

WooCommerce Bonanza Integration - Admin Guide

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1. Overview

Headquartered in Seattle Washington, Bonanza.com is a fastest-growing online marketplace consisting of over 15 million products where online store owners offer almost everything from Isometric sunglasses to Bieber perfume.

Bonanza is a beneficial company, which used by many online sellers and shoppers located in almost every country in the world to sell the products of every category. Mostly, it is well known for their unique collection of crafts, fashion, vintage and more.



CedCommerce Woocommerce Bonanza Integration enables the WooCommerce store owner to list their store products on Bonanza. The store owner or admin can synchronize the orders, products, pricing, and inventory through establishing the interaction between the Bonanza APIs and the Bonanza marketplace.

With this extension, the admin can manage the Bonanza orders on the WooCommerce stores without making any significant changes in the operational functionalities.

After installing the extension, the merchant can create the Bonanza Categories and the dependent attributes on the WooCommerce store.

The process enables the merchant to configure the desired product category into WooCommerce for automatic submission of the selected product to the same Category on Bonanza.

Features of the extension are as follows:

- **Profile-based product Upload:** Admin can create a profile and map the *Bonanza* category and attributes to the WooCommerce category and attributes, and then after assigning the products to the profile can easily upload products to the *Bonanza Web* site.
- **Synchronized Inventory and Profile Based Pricing:** Inventory Synchronization at regular intervals. products listing is established between WooCommerce and *Bonanza*. Profile-based price increase or decrease.
- **Synchronized Product Editing:** Besides adding the products, any product information changes made on the WooCommerce store reflects on the *Bonanza*.
- **Automated Inventory Updates:** No manual updating is required. Automatic inventory updates are available for the better management.
- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Admin can map many categories of the WooCommerce store to the single category of *Bonanza*.
- **Updates Information:** Changes made in the WooCommerce store reflects on the *Bonanza Web* site.
- **Bulk Upload System:** The merchant has the flexibility to upload any number of products on the *Bonanza Web* site using bulk product upload feature.

2. Prerequisites

Here are some prerequisites that the user has to verify before installing the extension.

- PHP Version 5.5
- Curl extension should be installed on server
- Oauth extension should be installed on server
- WordPress 4.0
- WooCommerce 2.3

Also, the **Prerequisites** tab is available with the extension. The admin can view the *prerequisites*, *Steps to follow*, and the *guidelines*.

To view the prerequisites and timeline

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **Prerequisites** tab.

3. Retrieve API Credentials from the Bonanza Seller Account

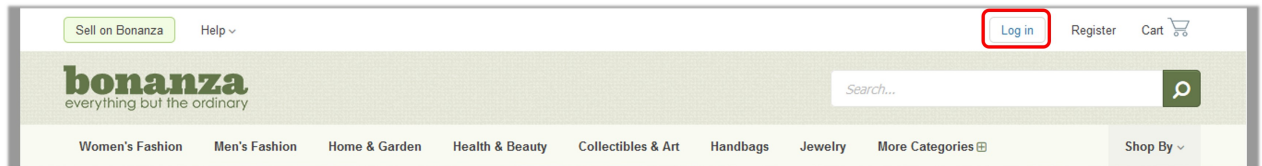
Once the extension is successfully installed on the WooCommerce store, the Bonanza menu appears on the left navigation panel of the WooCommerce Admin Panel. The merchant has to fill-in the **Bonanza DEVELOPER ID** and **BONAPITIT CERTIFICATE ID** details on the **Bonanza CONFIGURATION** page of the admin panel.

To get these API credentials, the store owner has to log in the Bonanza Account.

To retrieve API Key Details from the Bonanza account

1. Go to the <http://www.bonanza.com/>(<http://www.bonanza.com/>) link.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:

