

Newegg WooCommerce Integration Guide 0.0.1

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1. Overview

Founded in 2000, Newegg is one of the most trusted consumer electronics and computer related hardware and software marketplace.

On June 15, 2017, during London Tech Week, Newegg announced a global expansion plan to serve key parts of Asia Pacific, Europe, Latin America and the Middle East. Once complete, the online retailer is expected to reach customers in a total of 50 countries. [Reference from Newegg Wikipedia(<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Newegg>)] Hence, this integration plug-in is useful for the sellers those are targeting the customers from these regions.



Newegg WooCommerce Integration at Cedcommerce involves the integration of the WooCommerce e-commerce store with the Newegg marketplace through this extension, which automates the ordering process and facilitates the products handling and management.

This extension interacts with the Newegg Marketplace to integrate the synchronized product listing between the WooCommerce and the Newegg retailers. After installing the extension, the merchant can create the Newegg Categories and the dependent attributes on the WooCommerce store.

The process enables the merchant to configure the desired product category into WooCommerce for automatic submission of the selected product to the same Category on Newegg.

Key Features are as follows:

- **Profile-based product Upload:** Admin can create a profile and map the *Newegg* category and attributes to the WooCommerce category and attributes, and then after assigning the products to the profile can easily upload products to the *Newegg Web* site.
- **Synchronized Inventory and Profile Based Pricing:** Inventory Synchronization at regular intervals. product Listing is established between WooCommerce and *Newegg*. Profile-based price increase or decrease.
- **Synchronized Product Editing:** Besides adding the products, any product information changes made on the WooCommerce store reflects on the *Newegg*.
- **Automated Inventory Updates:** No manual updating is required. Automatic inventory updates are available for the better management.
- **Creation of WooCommerce Orders:** The newly placed orders on the *Newegg Web* site are automatically

created in the WooCommerce store with all the required details as it is on the *Newegg* Web site.

- **Consolidate Orders:** Easily manipulate orders from the WooCommerce store.
- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Admin can map many categories of the WooCommerce store to the single category of *Newegg*.
- **Updates Information:** Changes made in the WooCommerce store reflects on the *Newegg* Web site.
- **Bulk Upload System:** The merchant has the flexibility to upload any number of products on the *Newegg* Web site using bulk product upload feature.
- **Feed status:** Creates a Log of the Feed of all API requests made to *Newegg*. Admin can view all the details of that feed in the log.

2. Prerequisites

Here are some prerequisites that the user has to verify before installing the extension.

- PHP Version 5.5
- Curl extension should be installed on server
- Oauth extension should be installed on server
- WordPress 4.0
- WooCommerce 2.3

Also, the tab is available with the extension. The admin can view the *prerequisites*, *Steps to follow*, and the *guidelines*.

To view the prerequisites, steps to follow, and the guidelines

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **NEWEGG** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **Prerequisites** tab.

3. Retrieve API Credentials from Newegg

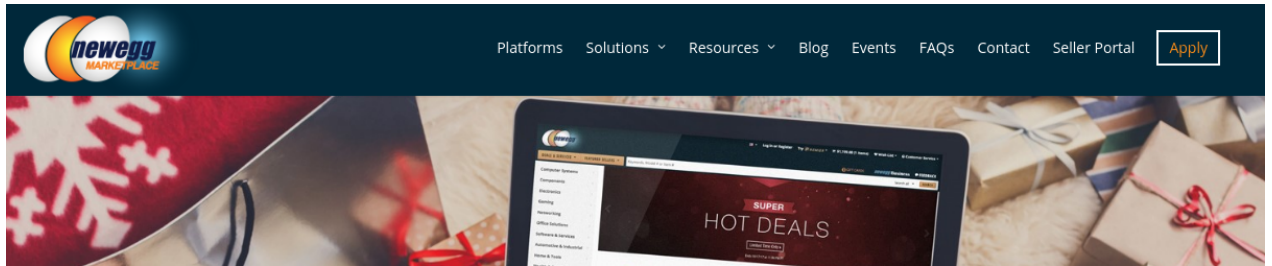
Once the extension is successfully installed on the WooCommerce store, the NEWEGG menu appears on the left navigation bar of the WooCommerce Admin Panel. The merchant has to enter the **API Key details** on the **NEWEGG CONFIGURATION** page of the admin panel.

