

Catch Integration For PrestaShop

by CedCommerce Products Documentation

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1. Overview

Prestashop store owners can now integrate their Prestashop stores with Catch marketplace with the help of CedCommerce and can increase the sale of their business. Catch.com.au is one of the biggest Australian online retailers which opened an online marketplace for third-party (3P) merchants to market their goods on.

Catch Integration for the Prestashop Stores enables the admin to manage the Catch orders in their Prestashop stores without making any significant changes to the operational functionalities. This extension interacts with the Catch Marketplace to integrate the synchronized product listing between Prestashop store and the Catch retailers.

This Integration extension synchronizes the orders, products, pricing, and inventory through establishing the communication between Catch APIs and the Prestashop store.

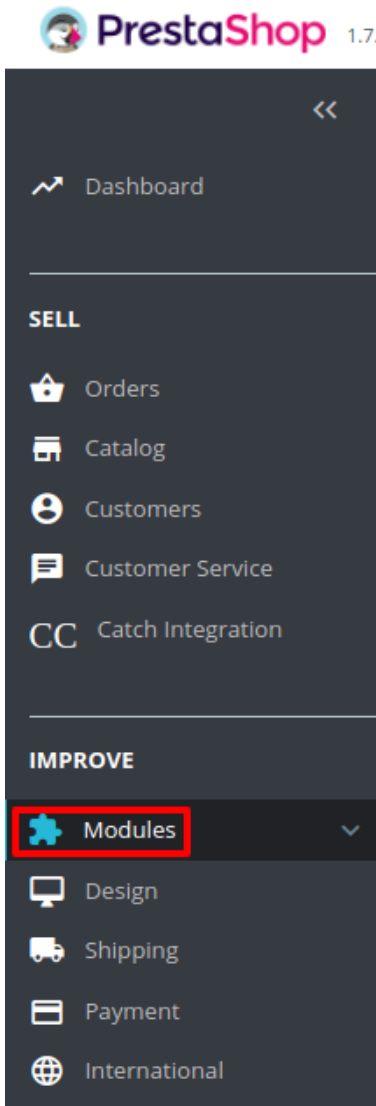
Key Features of Catch Integration Extension by CedCommerce:

- **Profile Based Product Upload:** Admin can create a profile and map the category and attributes to Prestashop store category and attributes. Then, after assigning the product to the profile can easily upload the product to Catch.
- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Enables the admin to map many categories of the Prestashop stores to the single category of Catch.
- **Synchronized Inventory and Profile Based Pricing:** Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and product listings along with all the details is established between Prestashop store and Catch. Profile-based price increase or decrease.
- **Easy Order Import:** Easy import of orders from Catch marketplace to Prestashop panel.
- **New Order Notifications:** Whenever a new order is fetched from Catch.com, the admin receives a notification.
- **Creation of Prestashop Orders:** Newly placed orders on Catch.com are automatically created in the Prestashop store as well with all the required details as on Catch.
- **Rejected products notification:** If any product containing some invalid details is rejected, then its information is fetched from the auto synchronization request along with the error due to which it is rejected.
- **Easy Debug:** Easy debug process for hassle-free products upload on the Catch website.
- **Crons:** Cron job automates the process for Inventory, Price, and Order management.

2. Catch PrestaShop Extension Installation

To install the extension:

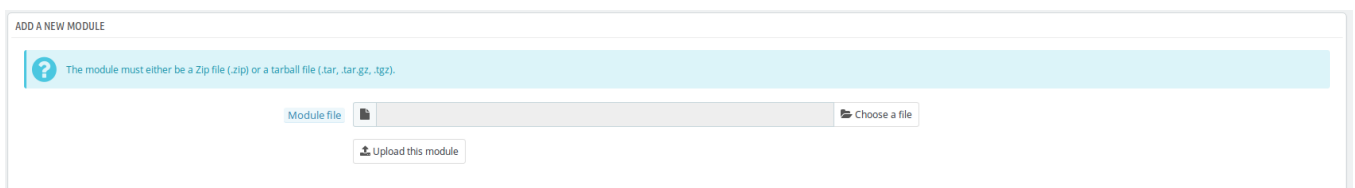
- Go to the **Prestashop Admin panel**.
- On the left navigation bar, point cursor to the **Modules and Services**.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



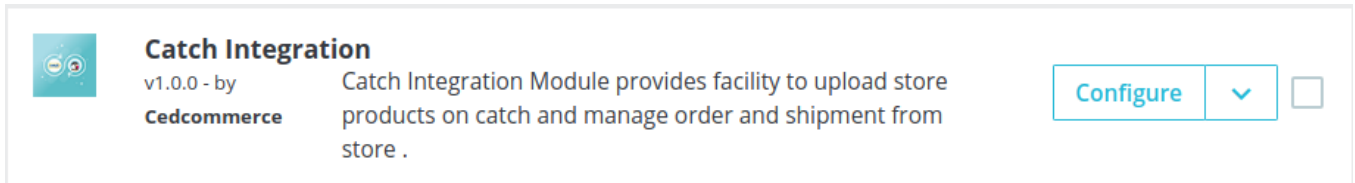
- Now click the **Modules Manager** menu, and you will come across a page like shown below.