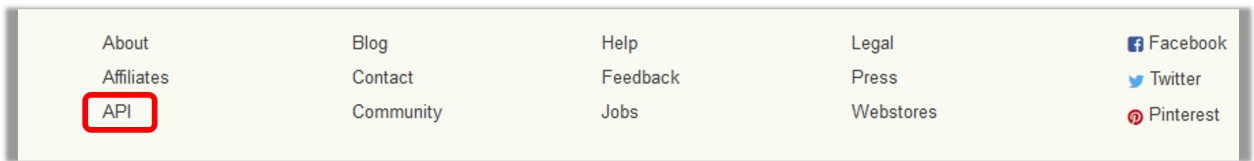


2. In the right-upper corner, click the **Log in** link.

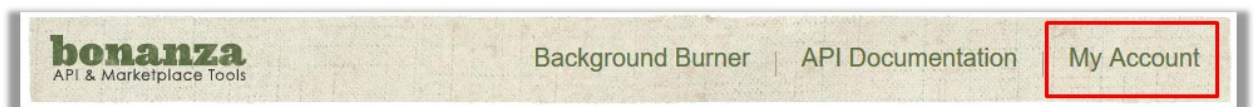

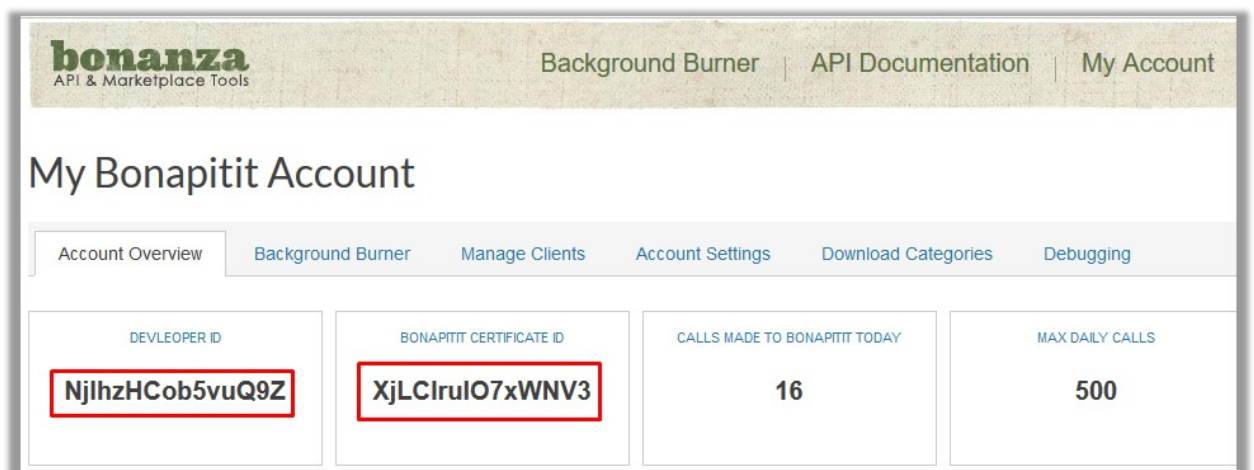
- Enter the login credentials to log in the Bonanza seller account.

- Copy the **DEVELOPER ID** and the **BONAPITIT CERTIFICATE ID** values, and then paste them in the respective fields appearing on the Admin panel of the WooCommerce store.

4. Bonanza Configuration Settings

After obtaining the **Developer ID** and the **Bonapitit Certificate ID** values from the Bonanza Seller account, the WooCommerce store owner has to paste them on the Bonanza Configuration page of the admin panel of the merchant.

To Set up the Bonanza Configuration settings in the WooCommerce Admin panel

- Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
- On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
- In the right panel, click the **CONFIGURATION** tab

The **BONANZA CONFIGURATION** page appears as shown in the following figure:

4. In the **Bonanza DEVELOPER ID** box, paste the value of the **DEVELOPER ID** copied from the Bonanza seller account.
5. In the **Bonapitit Certificate ID** box, paste the value of the **Bonapitit Certificate ID** copied from the Bonanza seller account.
6. Click the **Save Credentials** button.
7. Click the **Authorize** button to authorize the account.

5. Category Mapping

The **CATEGORY MAPPING** page lists all the Bonanza categories. Admin has to select the Bonanza categories to which the products need to be assigned.

To select the required categories for mapping

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **CATEGORY MAPPING** tab.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:

4. Click the **FETCH CATEGORIES** button to fetch all the categories from bonanza.com.
5. Under **Root Categories**, click the required category.

Next level categories list appears. click the required category.

Note: Keep clicking the every next level required categories, until the last level categories list and the corresponding check boxes appear as shown in the following figure:

6. Select the check boxes associated with the required categories.

The selected categories are saved and a success message appears on the page.

6. Manage Profiles

Profile based product uploading provides the admin a facility to create a group of the required products those have common meta-keys, and then upload those products at one go through uploading that profile (created group). In other words, admin can create a new profile and assign it to the group of those products, and then upload the profile on Bonanza; it saves the time of making the same changes in each meta-keys of each and every product.

It means, rather than making the changes in the common meta-keys of each and every product, admin can create a profile and assign it to all the products having common meta-keys, and thus make the changes in the meta-keys available on the profile page.

While creating and editing the profile, admin can select the product and the corresponding meta-keys. These meta-keys are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

Admin can perform the following tasks:

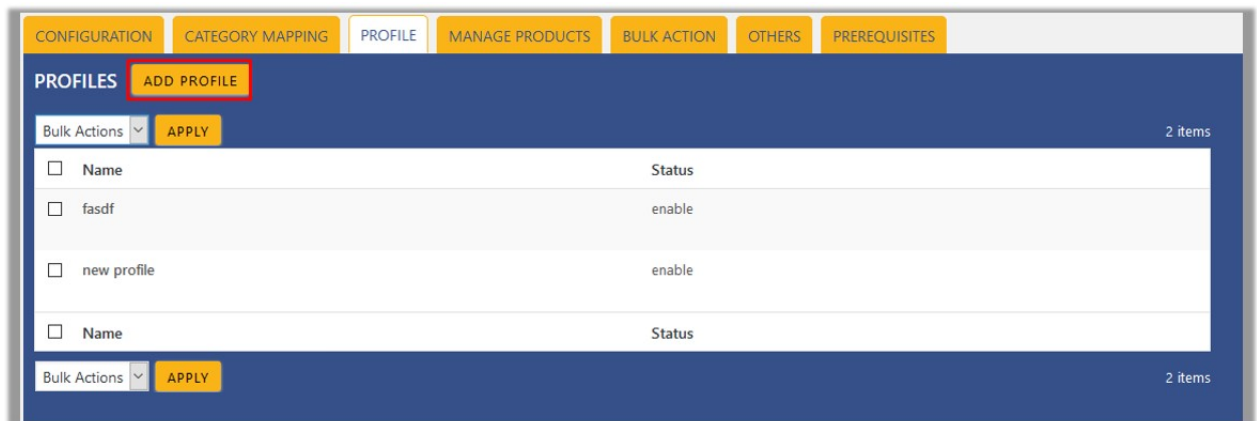

6.1. Add A New Profile

To add a new profile

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **PROFILE** tab.

The **PROFILES** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Click the **ADD PROFILE** button.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:



Note: Click the **INSTRUCTION TO USE** tab, to view the instruction.

5. Click the **SELECT PRODUCT AND CORRESPONDING METAKEYS** tab.

6. In the **Type Product Name Here** box, enter the required product name to get the attributes of the entered product name.

Note: Enter the initial of the product and a list appears. Select the required one from the list.

7. In the **Meta Field Key** column, select the check boxes associated with the required meta-keys.

8. Click the **SAVE PROFILE** button.

Saves the selected meta keys.

9. Scroll down to the **PROFILE INFORMATION** tab, and then click the tab.

The section appears as shown in the following figure:

10. Click the **BASIC** tab.

11. Under **BASIC**, do the following steps:

- a. In the **Profile Name** box, enter the name of the profile.
- b. Select the check box associated with the **Enable Profile** field.

12. Click the **ADVANCE** tab.

- In the select list associated with the **SKU** box, select the required meta key.
OR
In the **SKU** box, enter the required value.
Note: The value entered in the box is applicable to all the products assigned to the profile.
Whereas, selecting the meta key from the list selects the individual value of the individual product.
- In the select list associated with the **UPC** box, select the required meta key.
OR
In the **UPC** box, enter the required value.
Note: The value entered in the box is applicable to all the products assigned to the profile.
Whereas, selecting the meta key from the list selects the individual value of the individual product.
- Similarly, enter the values in other fields if required.

d. Scroll down to the **Bonanza Category** field.



e. In the **Bonanza Category** list, select the required category for mapping.

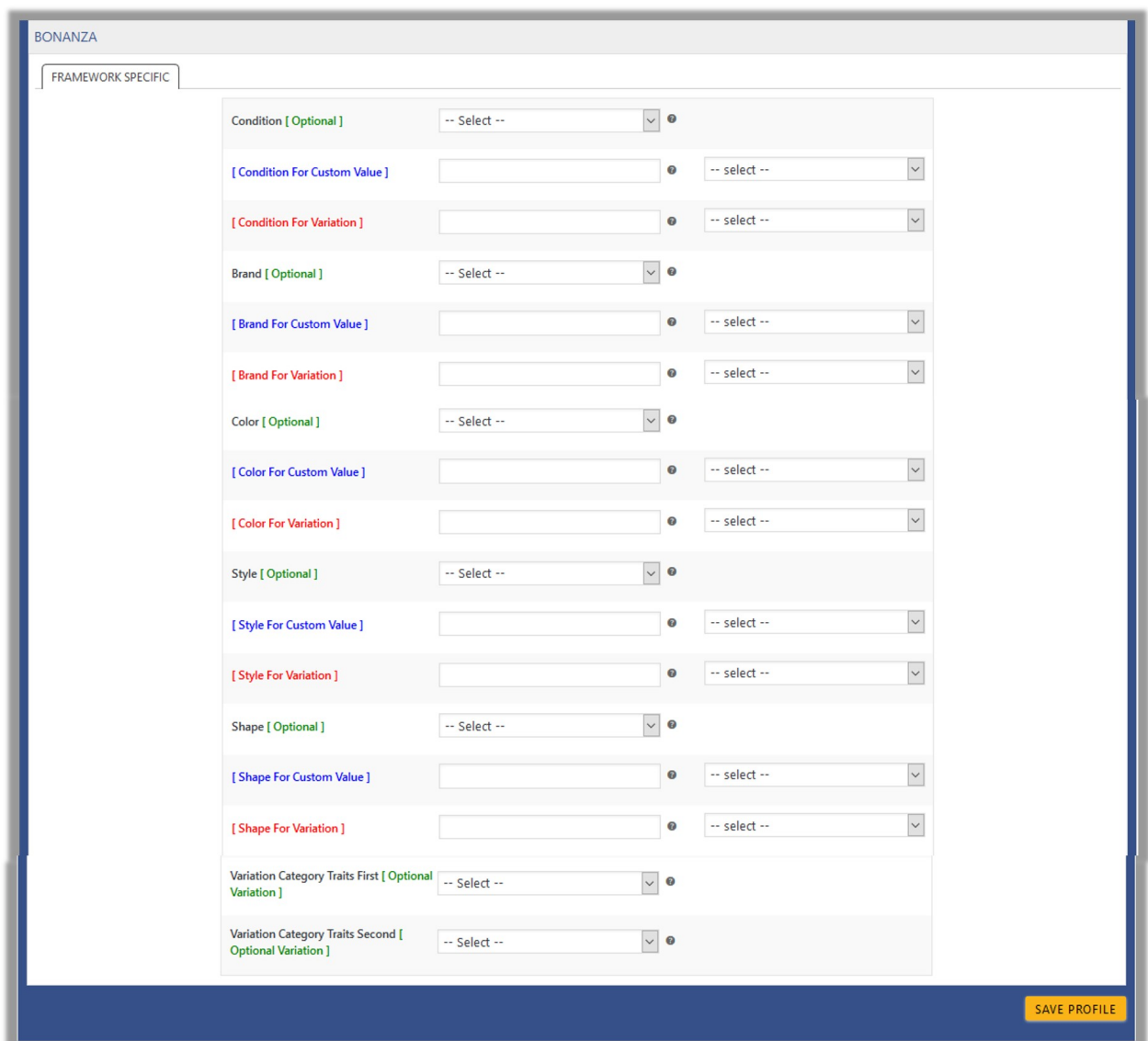
It enables the admin to map only one category to one profile.