To retrieve API Key Details from the Newegg

1. Go to the Sell on Newegg.com(<https://www.newegg.com/sellers/>)

link.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:



- In the Right-Top corner of the page, click the **Apply** link.

- Enter the required information, and then click the **Submit Your Application** button.
After the application gets accepted by Newegg, it provides the **USERNAME** and **PASSWORD** for the Newegg seller panel.
- Send mail to datafeeds@newegg.com, requesting them for the API keys.
After obtaining the **Seller Id**, **Authorization Key**, and **Secret Key** from Newegg, use these details while setting-up the configuration details on the New Egg Configuration page of the admin panel.

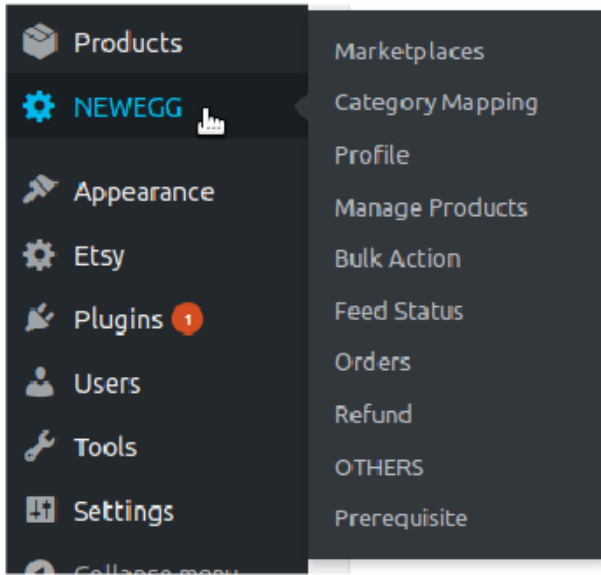
4. Newegg Configuration Settings

After obtaining the **Seller ID**, **Authorization Key**, and the **Secret Key** values from the Newegg marketplace, the WooCommerce store owner has to paste them on the **NEW EGG CONFIGURATION** page of the admin panel of the merchant.


To Set up the Newegg Configuration settings in the WooCommerce Admin panel:

- Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.

2. On the left navigation bar, click the **NEWEGG** menu.

3. Click **Marketplaces**.

8. Select the **Enable Sync on Product Update** checkbox to enable the synchronization of product edits between WooCommerce store and the Newegg Marketplace if required.
9. Select the **Enable Product Price/Inventory Sync with newegg** checkbox to enable the synchronization of product price and inventory with Newegg.

5. Category Mapping

The **CATEGORY MAPPING** page lists all the Newegg categories. Admin has to select the Newegg categories to which the products need to be assigned.

To select the required categories for mapping

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **NEWEGG** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **CATEGORY MAPPING** tab.

