

WooCommerce Fruugo Integration Guide 0.0.1

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1. Overview

Founded in 2006, Fruugo is a UK based e-commerce company, which is a global marketplace offering thousands of sellers to cater services of sports and leisure, health and beauty, clothing, home and garden, kids, toys and more. It operates in 23 countries across the globe with great products and enthusiasm to deliver it to the customers.



WooCommerce Fruugo Integration is a fabulous API integration that helps the WooCommerce store owners to synchronize inventory, price, and other product details for product creation and management between the WooCommerce store and Fruugo marketplace.

The **WooCommerce Fruugo Integration** extension interacts with Fruugo marketplace to integrate the synchronized product listing between WooCommerce and Fruugo retailers. After the installation, the store owner can create Fruugo categories and the dependent attributes on the WooCommerce store.

The process enables the store owner to configure the desired product category into WooCommerce for automatic submission of the selected product in the same category on Fruugo.

Key features are as follows:

- **Upload product based on profile:** An admin can create a profile, map the Fruugo category and attributes to the WooCommerce category and attributes. Then, after assigning the product to the profile can easily upload the product to Fruugo.
- **Batch product request download:** You can create the batch product download request and fetch the status. Once it turns to finish status, the admin can process by one click.
- **Upload Products in Bulk:** The admin has the option to upload the products in any number of the bulk amount on Fruugoweb site using this feature.
- **Attribute mapping:** The feature allows mapping the suitable existing attribute with Fruugo attributes to one single category of Fruugo.
- **Automated Synchronization:** The products listing, order, inventory return and refund, and pricing are automatically synchronized at regular interval of time.
- **Enable and disable of products:** A merchant can anytime open and close the products on Fruugo using enable and disable the feature.
- **Order Notification:** Whenever a new product is fetched from Fruugo.com, the admin receives a notification when a new product is made or when admin receives the notification.
- **Rejected products notification:** If any product containing some invalid details is rejected, then its information is fetched from the automatically synchronized request along with the error due to which it is rejected.
- **Simple and configurable product upload:** Admin can upload the simple and configurable type of WooCommerce product on the Fruugo website.


2. Fruugo Configuration Settings

Once the extension is successfully installed in the WooCommerce store, the **Fruugo** menu appears on the left navigation bar of the Admin Panel. The WooCommerce store owner has to first create a seller account in the


Fruugo seller panel. Once the seller account is created and is approved by Fruugo, then the store owner can use the **Fruugo Username** and **Password** while setting up the Fruugo Configuration settings in the WooCommerce Admin panel.

To set up the configuration settings in the WooCommerce Admin panel

1. Go to the **WooCommerce Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Fruugo** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click **Configuration**.
The menu moves to the left navigation bar, below Fruugo as shown in the following figure:


4. In the **Enter User Name** box, enter the Fruugo seller account Username.
5. In the **Enter User Password** box, enter the Fruugo seller account Password.
6. Click the **Save Credentials** button.

3. Category Mapping


The **CATEGORY MAPPING** page lists all the Fruugo categories. The WooCommerce store owner has to select the Fruugo categories to which the products need to be assigned.

To select the required categories for mapping

1. Go to the **WooCommerce Admin** panel.
2. Go to the left navigation bar.



3. Under **Fruugo**, click **Category Mapping**.
The **FRUUGO CATEGORY** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Under **Root Categories**, click the required category.

Next level categories list appears. Click the required category.

Note: Keep clicking every next level required categories until the last level categories list and the corresponding checkboxes appear as shown in the following figure:

5. Select the check boxes associated with the required categories.

The selected categories are saved and a success message appears on the page.

4. Manage Profiles

Profile-based product uploading provides the store owner a facility to create a group of the required products those have common meta-keys, and then upload those products at one go through uploading that profile (created group). In other words, the store owner can create a new profile and assign it to the group of those products, and then upload the profile on Fruugo; it saves the time of making the same changes in each meta-keys of each and every product.

It means, rather than making the changes in the common meta-keys of each and every product, the store owner can create a profile and assign it to all the products having common meta-keys, and thus make the changes in the meta-keys available on the profile page.

While creating and editing the profile, the store owner can select the product and the corresponding meta-keys. These meta-keys are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

The store owner can perform the following tasks:




4.1. Add A New Profile

To add a new profile

1. Go to the **WooCommerce Admin** panel.
2. Go to the left navigation bar.



3. Under **Fruugo**, click **Profile**.
The **PROFILES** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. Click the **ADD PROFILE** button.

Profile can be created to assign similar type of values and categories to multiple products.

1. Use "Select Product And Corresponding MetaKeys" section to select the metakeys of product you consider can be useful in mapping. Once you select the metakeys click on UPDATE. This step is not always necessary. If you have done it before, you can skip it for the next time you create a profile.
2. Under "BASIC SETTINGS" tab, you have option to setup basic information for your profile. Here you can give your profile a name and enable/disable it.
3. Under "REQUIRED FIELDS" sections, you have to fill in all the details that are mandatory for the products.
4. After Required Fields its time to select the fruugo category from "fruugo CATEGORY" section. Once you select the category you will get fields for variation products that need to be filled in if you wish to list variation products on fruugo
5. Once done with above steps you can fill in the Extra information that can be sent with the products under "EXTRA FIELDS" section.
6. If you have read above instructions carefully, you are good to go.

5. Under **Select Product MetaKeys**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Type Product Name Here** box, enter the required product name to get the attributes of the entered product name.

Note: Enter the initial of the product and a list appears. Select the required one from the list.
 - b. In the **Meta Field Key** column, select the check boxes associated with the required meta-keys.
6. Under **BASIC**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Profile Name** box, enter the name of the profile.
 - b. Select the check-box associated with the **Enable Profile** field.
7. Under **Required Fields**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Identifier Type** list, select the required value.
 - b. In the select list associated with the **Identifier Value** box, select the required meta key.

OR

 In the **Identifier Value** box, enter the required value.

Note: The value entered in the box is applicable to all the products assigned to the profile. Whereas, selecting the meta key from the list selects the individual value of the individual product.
 - c. In the select list associated with the **Product Brand** box, select the required meta key.

OR

 In the **Product Brand** box, enter the required value.
 - d. In the select list associated with the **Product Vat** box, select the required meta key.

OR


 In the **Product Vat** box, enter the required value.
 - e. In the **Fruugo Category** list, select the required category for mapping.

It enables the admin to map only one category to one profile.
8. Under **Extra Fields**, similarly, enter the required values in the required fields.
9. Click the **SAVE PROFILE** button. **Note: These meta-keys are applicable to all the products, the profile is assigned to. Leave the field empty if the specific value is required based on a specific product.**

4.2. Edit the Existing Profile

To edit the existing profile

1. Go to the **WooCommerce Admin** panel.
2. Go to the left navigation bar.



3. Under **Fruugo**, click **Profile**.




4.3. Delete the Profiles

2. Go to the left navigation bar.