Note: These meta-keys are applicable to all the products, the profile is assigned to. Leave the field empty if the specific value is required based on a specific product.

13. Click the **SAVE PROFILE** button.

14. Scroll down to the **BONANZA** tab, and then click the tab.

Based on the selected **Bonanza Category**, the various traits fields appear under the section as shown in the following figure:



Here, other than the regular traits fields based on the selected category, the facilities to provide the custom traits value and the variation traits value are available.

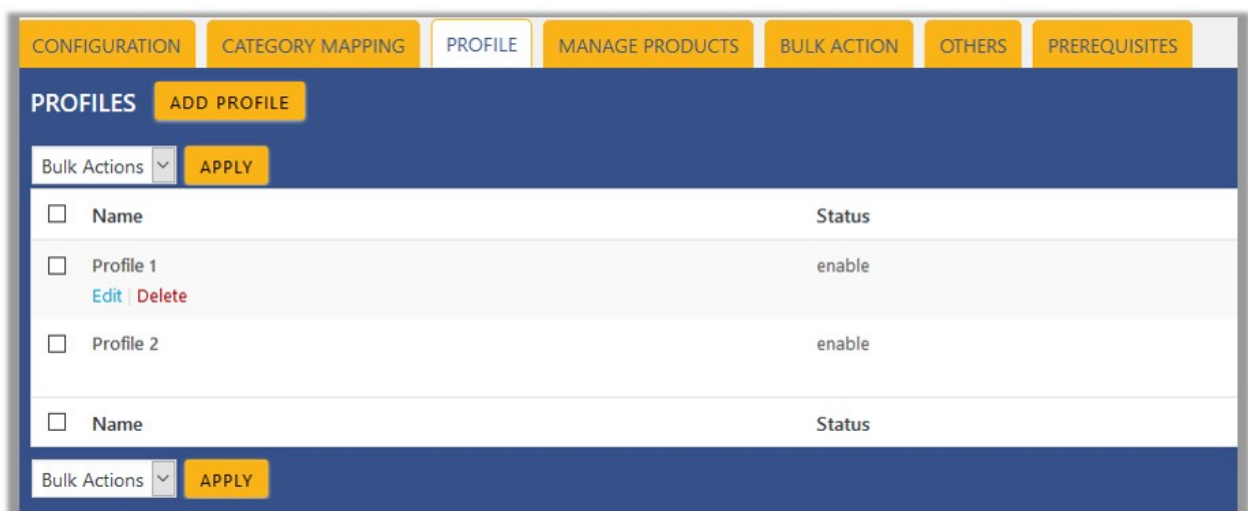
- **Custom Value** is the value other than the values provided by Bonanza for the specific traits.
 - **Variation** means a deviation from the standard model or pattern such as the variation of colors, size, metal, and so on.
15. In the **Color [Optional]** list, select the required value.
 16. In the select list associated with the **[Color For Custom Value]** box, select the required meta key.
OR
In the **[Color For Custom Value]** box, enter the required value.
Note: The value entered in the box is applicable to all the products assigned to the profile. Whereas, selecting the meta key from the list selects the individual value of the individual product.
 17. In the select list associated with the **[Color For Variation]** box, select the required meta key.
OR
In the **[Color For Variation]** box, enter the required value.
Note: The value entered in the box is applicable to all the products assigned to the profile. Whereas, selecting the meta key from the list selects the individual value of the individual product.
 18. Similarly, enter the values in the required traits fields.
Note: Bonanza allows only two variations to be displayed on the front end view. The admin has to select and prioritize the variations to get displayed on the front end view. For instance, the **Variation Category Traits First [Optional Variation]** and **Variation Category Traits Second [Optional Variation]** fields.
 19. In the **Variation Category Traits First [Optional Variation]** list, select the trait to set it as a **first** variation.
 20. In the **Variation Category Traits Second [Optional Variation]** list, select the trait to set it as a **Second** variation.
 21. Click the **Save Profile** button.