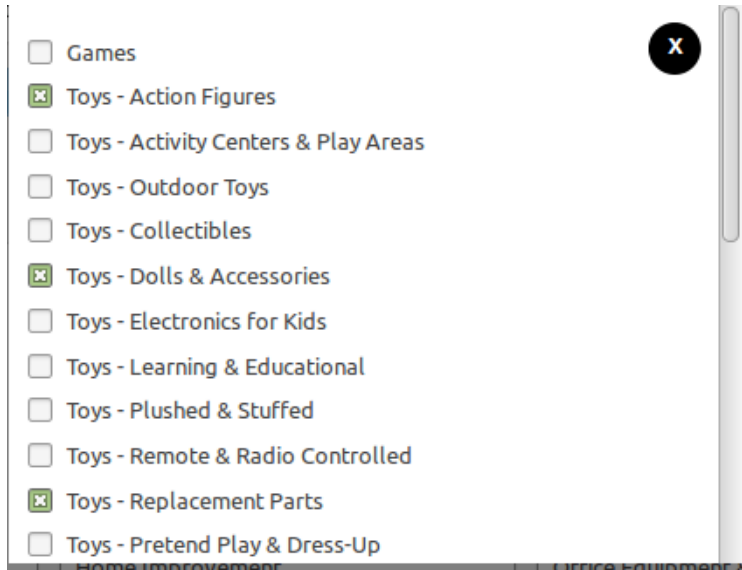

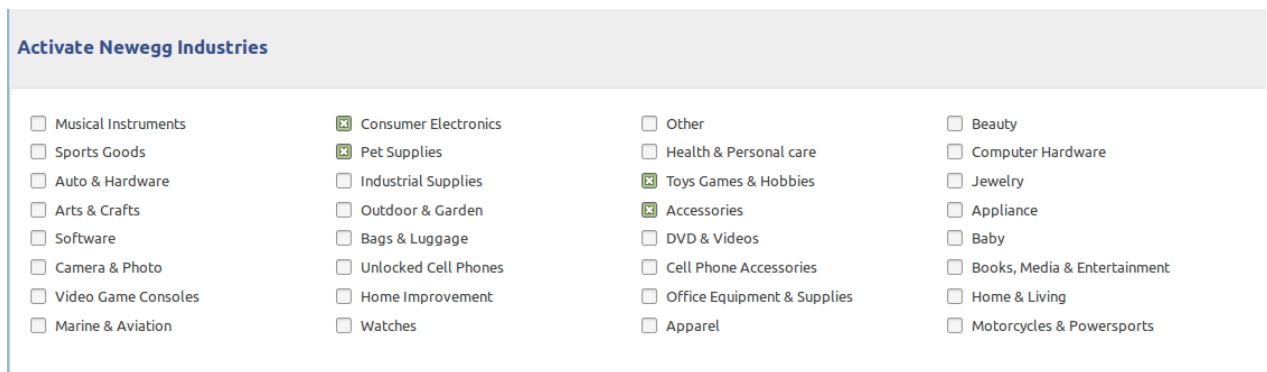

6. Manage Profiles

Profile-based product uploading provides the admin a facility to create a group of the required products those have common meta-keys, and then upload those products at one go through uploading that profile (created group). In other words, admin can create a new profile and assign it to the group of those products, and then upload the profile on Newegg; it saves the time of making the same changes in each meta-keys of each and every product.

It means, rather than making the changes in the common meta-keys of each and every product, admin can create a profile and assign it to all the products having common meta-keys, and thus make the changes in the meta-keys available on the profile page.

While creating and editing the profile, admin can select the product and the corresponding meta-keys. These meta-keys are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

Admin can do the following tasks:

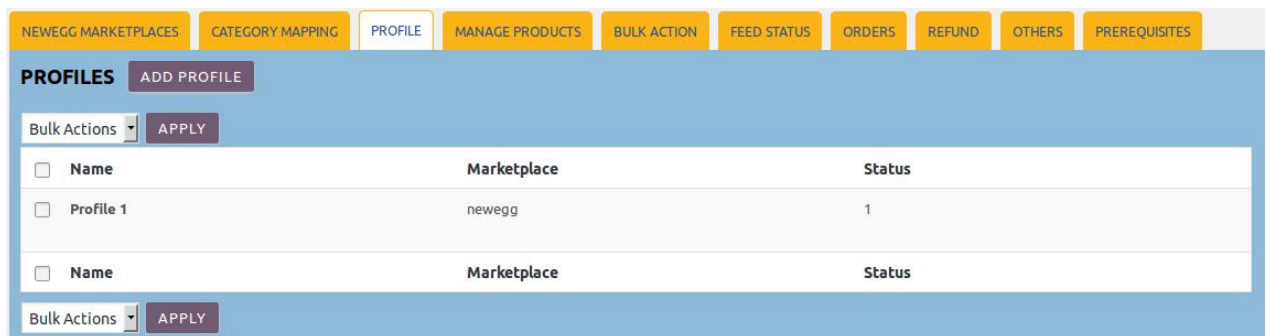

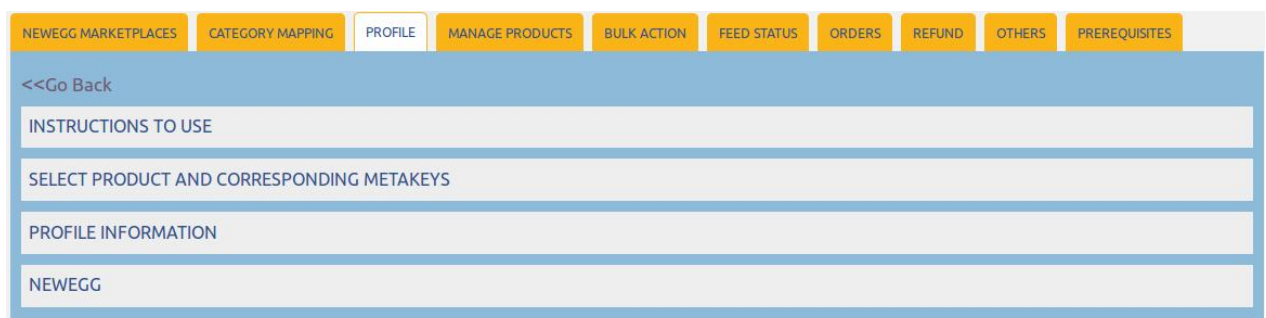
1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.

Note: The value entered in the box is applicable to all the products assigned to the profile. Whereas, selecting the meta key from the list selects the individual value of the individual product.
- In the select list associated with the **Product Brand** box, select the required meta key.
OR
In the **Product Brand** box, enter the required value.
- Similarly, enter the values in the other fields if required.
- In the **Newegg Subcategory** list, select the required category for mapping.
It enables the admin to map only one category to one profile.
Note: These meta-keys are applicable to all the products, the profile is assigned to. Leave the field empty if the specific value is required based on a specific product.

