

Spartoo Integration for Magento - Manual

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1. Overview

Spartoo Integration by CedCommerce helps to integrate the Magento store with Spartoo by establishing a synchronization of products, orders, and return with the help of Spartoo API. The CRONs implemented in this extension help to automate the process thereby keeping it up to date. This extension helps you sell on Spartoo by directly uploading your products from your Magento store.

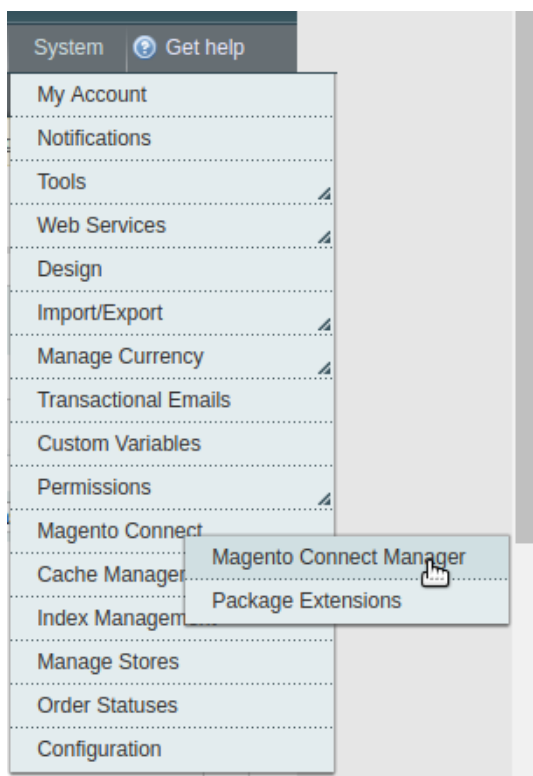
The features of the Spartoo Integration extension are as follows:

- Manage Spartoo Product/Upload Product (directly from the grid and bulk upload all products)
- Product Synchronization
 - Automatic process of synchronization with crons
- Manual synchronization process
- Review Product/Inventory/Price Feeds
- Automated Order Import
- Shipment of Orders
 - Automated Shipment with Shipworks/Shipstation
- Fetch Return and process
- Upload Simple and Configurable Product(s)
- Bulk Product Upload/Publish
- Retire/Unpublish Selected Product(s)
- CRON Facility
- Knowledge Base

2. Spartoo Integration Extension Installation

To install the extension

To install the extension, Go to the system and select the drop down as shown in the below figure.



- Select the Magento Connect
 - Go to the Magento Connect Manager.

 - Click on the button **Commit Changes**. To save the changes.

3. Spartoo Configuration Settings

Once the extension is successfully installed on the Merchant's store, Spartoo tab appears in the Magento Admin Panel. The merchant has to fill in the API credentials on the **Spartoo Configuration** page of the admin panel.