6.2. Edit the Existing Profile

To edit the existing profile

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **PROFILE** tab.

4. Move the cursor over the required profile to edit.
The [Edit](#) and the [Delete](#) links appear as shown in the figure.

- Click the **Edit** link.

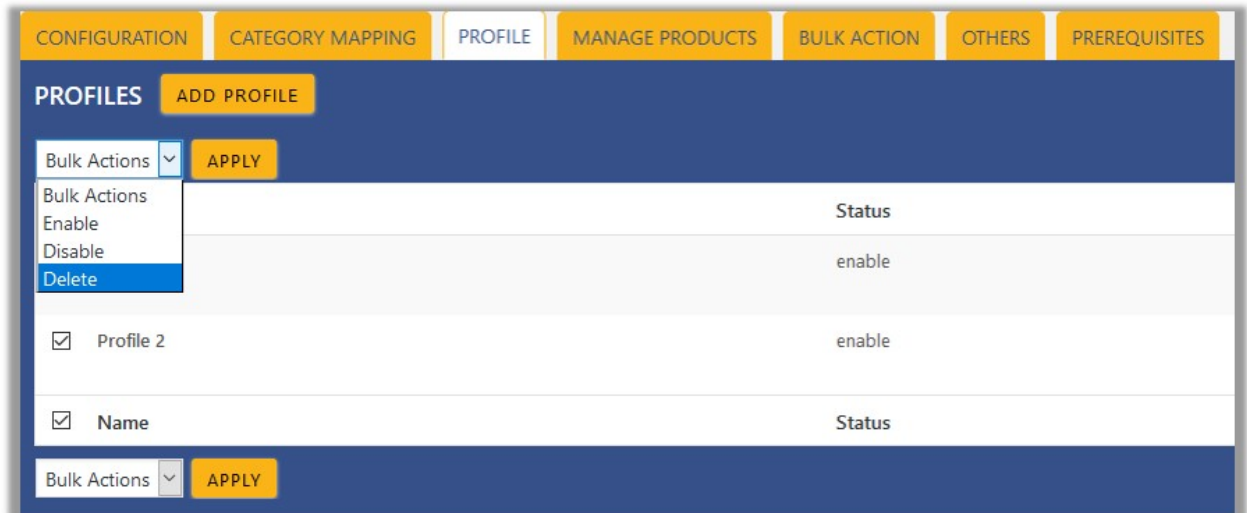

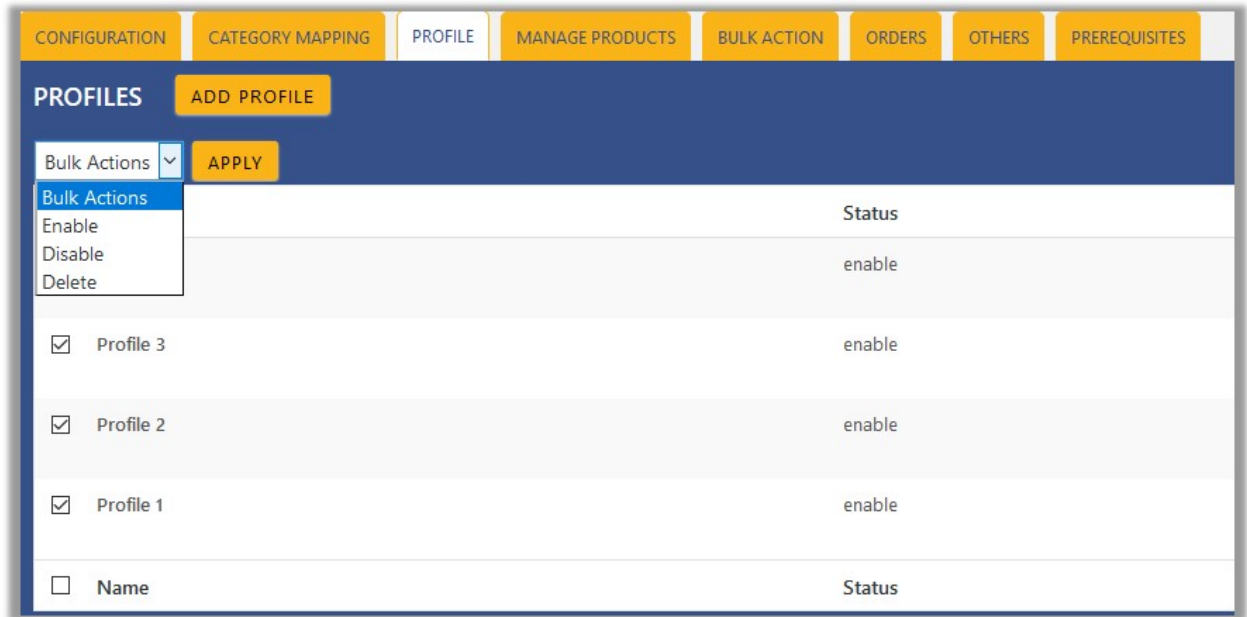
4. Select the check boxes associated with the required profiles.