- Now you need to click on **Upload a Module** on the top of the page.
- In doing so, the page opens a section like shown in the image below:



- Now in the Module File tab, choose the package file of Catch marketplace from your system.
- Once selected, click on the **Upload this module button**.
- On the same page, scroll down and in the Modules list, search for Catch and it will be listed on the right as shown in the image below. You have to click on the **Install**.



- Once you click on the **Install** button, you can see a message like shown below, on the same page, asking you if you wish to proceed with the installation. You may click on **Proceed with the installation**.
- The module will be installed and you will be navigated to the **Configuration** page for further steps to be taken.

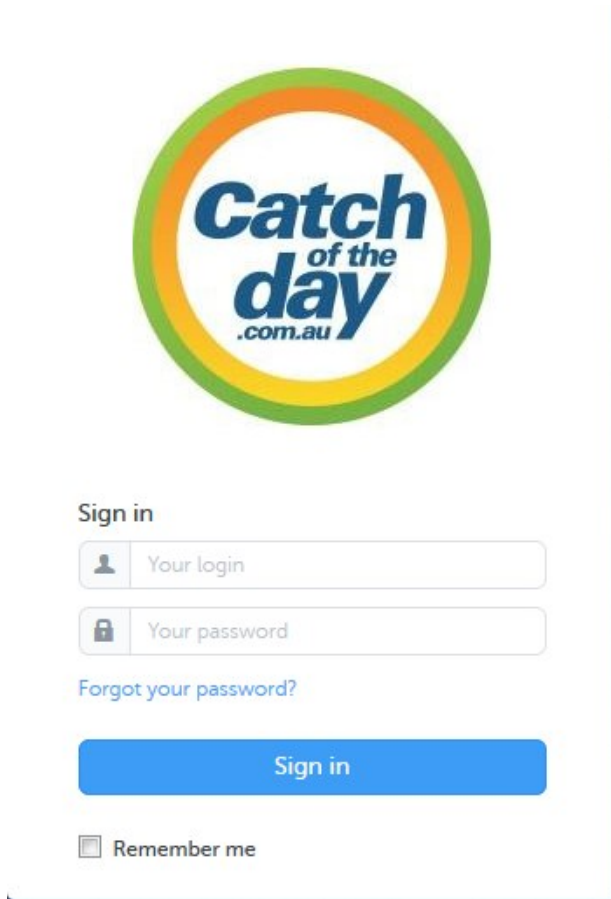
3. Retrieve API credentials from Catch

Once the extension is successfully installed in the Prestashop store, the **CATCH INTEGRATION** menu appears on the left navigation bar of the Admin Panel. The store owner has to fill out the retrieved the **API Key** value in the respective field displayed on the **Catch Configuration** page of the admin panel.

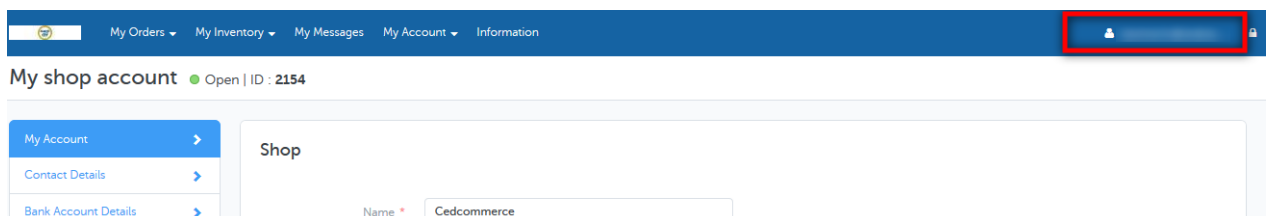
To retrieve the API Key from the Catch Seller Account

1. Go to the <https://catch-dev.mirakl.net>(<https://catch-dev.mirakl.net/>) link for Sandbox Mode. Or Go to the <https://marketplace.catch.com.au/login>(<https://marketplace.catch.com.au/login>) link for Live Mode. *(It should be in accordance with the Mode that you will be choosing while doing the Configuration).*

