

Cdon Integration For Prestashop Guide

by CedCommerce Products Documentation

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1. Overview

Cdon Prestashop Integration is an efficient API integration that helps the Prestashop store owners to synchronize inventory, price, and other product details for the product creation and its management between the **Prestashop store** and the **Cdon marketplace**.

The **Cdon Prestashop Integration** extension integrates and synchronizes the product listing between Prestashop and Cdon. Once the seller has installed the extension, it becomes easy to map the Cdon Categories with PrestaShop store. This extension establishes synchronization between Cdon marketplace and Prestashop and as a result, all the orders placed on Cdon are automatically reflected in your Prestashop Dashboard.

This extension empowers the sellers to configure the desired product category into Prestashop for automatic submission of the selected product to the same Category on Cdon.

The Key Features are as follows:

Profile-based product upload: Admin can create a profile, map the Cdon category and attributes to the Prestashop category and attributes, and then after assigning the products to the profile can easily upload products to Cdon.com.

Attribute Mapping: Maps suitable existing attribute with Cdon attribute, so a seller need not populate those fields.

Synchronized Inventory: Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and the listing of the products along with all the details is established between Prestashop and Cdon.com.

Bulk Upload System: The merchant has the flexibility to upload as many numbers of products on Cdon.com using bulk product upload feature, as wanted.

Simple and Configurable Product Upload: Admin can upload the Simple and Configurable type of Prestashop products on the Cdon website.

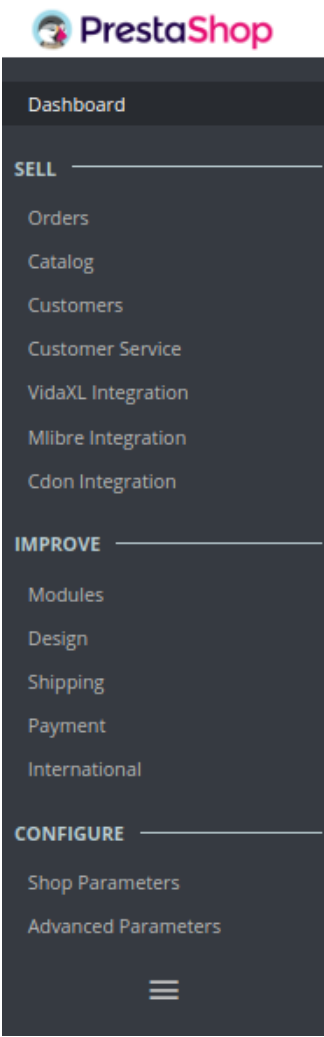
Enable and Disable Products: Merchants can close and reopen the products on Cdon.com using Enable and Disable feature.

Easy Order Creation: The newly placed orders on Cdon.com are automatically created in the Prestashop store with all the required details as it is on Cdon.

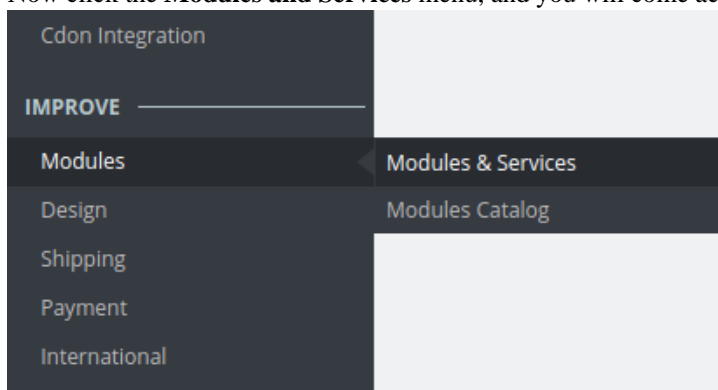
2. Cdon Prestashop Extension Installation

To install the extension:

- Go to the **Prestashop Admin panel**.

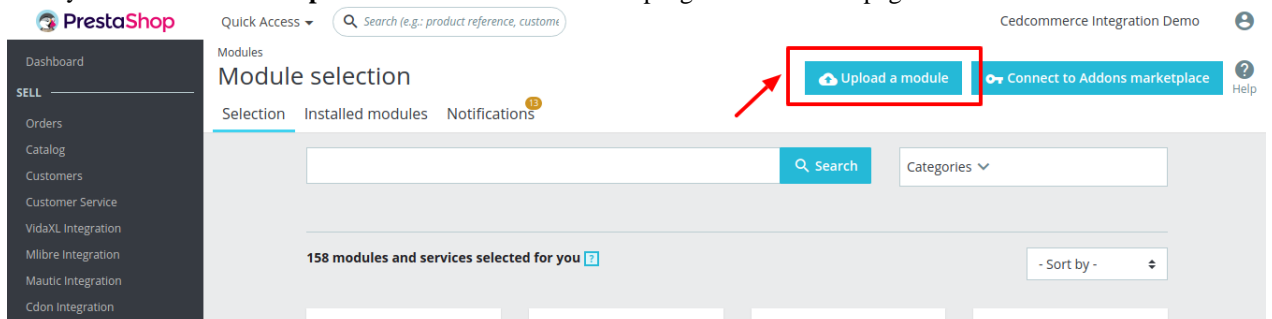


- On the left navigation bar, point cursor to the **Modules and Services**.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




- Now click the **Modules and Services** menu, and you will come across a page like shown below.

- Now you need to click on **Upload a New Module** on the top right corner of the page.



- In doing so, the page opens a section like shown in the image below:

Please upload one file at a time, .zip or tarball format (.tar, .tar.gz or .tgz). Your module will be installed right after that.