12. Scroll down to the **NEWEGG** tab.

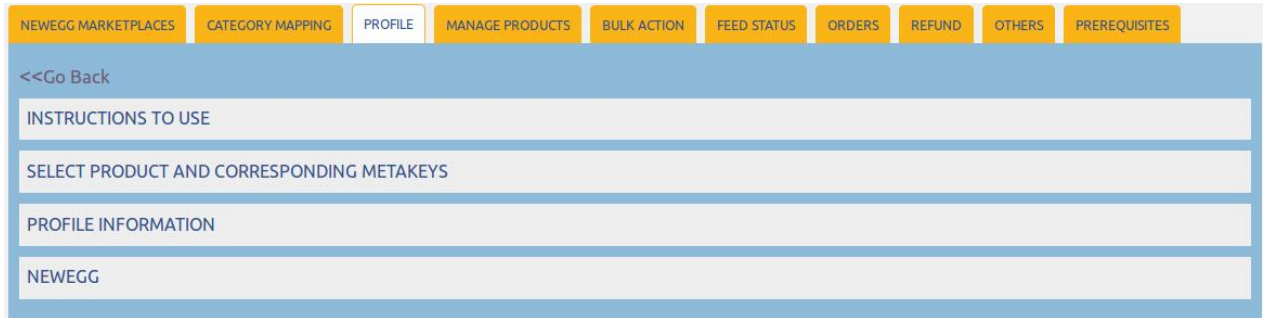

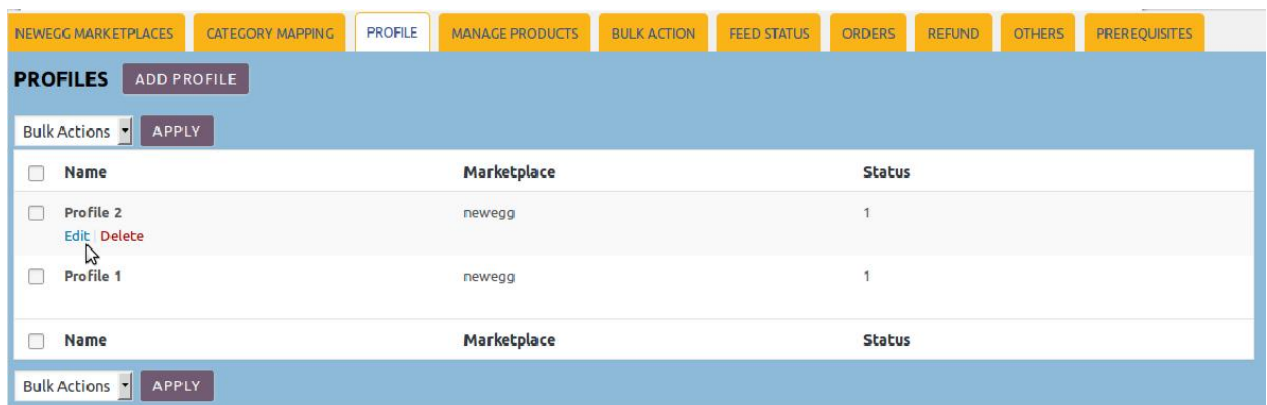

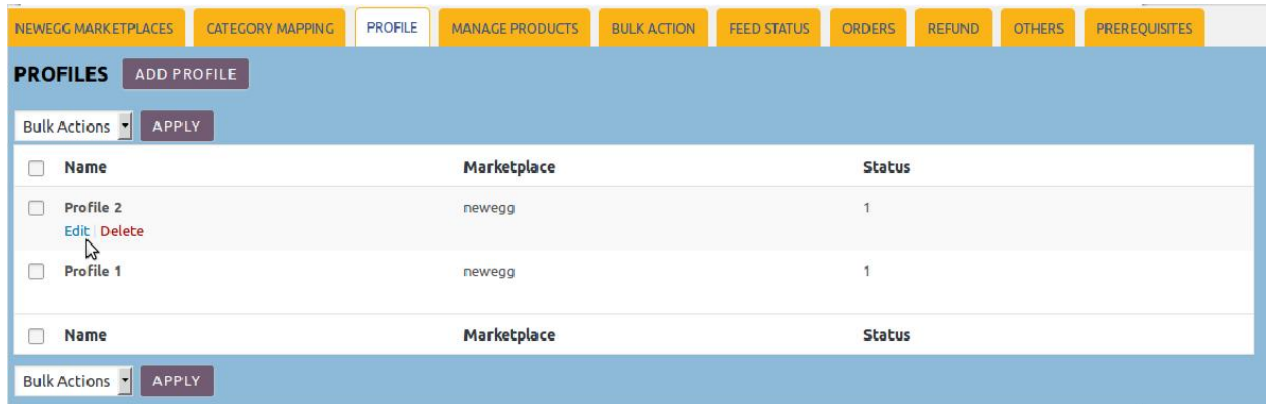

Admin can also delete more than one profiles in bulk through the **Bulk Action**.