6.4. Enable the selected Disabled Profiles in Bulk

To enable the selected disabled profiles in bulk

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **PROFILE** tab.

The page appears as shown in the following figure:

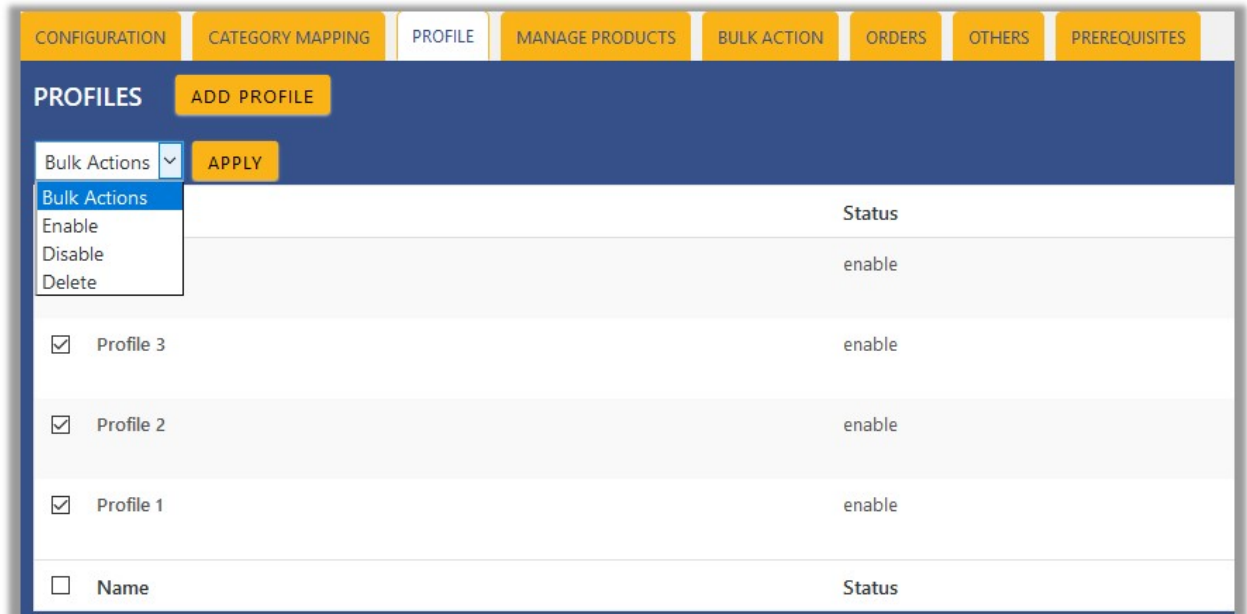


4. Select the check boxes associated with the required profiles.
 5. In the **Bulk Actions** list, select **Enable**.
 6. Click the **Apply** button.
- The selected profiles are enabled.

6.5. Disable the selected enabled Profiles in Bulk

To disable the selected enabled profiles in bulk

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
 3. In the right panel, click the **PROFILE** tab.
- The page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Select the check boxes associated with the required profiles.
 5. In the **Bulk Actions** list, select **Disable**.
 6. Click the **Apply** button.
- The selected profiles are disabled.

7. Manage Products

Admin can view all the products details such as the assigned profile name, product selling price, and the product inventory.

Admin can edit the product meta-keys and assign the profile to the products. Also, can upload the selected products to the Bonanza marketplace.