- Now select the Module File either by clicking on **select file** tab or simply dropping it, from your system.
- Once selected, click on the **Upload this module button**.
- On the same page, scroll down and in the Modules list, search for Cdon and it will be listed on the right side as a drop-down.
- Once you select and click on the **Install** button, you can see a message like shown below, on the same page, asking you if you wish to proceed with the installation. You may click on **Proceed with the installation**.
- The module will be installed and you will be navigated to the **Configuration** page for further steps to be taken.

3. Retrieve API Credential from the Cdon Seller Panel

Once the extension is successfully installed in the Prestashop store, the merchant has to enter the **API Key details** in the respective fields displayed on the **Cdon Configurations** page while setting up the configurations.

To get the API Key Details from the Cdon:

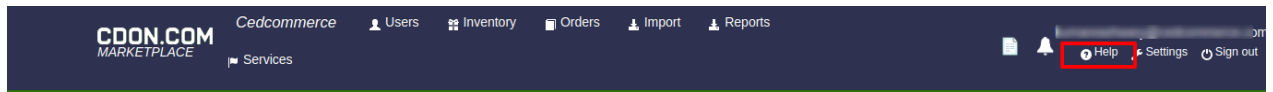

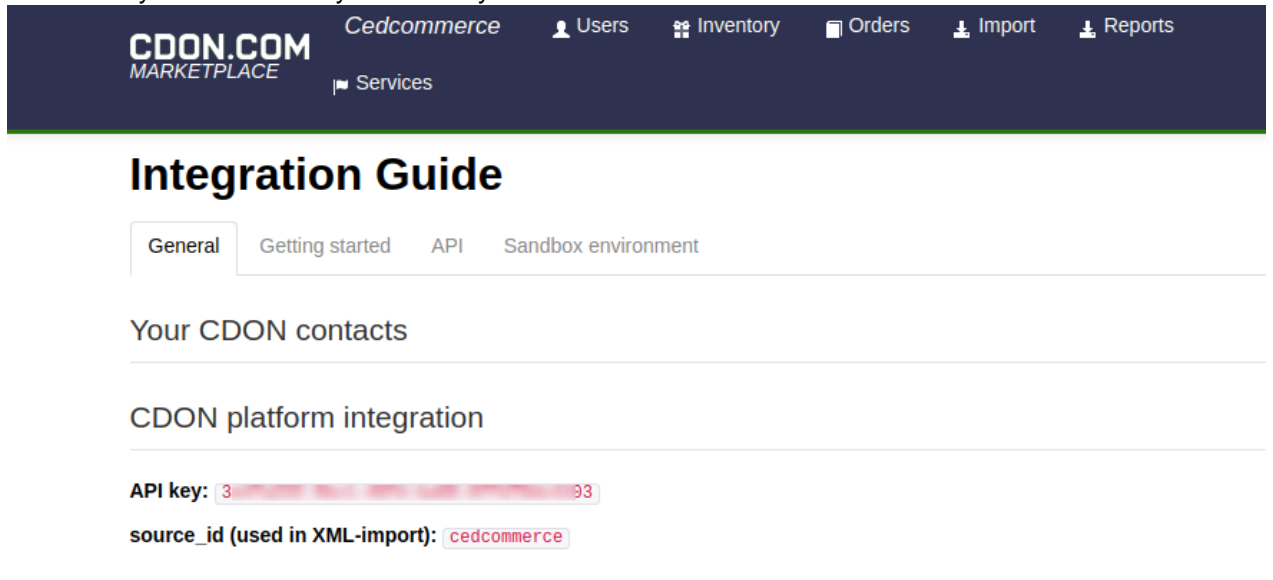

3. On the top panel click on help as shown in the figure below:



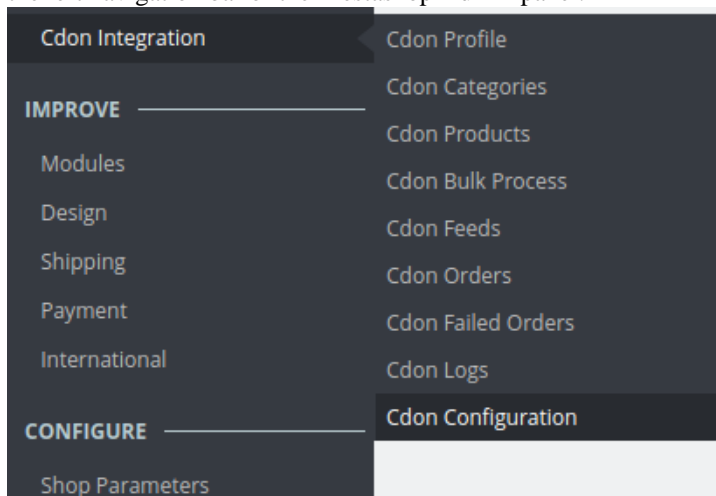
4. From here you can retrieve your API Key & Source Id.

4. Cdon Configuration Settings

1. Once the extension is successfully installed in the PrestaShop store, the **CDON INTEGRATION** menu appears on the left navigation bar of the Prestashop Admin panel.



2. Click on **Cdon Configuration** and the configuration page will open.

- In the **Price Type**, select either **Normal Price Without Tax** or **Normal Price With Tax**. Note that this is the type of product price to be sent to Cdon.com.
- In the **next section**,
 - Click on **Add new rule button**,
 - Choose the Country you wish to sell in under **Cdon Channel** section.
 - Select the **Cdon Price type variation** to variate your Cdon price with your PrestaShop store.
 - In the **Description language**, select the language in which you want the data to be processed.
- In the **Auto Sync Inventory and Price By Cron**, If enabled the inventory and price will automatically get sync with Cdon.
- In the **Update Inventory/Price on Product Edit**, select **Yes** or **No**, if you want the inventory and price to be updated on Cdon when you edit product on the store.
- In the **Delete Product Data on Product Delete**, select **Yes** or **No**, if you want to disable product on Cdon when you delete product on the store.
- Select Product **Feed size** and **Inventory Feed Size**.