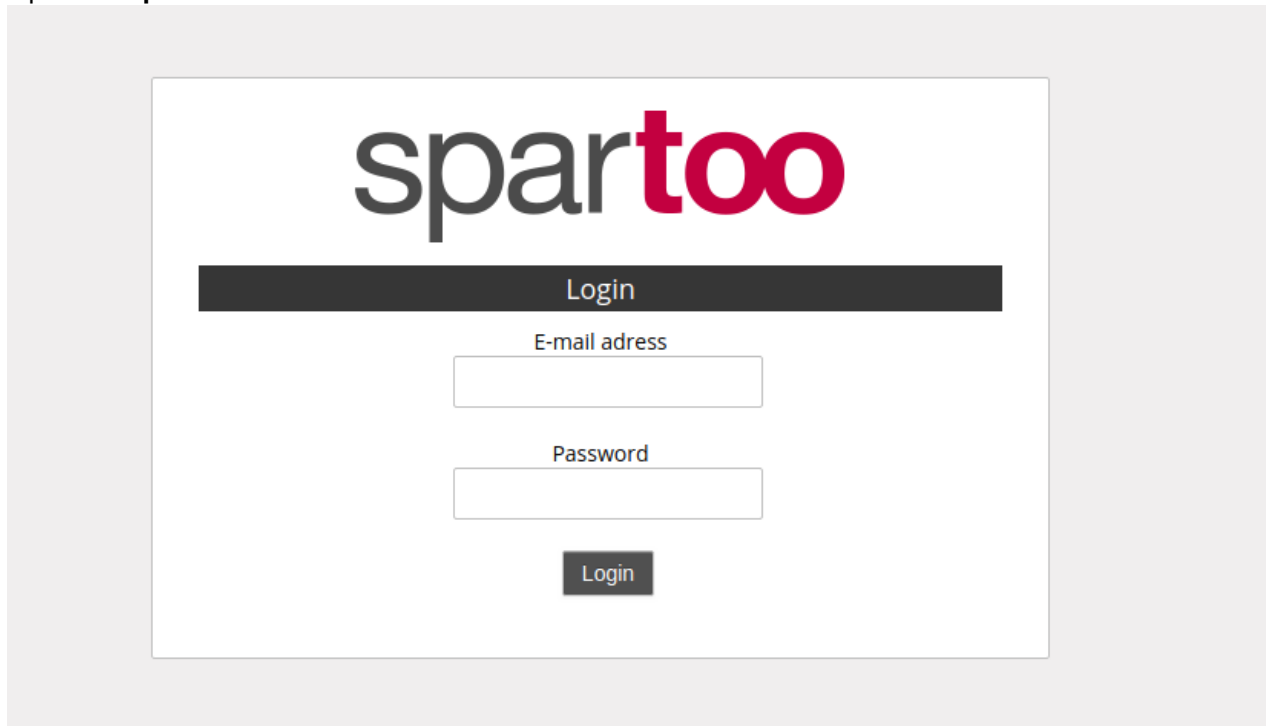
The user has to log in the Spartoo Seller account to obtain the following API credentials:

- Spartoo **Consumer Id**

After obtaining **Consumer Id**, the merchant has to copy it from the Spartoo Seller account and paste it to the Configuration page of the admin panel of the seller.

To Copy the Configuration Settings from the Spartoo Seller account

1. Open the **Spartoo Seller** account.



2. Go to the **Information** option from the left side of the screen.

3. Under **Spartoo API Settings**, do the following steps:

a. In the **Enabled** list, select **Yes**.

Note : Selecting the **No** option hides all other fields of **Spartoo API Settings**. Thus, the user cannot set-up the API settings in the Magento store.

b. In the **Consumer Id**, Enter the details copied from the seller panel.

c. In the **Order import Start Date** box, enter the date.

The date from which the user has started to fetch the order.

d. In the **Email Id to Receive Critical Notifications** enter your email Id to get the critical notifications from Marketplace on your e-mail.

e. In the **Spartoo Debug Mode**

\. Select **Yes** to recognize the error

\. Select **No** to disable the Debug Mode

f. In the **Spartoo Customer Email**, enter the default email Id to create a default customer if the customer details are not available

g. In the **Spartoo Order Id Prefix**, Enter the prefix code the recognize the order of Spartoo. For Eg: SP

Click the **Spartoo Product Global Settings** tab.

- Select **Yes**, to create order if the product is Disabled in your Magento.
- Select **No**, to create a failed order, if the product is Disabled in your Magento.

Fill the custom values in the particular text boxes to set the manual time for the crons.

- In the **Enable Order Cron**,
 - Select **Yes**, to enable the cron
 - Select **No**, to disable the cron.
- In the **Order Status Sync Cron**
 - Select **Yes**, to sync the order status through cron
 - Select **No**, to disable the order sync cron.
- In the **Enable Inventory Cron**,
 - Select **Yes**, to enable the Inventory Cron
 - Select **No**, to disable the Inventory Cron

Now click on the **Save Config** button to save the Configuration process.

4. Manage Profile

Admin can create a new profile and assign the required products to the profile. While creating and editing the profile, admin can map the Magento attributes to the Spartoo attributes. These attributes are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

Admin can do the following tasks:

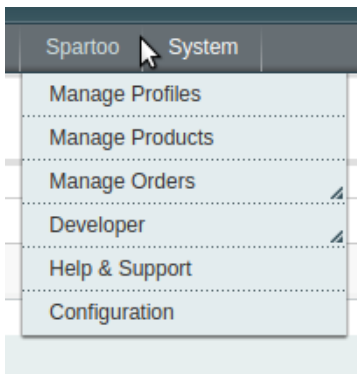
- Add a new profile

4.1. Add Profile

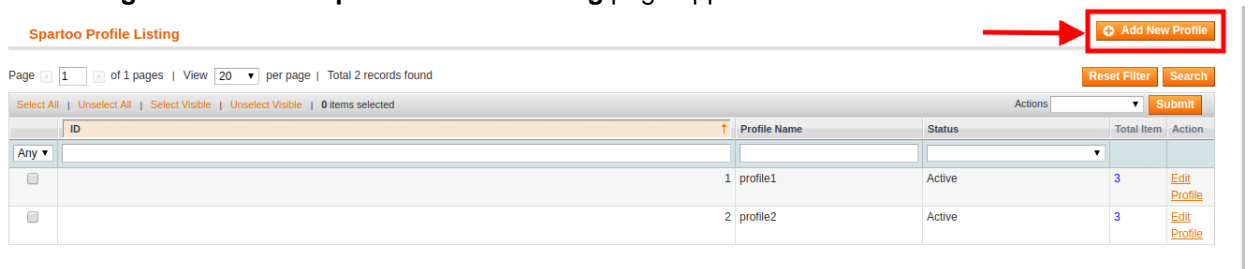
Procedure to Add A New Profile:

1. Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.

2. On the top navigation bar, point to the **Spartoo** menu. The menu appears as shown:

3. In the left panel, under **Profile Information**, do the following steps:

- In the **Profile Code** box, enter the profile code. (**Note:** It is only for the internal use. Use the unique profile code with no spaces. Start with small letters.)
- In the **Profile Name** box, enter the name of the profile. (**Note:** Use the unique name to identify the profile.)
- In the **Status** list, select **Active** to enable the profile. (**Note:** The **Inactive** option disables the profile.)

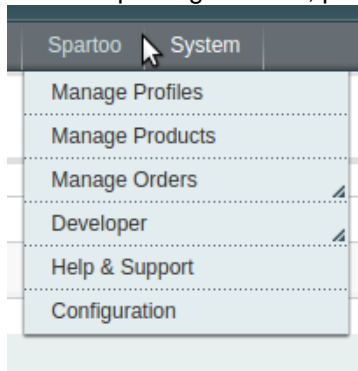

- Select the check boxes associated with the required products that you want to assign to the profile. (**Note:** Admin can assign one product to one profile only. It means, admin can assign multiple products to the same profile but can associate a product only to one profile at one time. To assign a product to another profile, the admin has to remove that product from the currently assigned profile.)
- 6. Click **Select All** to select all the products available in the store. (**Note:** To clear the selection, click the **Unselect All** link.)
- 7. Click the **Select Visible** link to select the products displayed on the current page. (**Note:** To clear the selection, click the **Unselect Visible** link.)
- 8. Click the **Save** button. The profile will be created and you will be navigated to the **Spartoo Profile Listing** page. A success message will appear on the page as highlighted in the image below and the newly created profile will be listed in the column.

4.2. Edit Existing Profile

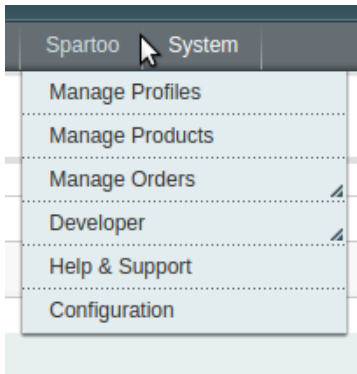

4.3. Delete Profile

Procedure to Delete the Profile:

- Go to the **Magento Admin** panel.
- On the top navigation bar, point to the Spartoo menu. The menu appears as shown. Click **Manage Profiles**. The **Spartoo Profile Listing** page appears.

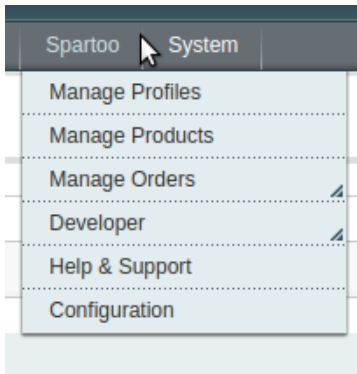
4.4. Manage Products Assigned to the Profile

With the help of this feature, the admin can manage the products assigned to the specific profile. The admin can view and edit the product, validate and upload the individual product. Also, the admin can view the error message if any error exists in any product details. The admin can also submit certain actions on the selected products available on the Product Manager page.

