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1. Overview

This extension is created for Magento users which enables them to list their products on Ebay for FREE.

The advanced, easy to use Ebay Basic Integration for Magento from CedCommerce brings you an exclusive option to list your products on Ebay marketplace for FREE and earn globally.


Key features of the extension

- **Sending products on eBay gets easy** – Create a profile for similar type of products, add the products to it, and send those on eBay every time, easily.
- **Upload products on eBay in one go** – With seller friendly interface, it enables you to send the Magento products on eBay in an instant.
- **Enable/Disable products on eBay** – Disable your listed products on eBay marketplace and retire them. When needed, enable them once again.
- **Map Magento attributes with eBay** – The advanced extension enables you to map the Magento store's product attributes to that of eBay marketplace.

2. Installation of the Extension

To install the extension

- Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- On the top navigation bar, point to the **System** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



- Point to the **Magento Connect** menu, and then click **Magento Connect Manager**. The page appears as shown in the following figure:



- Scroll down to the **Ebay_Integration** Package.
- In the **Actions** column, select the **Install** option from the list.
- Click the **Commit Changes** button.
Auto-scroll console contents screen appears and the extension is installed after the process.

3. Configuration

To complete the configuration,

- Go to your Magento admin panel.
- Place the cursor on **Ebay Basic** present on the top navigation bar.



- When the menu appears, click on **Configuration**.
- You will be navigated to the configuration page as shown below:




Ebay Basic API Settings

- Click on **Ebay Basic API Settings** and the section will expand as:



- In **Environment**, select from the **Sandbox** or **Production** options.
- In **Enabled**, select **Yes** and the section will expand as:



- In **Location**, select your store's location.
- To get the **Ebay Basic Token**, click on the **Fetch Token** button.

- On clicking it, a new tab gets opened asking you to sign in to the Ebay seller account.

- Enter the login credentials and then click the **Sign In button**. The page appears as shown:

- Click the **Agree** button. You get redirected to the configuration page which appears with **Ebay Basic Token** filled automatically. (*The **Ebay token** is fetched from the seller panel and appears in the Ebay Basic token Box.*)

Fetch Other Details- While doing the configuration, you need to fetch the '**other details**' that include Shipping, Return and other settings.

To do that,


- Click on the **Fetch Other Details** button which is next to the Fetch Token button. On doing so, other details(shipping, returns, and payment related) will be fetched.

- On clicking **Ebay Basic Return Policy Settings**, the section will expand as:

- In **Refund Type**, select the type of refund from the options listed.




- In **Return Accepted**, select if returns will be accepted by you or not.
- In **Return With-in Days**, select the time duration under which the return can be requested.
- In **Shipping Cost Paid By**, select whether the shipping cost of the product being returned will be paid by buyer or by seller.

- On clicking **Ebay Basic Shipping Settings**, the section will expand as:

- In **Ebay Basic Service Type**, select from the options shown in the image below,



- In **Shipping Postal Code**, enter the postal code for your product location.
- In **Shipping Settings**, you may add the rules by clicking on **Add Rules** button. On clicking it, the fields will appear as:

▲ Set shipping method and their charges.

- Select **Yes** in the **Enabled**.
- Select **Shipping Service** in the corresponding column.
- Enter the **Shipping Cost** and **Shipping Additional Cost** in the next two fields.
- Set priorities in the next field by entering the number.

- On clicking **Ebay Basic Payment Details**, the section will expand as:

- In **PayPal Email Address**, enter your PayPal email address.
- In **Payment Methods**, select the payment methods that buyers will use for buying your eBay products.

Once all the actions have been taken as mentioned above, click on **Save Config** button on the top right side of the page. Configuration will be saved.

4. Profile Management

In the **Manage Ebay Basic Profiles** section of the eBay Basic Integration for Magento, you may take the following actions:


- Adding a New Profile

4.1. Adding a New Profile

TO ADD A NEW PROFILE,

- Go to the **Magento** admin panel.
- On the top navigation bar, place cursor on **Ebay Basic**.
- When the menu appears, click **Manage Ebay Basic Profiles**.



- On clicking it, you will be navigated to a page as shown below:

- In case the required attribute does not exist in the corresponding list, select **–Set Default Value–** from the corresponding list. A box will appear in the **Default Value** column next to corresponding **Magento Catalog**

- Select the check boxes associated with the required products that you want to assign to the profile.
(**Note:** Admin can assign one product to one profile only. It means, admin can assign multiple products to the same profile but can associate a product only to one profile at one time. To assign a product to another profile, the admin has to remove that product from the currently assigned profile.)
- Click **Select All** to select all the products available in the store.
(**Note:** To clear the selection, click the **Unselect All** link.)
- Click the **Select Visible** link to select the products displayed on the current page.
(**Note:** To clear the selection, click the **Unselect Visible** link.)
- Click the **Save** button. The profile will be created and you will be navigated to the **Ebay Basic Profile Listing** page. A success message will appear on the page and the newly created profile will be listed in the column.
- Or you may click the **Save and Continue Edit** button to save the created profile and continue editing, if required.
- You may also click the **Save and Upload Product** button to save the profile and upload the products on Ebay. The assigned products will be listed on the **Product Manager** page and a success message will appear.

4.2. Edit the Existing Profile

TO EDIT THE EXISTING PROFILE.

- Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- On the top navigation bar, point to the Ebay Basic menu. The menu appears as shown.



- Click **Manage Ebay Basic Profiles**. The Ebay **Profile Listing** page appears.

- Click **Manage Ebay Basic Profiles**. The Ebay **Profile Listing** page appears as shown:



4.4. Managing Products Assigned to Profile

With the help of this feature, the admin can manage the products assigned to the specific profile. The admin can view and edit the product, validate and upload the individual product. Also, the admin can view the error message if any error exists in any product details. The admin can also submit certain actions on the selected products available on the Product Manager page.


Note: After getting redirected to the Product Manager page from the Ebay Basic Profile Listing page, the admin can view the list of only those products that are assigned to the selected profile.

To go to the Product Manager page:

- Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- On the top navigation bar, place cursor on the **Ebay Basic** menu.
The menu appears as shown:




- Click **Manage Ebay Basic Profiles**.

- Scroll down to the required profile row.
- In the **Action** column of the respective row, click the **Arrow** button. A menu appears.

- All the products assigned to the selected profile are listed on this page.

4.5. Deleting a Profile

TO DELETE A PROFILE.

- Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- On the top navigation bar, point cursor to the **Ebay Basic** menu.
- The menu appears as shown



- Click **Manage Ebay Basic Profiles**.
- You will be navigated to **Ebay Basic Profile Listing** page on which, all the available profiles are listed.



- You will be navigated to the page on which you will see the status of the product upload.



- Click on **Save** button once the changes have been made. The editing will be done for the product.