- Select the **Fetch Cdon Order Range** from the drop-down menu.
- Select Yes/No Under **Auto Reject Failed Orders**
- Enter the e-mail address in the section **Order Email**.
- In the **CUSTOMER ID**, enter the ID for customers to be used, for orders which are imported from Cdon.
- In the **Import Cdon Order of status**, select the status to appear when the order has been imported.
- In the **Order status when canceled at Cdon**, select the status to appear when the order has been canceled.
- In the **Cdon Order shipment status**, select the order status to appear when the order has been shipped.
- In the **Order Carrier**, select the order carrier set for orders which are imported from Cdon.
- In the **Order Payment**, select the order payment method set for each order which are imported from Cdon.
- The next section is **Cron Info**.

- Put these Cron urls at your server if you want to automate product syncing and order importing.

Once you are done with entering and selecting all these needed information, click on **Save** to save all the configuration settings you have made changes for.

Your configuration will be saved.

5. Managing Cdon Profiles

Admin can create a new profile and assign the required products to the profile. While creating and editing the profile, admin can map the Prestashop attributes to the Cdon attributes. These attributes are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

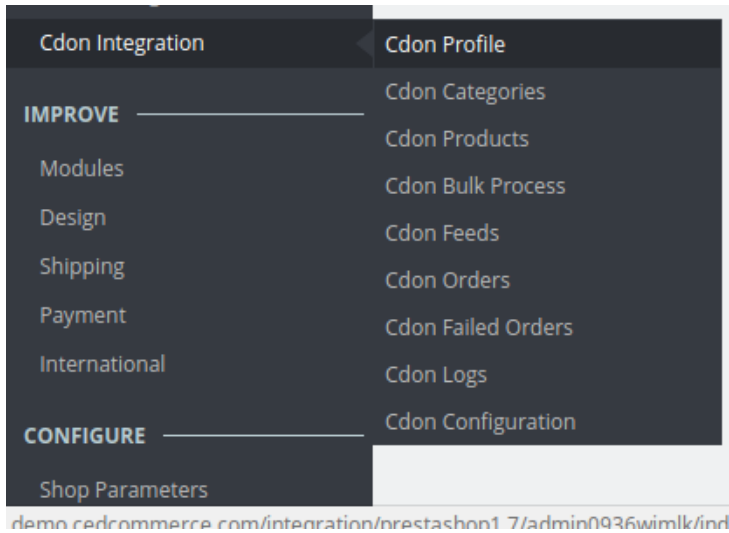
Admin can do the following tasks:

- Delete the profiles

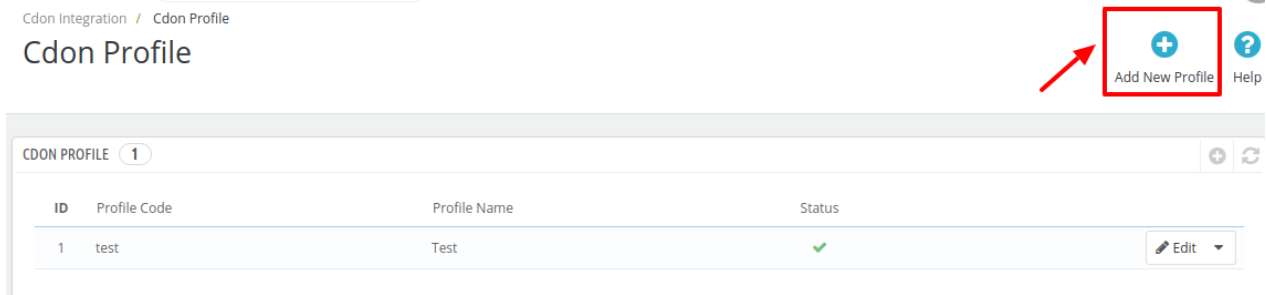
5.1. Adding a new profile

To add a new profile, a seller needs to:

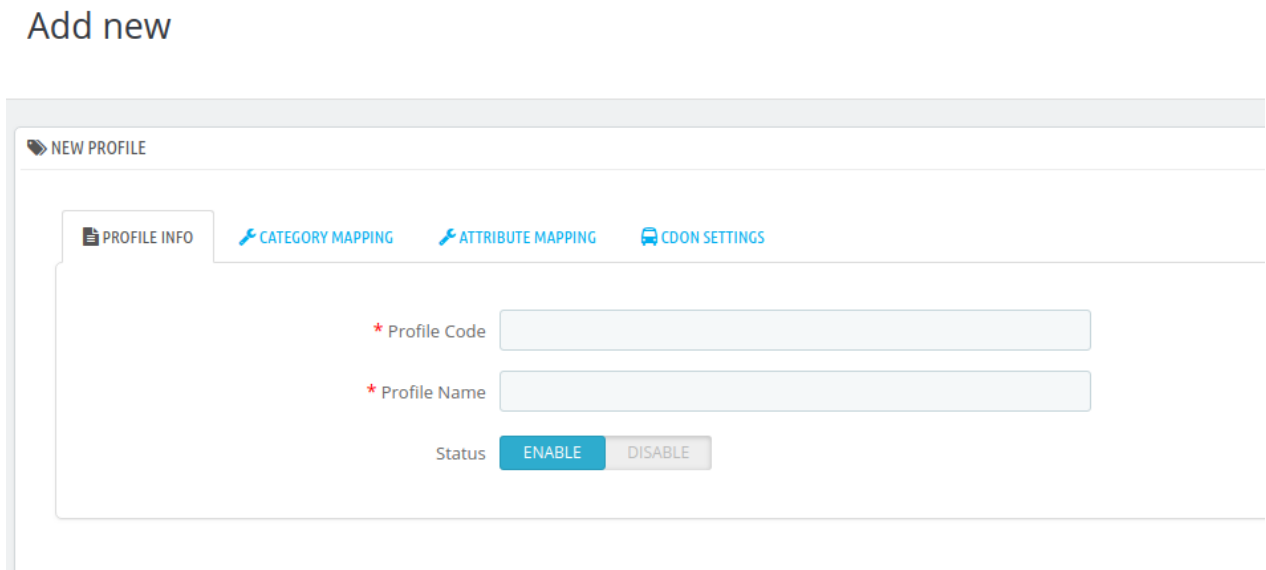
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on **Cdon** Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:



- Click on **Cdon Profile** and you will see the page as shown below:



- Now click on **Add New Profile**. You will be taken to the page as shown below:



- In the **Profile code**, enter the code for the profile you are making.
- In the **Profile name**, enter the name of the profile.
- Select **Enable** as the status to enable the profile.
- Click on the **Save** button.

Now Click on **Category Mapping** adjacent to the **Profile Info** tab, and you'll come across a section as below:

- Here all the **Cdon attributes** are mentioned on the left which you have to match with PrestaShop attribute on the right.
- Now from the drop-down menu select all the attributes and perform the desired mapping.

Click on the **Cdon Settings** adjacent to the **Attribute Mapping** and you will see the section as shown below:

In Cdon products

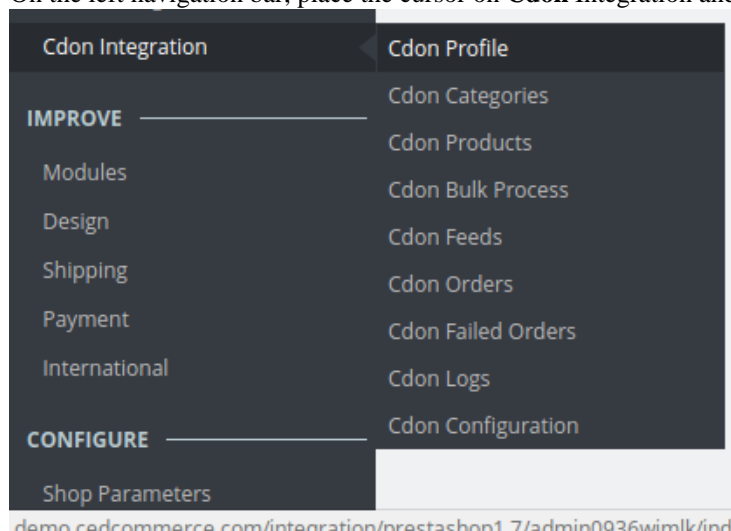
- In the **Product VAT** section choose the tax that is applied to the product.
- In the **Product Status** section, you can choose the current status of the product.
- Select the **Product Expose Status** from the drop-down menu next on the list.
- In the **Freight Class**, you can adjust the freight Class of your products (for example – A,B,D).

Now click on **Save** button and your profile will be created.


5.2. Editing the existing profile

- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on **Cdon Integration** and you will see it getting expanded as below:





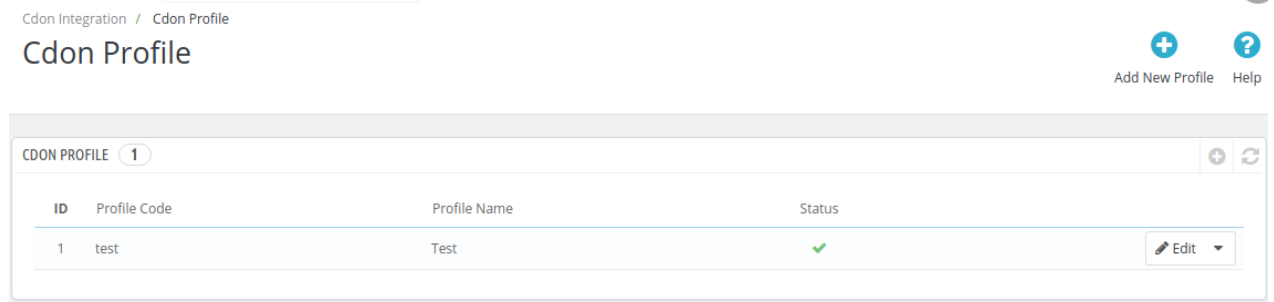
5.3. Deleting the existing profile

To delete an existing profile, a seller needs to:

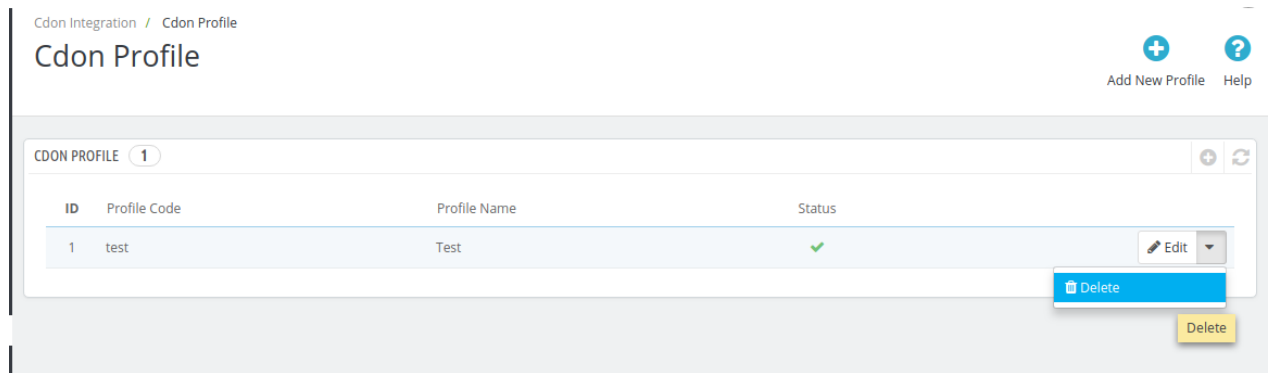
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel

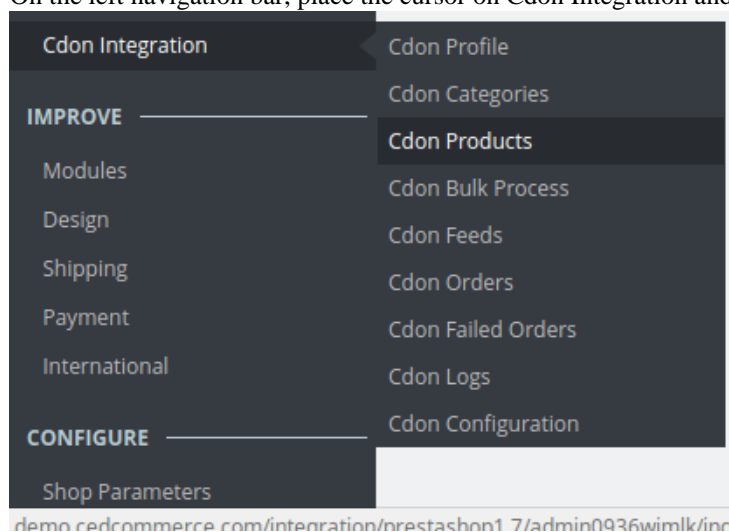

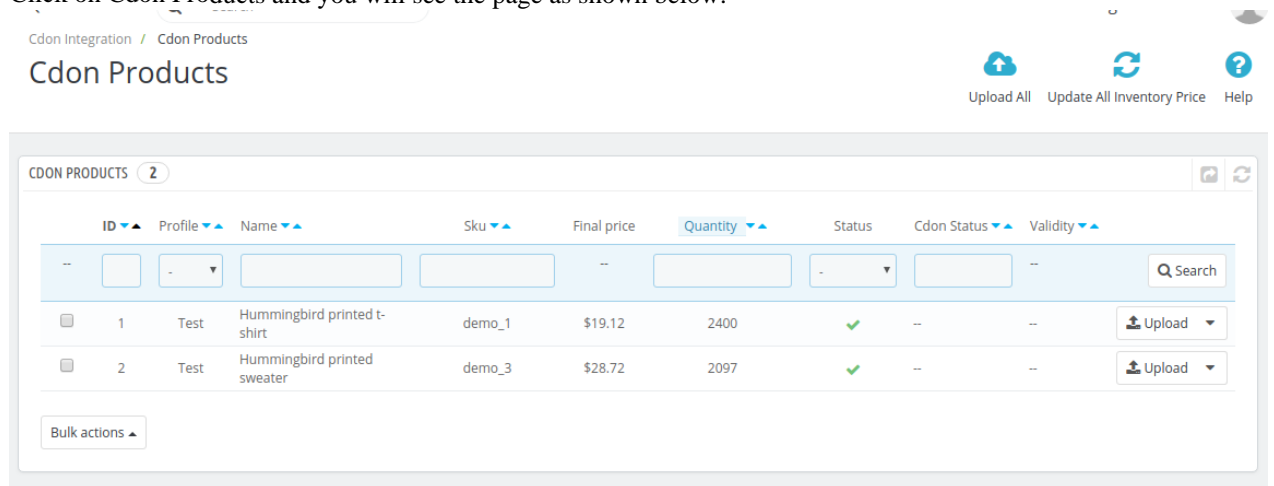
6.1. Uploading/Updating Selected Products

To upload/update a product, a seller needs to:

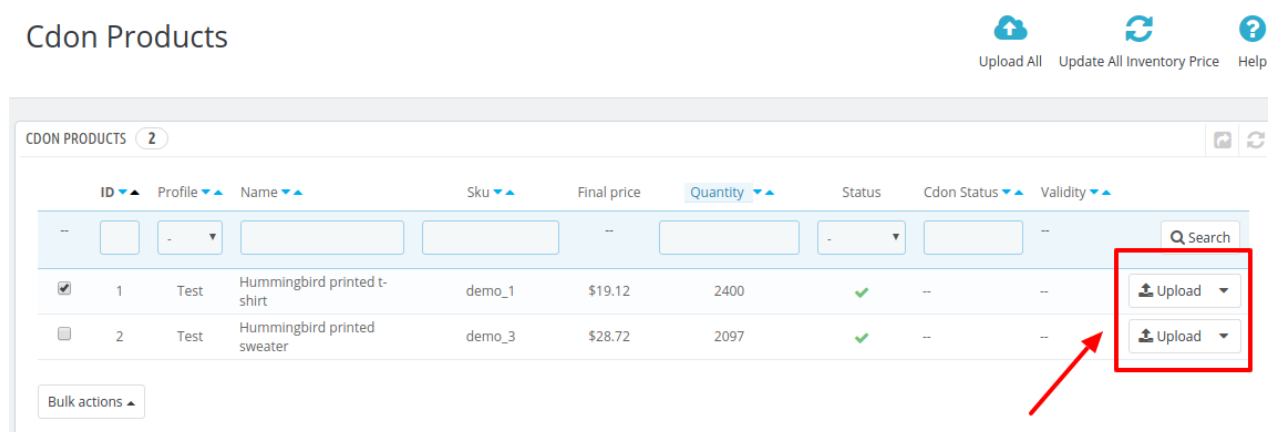
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on Cdon Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:



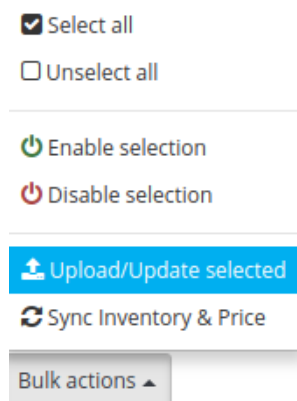
- Click on Cdon Products and you will see the page as shown below:



- Select the product you wish to upload and click on the **Upload Button** as seen below



- You can also perform **Bulk Upload**, you may select the product(s) and then you need to click on the **Bulk Actions** button on the bottom left of the page and you may see the options for actions, as shown below:

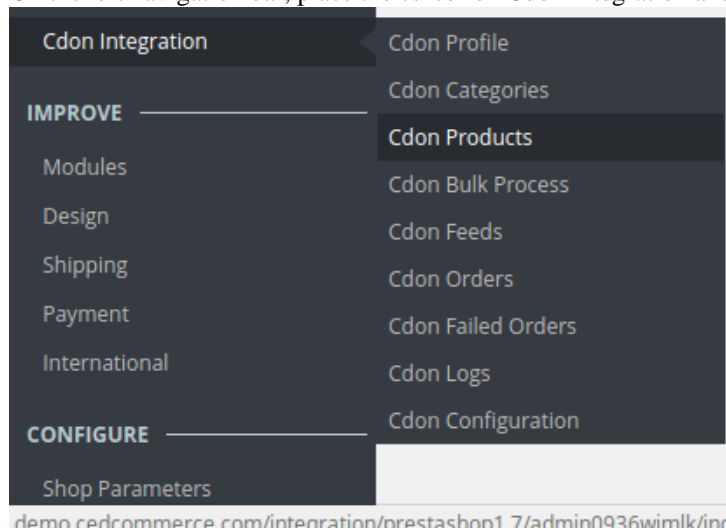


- Now click on the **Upload/Update selected** to upload the product.
- After you click **Upload/Update**, the products will go into the queue.
- All the Products which are queued will get **Uploaded on Cdon** afterward when the **Cron runs**.

- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on Cdon Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:

- Viewing the failed orders.

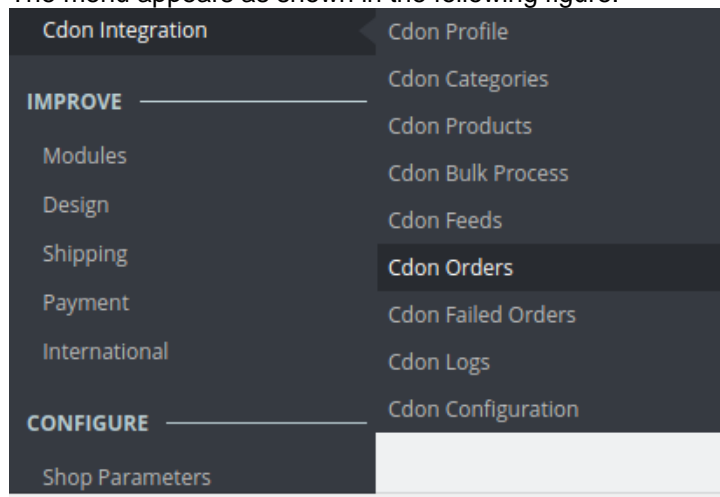
7.1. Shipping of Cdon orders

- On the left navigation bar, move the cursor over the **Cdon Integration** menu.

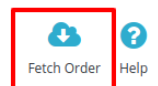

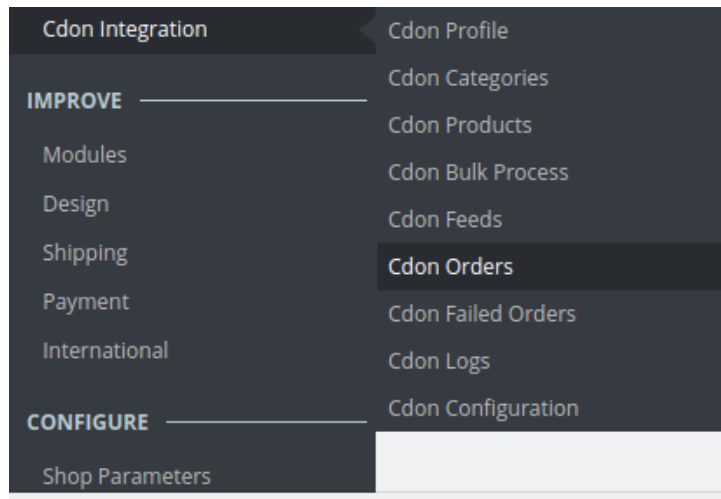

- Once you have filled the necessary details, click on the **Ship Order** button.