Note: After getting redirected to the Product Manager page from the Spartoo Profile Listing page, the admin can view the list of only those products that are assigned to the selected profile.

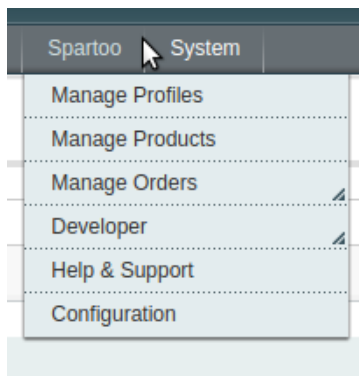

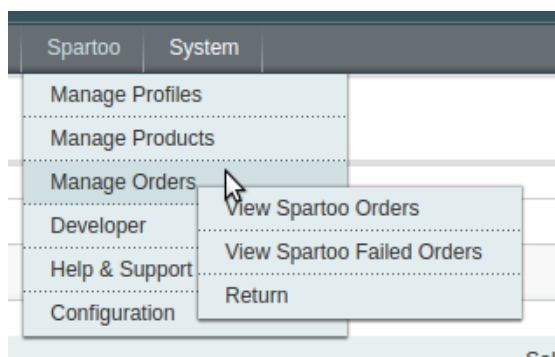



- If the selected Payment Method in Spartoo System Configuration Setting is not available in Magento.

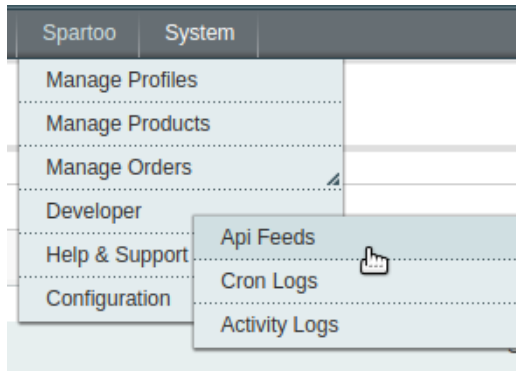

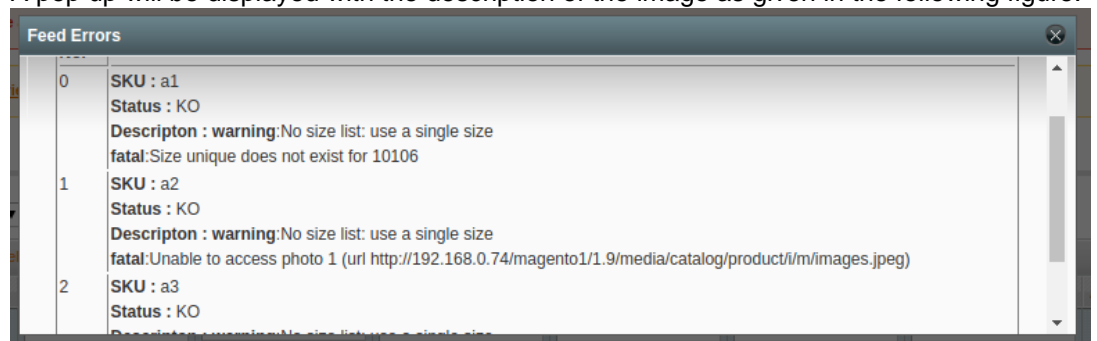

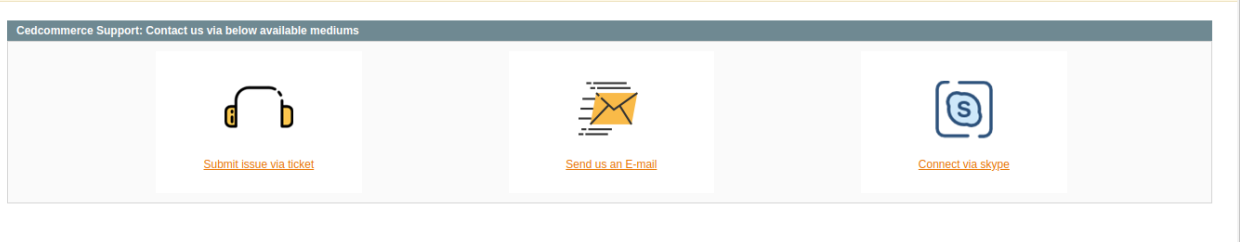
