as:




- On this page, you may see the logs as shown in the above image. If they are not listed, click Reset Filter and the logs will be listed as shown in the figure.

**To delete all the logs,**

- Click on **Truncate** button and all the logs will be cleared from the list.

**To delete selected logs,**

- Select the log(s) you want to be deleted.
- Click on **Actions** drop down on the top right, above the listing. You will see the option of deleting a record as:




- Click on **Delete Records**.

**6.4. Cron Logs**

Seller may see the cron logs that are running – from the Magento admin panel itself – after the integration of Magento store with Shopify is done.

**To see the Cron Logs,**

- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- Place cursor on **Shopify** on the top navigation bar and when the menu appears, move it on **Developer**.
- Now click on **Cron Logs**.


- You may see the crons on this page and if they are not listed, click on **Reset Filter** button on top right of the page and the cron logs will be listed as shown in the image above.