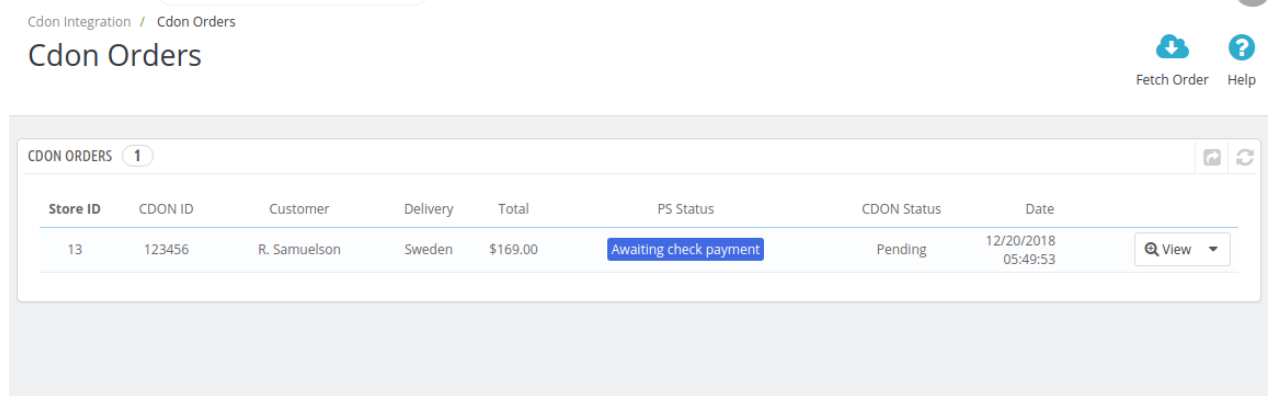

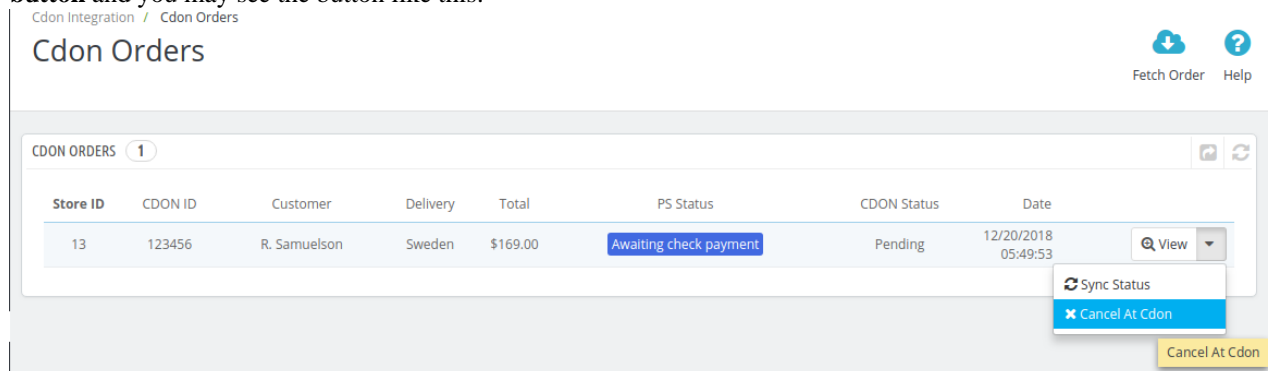

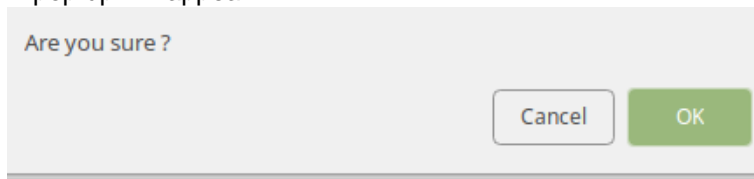

- A pop up will appear



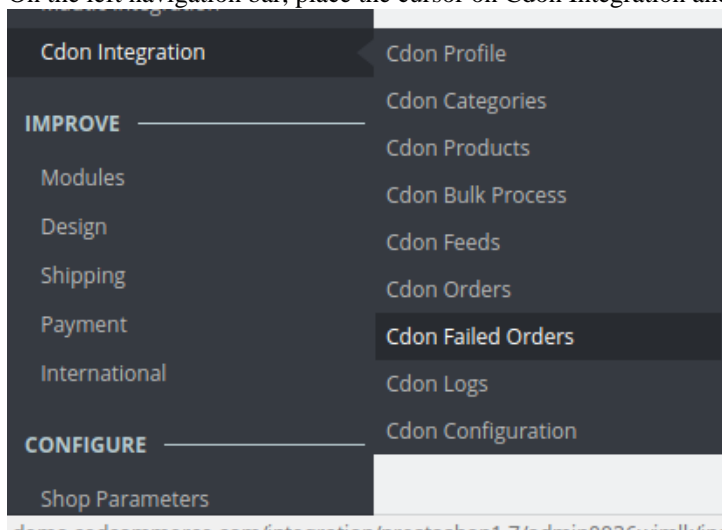
- Click on **Ok**.