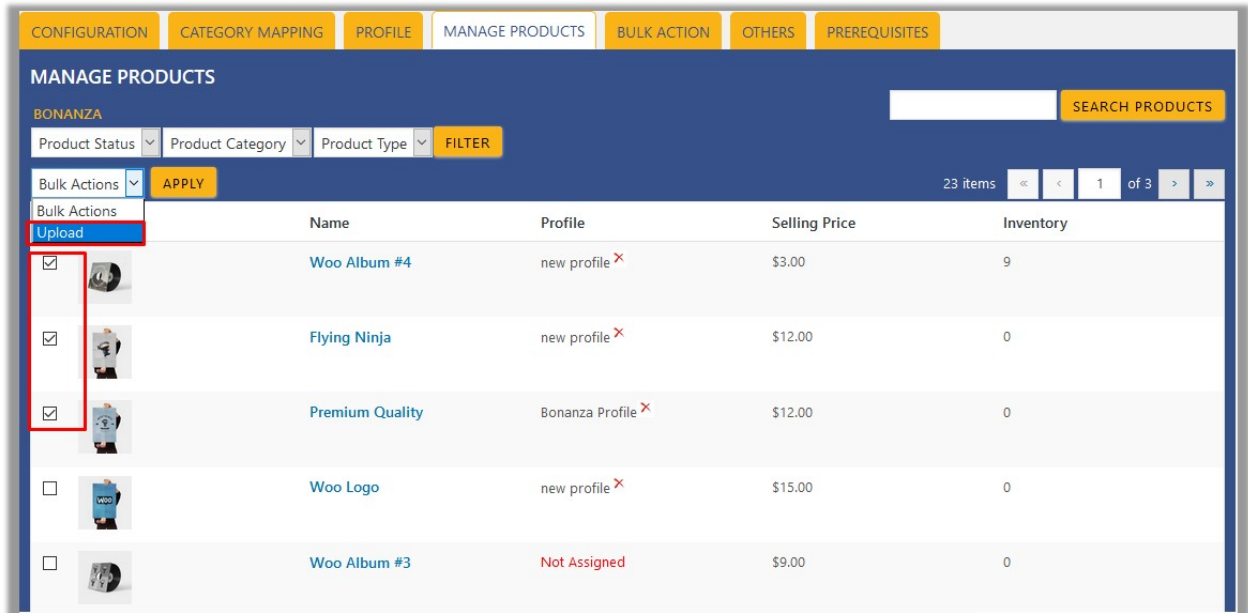

7.1. Upload the Selected Products

To upload the selected products

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **MANAGE PRODUCTS** tab.
The **MANAGE PRODUCTS** page appears as shown in the following figure:

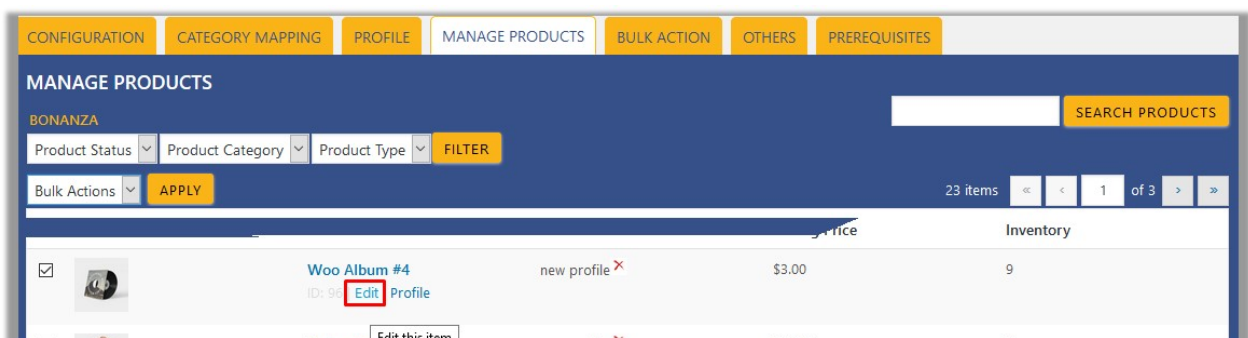


4. Select the check boxes associated with the required products to upload.
5. Click the **Arrow** button next to the **Bulk Actions** field, click **Upload**, and then click the **Apply** button.
The selected products are uploaded and a success message appears.

7.2. Edit the Product

To edit the product

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **MANAGE PRODUCTS** tab.
The **MANAGE PRODUCTS** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Move the cursor over the required product to edit.
The **Edit** and the **Profile** links appear as shown in the figure.

5. Click the **Edit** link.
The Edit Product page appears.
6. Scroll down to the Settings area.
7. In the left navigation panel, click the **Bonanza** tab.

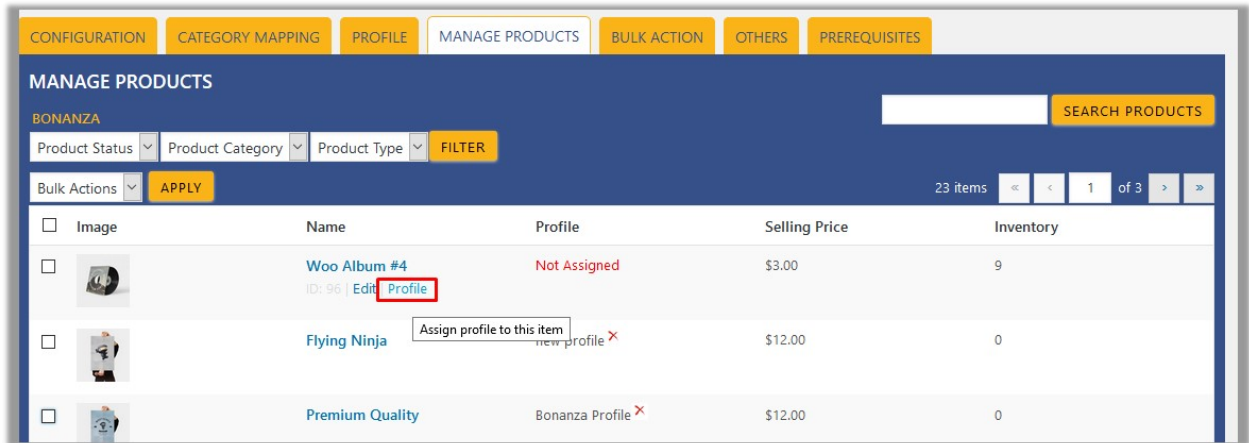

9. In the right panel, click the **Update** button.
Note: After making any changes to the product, **make sure that the product is uploaded again on Bonanza.**

7.3. Assign the Profile to the Product

To assign the profile to the product

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **MANAGE PRODUCTS** tab.
The **MANAGE PRODUCTS** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Move the cursor over the required product to assign the profile.
The **Edit** and the **Profile** links appear as shown in the figure.