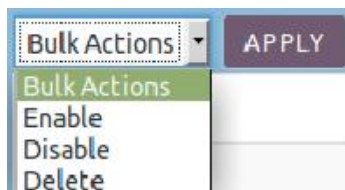

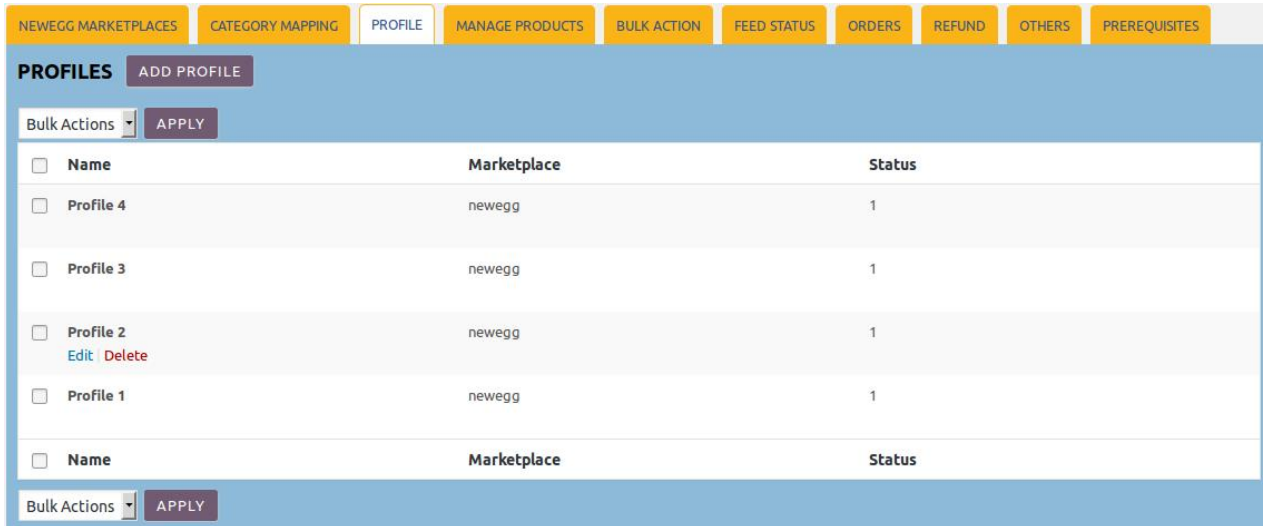

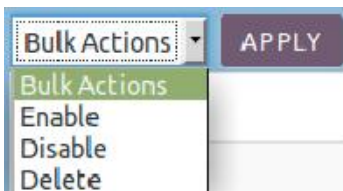

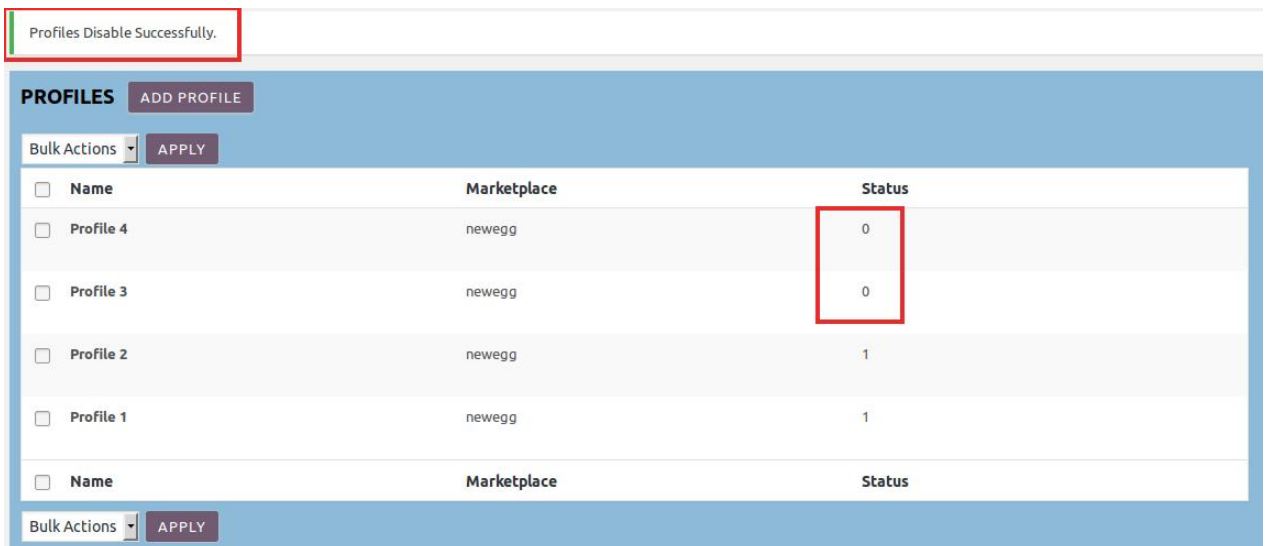

2. On the left navigation bar, click the **NEWEGG** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **MANAGE PRODUCTS** tab.