8. Cdon Failed Orders

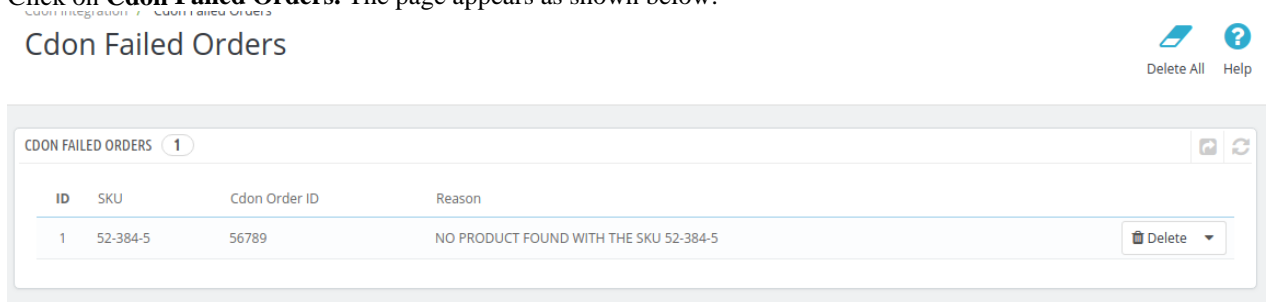
The admin can see the failed Cdon orders and has the liberty to cancel those orders as well.

To cancel the failed order:

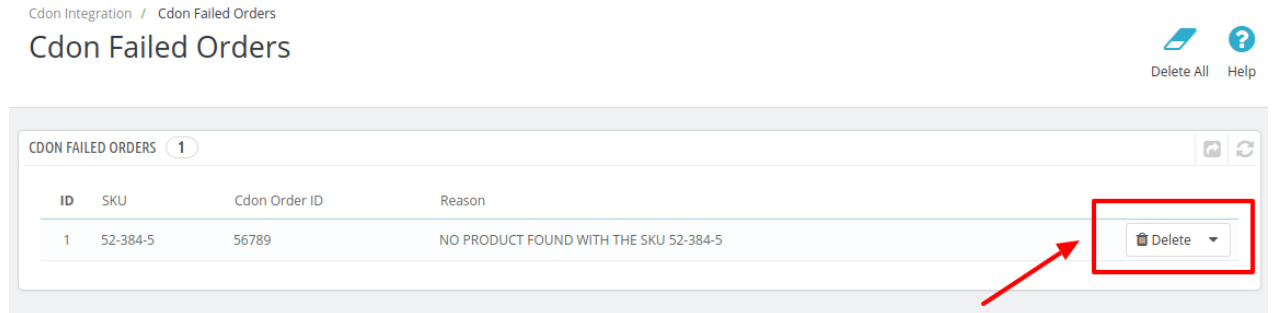
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on Cdon Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:



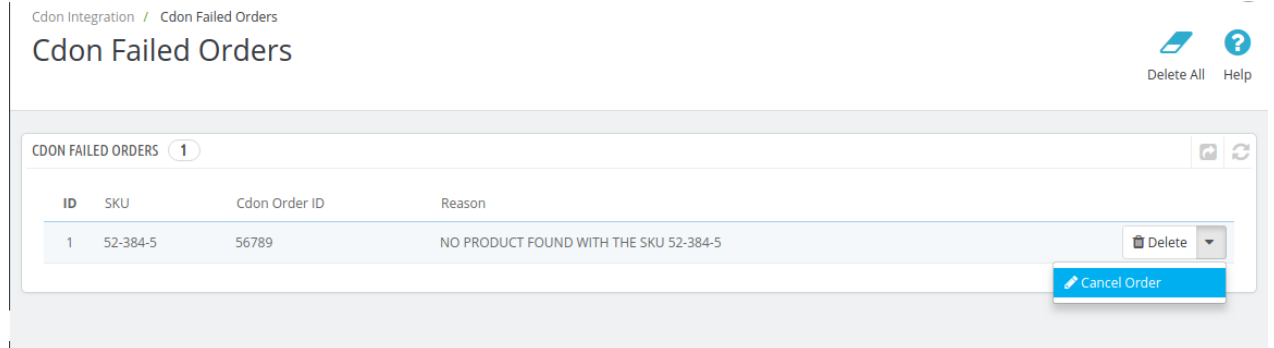
- Click on **Cdon Failed Orders**. The page appears as shown below:

- To cancel the failed orders, click on the **Cancel** button which is on the drop-down menu next to the delete button.

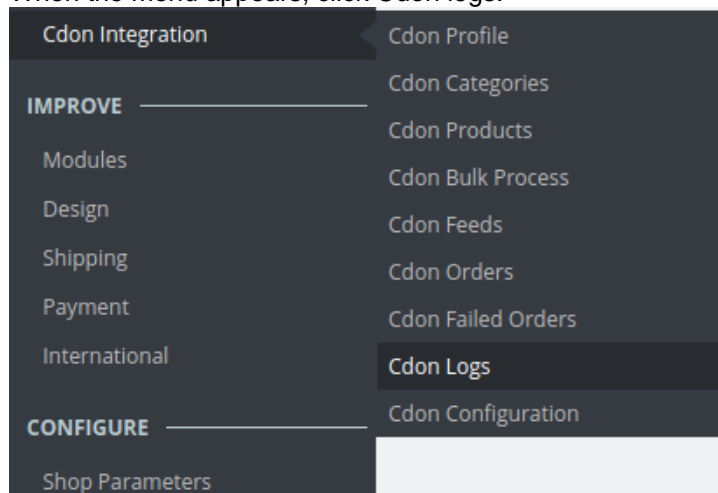

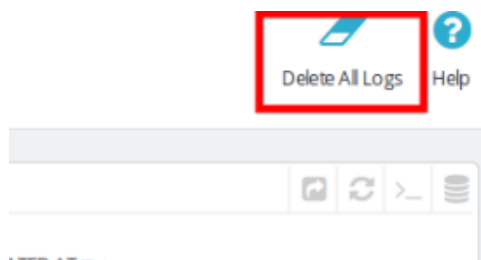