5. Click the **Profile** link.
A dialog box appears as shown in the following figure:



6. In the **AVAILABLE PROFILE** list, select the profile to assign it to the individual product.

7. Click the **SAVE PROFILE** button.

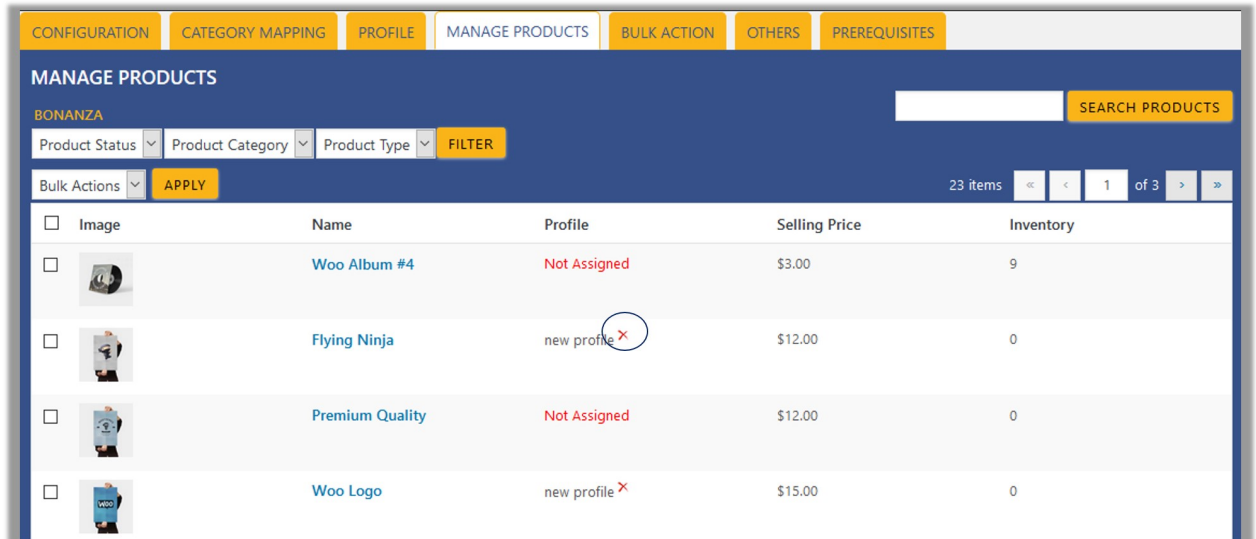
The profile is assigned to the product.

7.4. Remove the Assignment of the Profile

To remove the assignment of the profile

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **MANAGE PRODUCTS** tab.

The **MANAGE PRODUCTS** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Scroll down to the required product.
The product from which the profile assignment needs to be removed.
5. In the **Profile** column of the required product, click the cross icon associated with the profile name.
The assigned profile is removed from the product, and the **Not Assigned** link appears.

8. Bulk Action

With this feature, the admin has an ability to perform the following Bulk actions:

- Assign the selected profile to the category.(<https://docs.cedcommerce.com/woocommerce/woocommerce-bonanza-integration-admin-guide?section=bulk-profile-assignment-3>)
Thus, the selected profile is assigned to all the products that come under the category.
- Upload the selected categories to Bonanza(<https://docs.cedcommerce.com/woocommerce/woocommerce-bonanza-integration-admin-guide?section=bulk-product-upload-4>)
. Also, can select the required products to upload and exclude the products not to upload on Bonanza.

8.1. Bulk Profile Assignment

To perform bulk profile assignment

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **BULK ACTION** tab.

1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Bonanza** menu.
3. In the right panel, click the **BULK ACTION** tab.

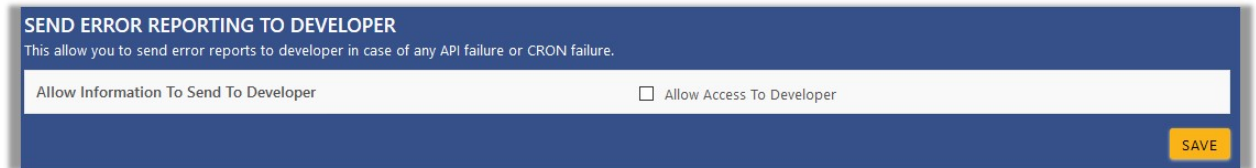
1. Go to the WooCommerce Admin panel.