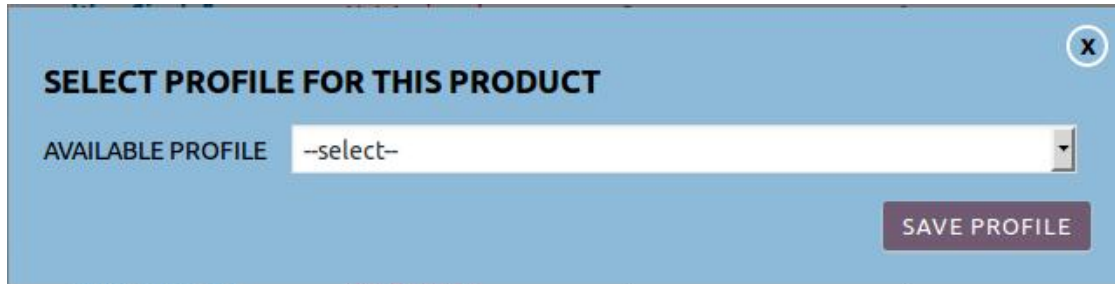

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **NEWEGG** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **MANAGE PRODUCTS** tab.

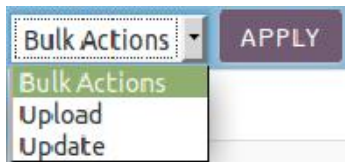

6. Click **Update**, and then click the **APPLY** button.
The selected products are updated and a success message appears.

8. Bulk Action

With this feature, the admin has an ability to perform the following Bulk actions:

: Assigns the selected profile to the category. Thus, the selected profile is assigned to all the products that fall under the category.

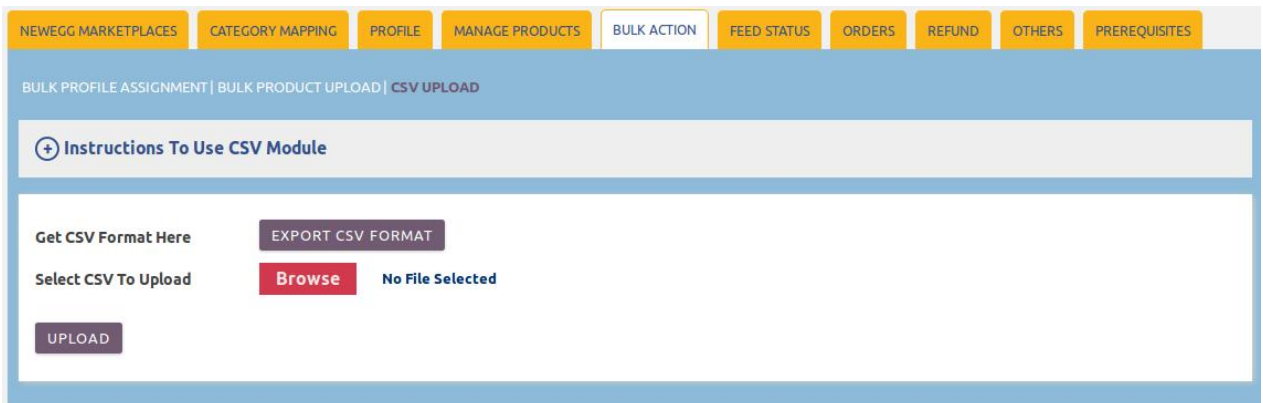

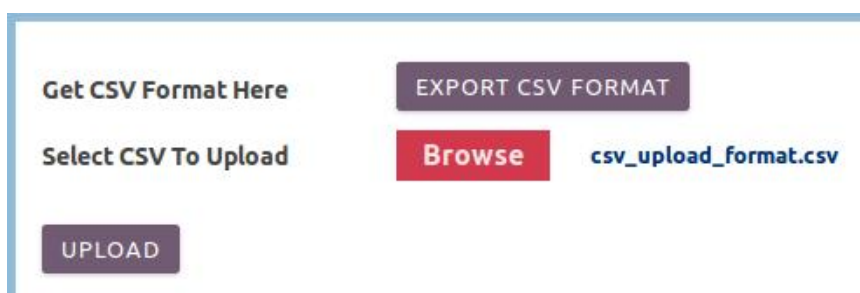

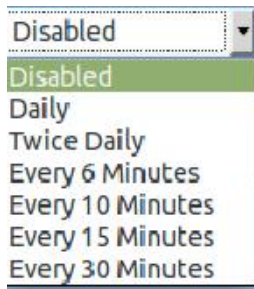