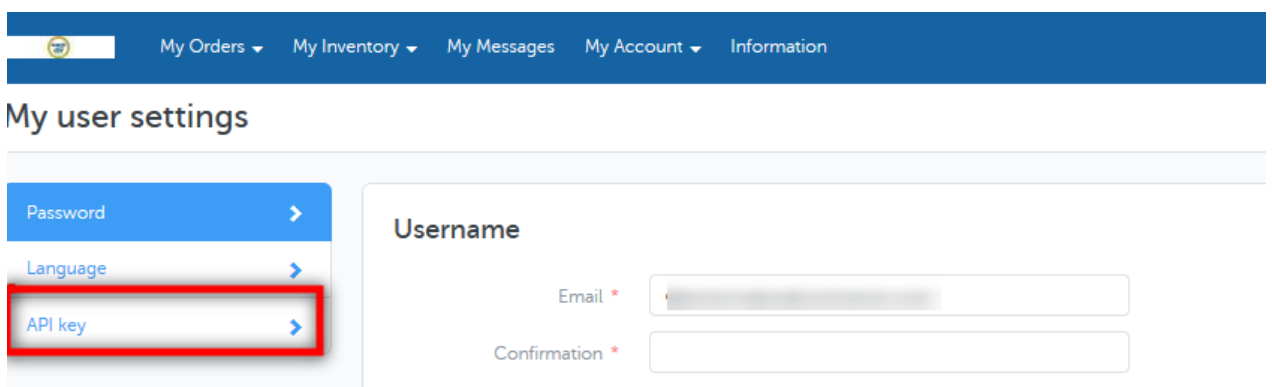

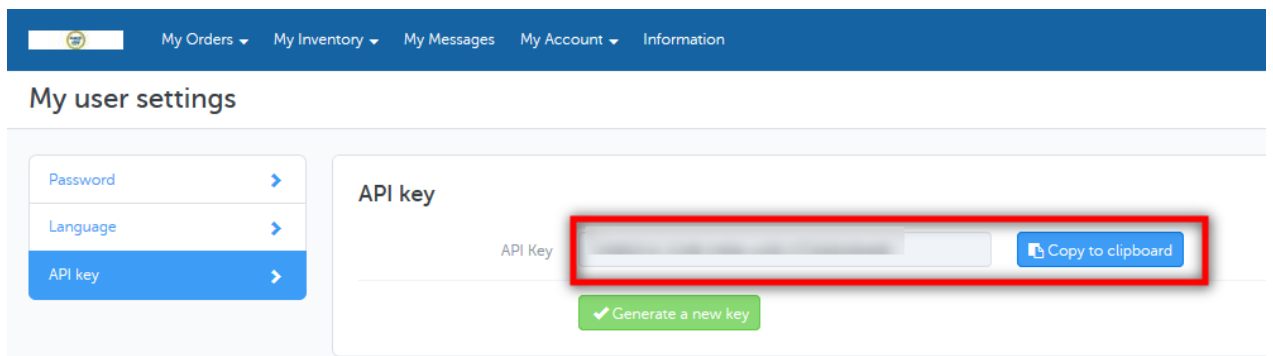
2. Enter the login credentials, and then click the **Sign In** button.

The **API Key** value appears in the right panel as shown in the following figure:



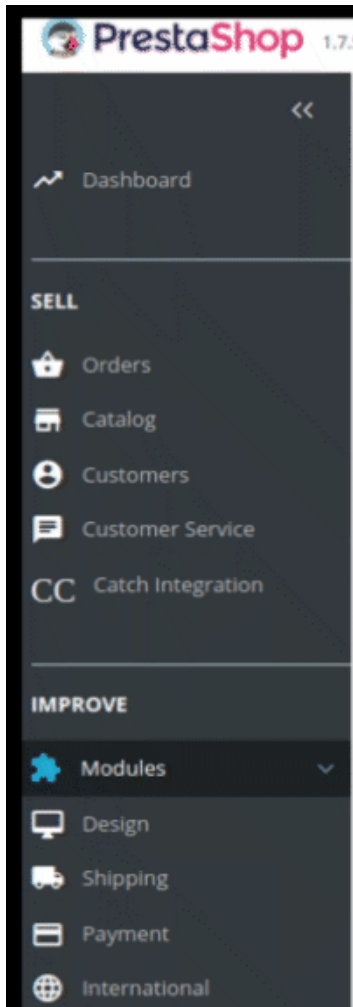
- Click the **Copy to clipboard** button to copy the API key value.

4. Catch Configuration Settings

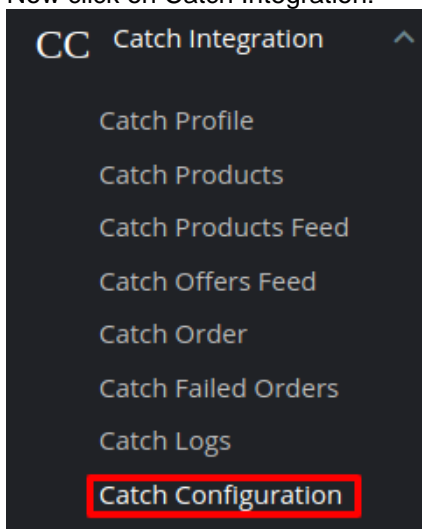

- In **Debug Mode**, select **Enable** if you want the Debug log to be created.

- In the **Customer Order Mail**, you need to provide the Email to create order on the store which is imported from Catch.
- Enter the **Customer Id** in the next section. Customer Id is a unique id which is used to create order on the Prestashop store which is imported from Catch.
- In the **Order status**, select the current order status which appears by default.
- In the **Order status when acknowledge**, select the order status to appear when the order has been acknowledged.
- In the **Order status when shipped**, select the order status to appear when the order has been shipped.
- In the **Order Carrier**, select the order carrier set for particular orders while importing the Catch order.
- In the **Order Payment**, select the order payment method set for each order while importing the Catch order.
- In **Auto Order Acknowledge/Reject**, if **Yes** is selected, the order will be automatically accepted or

rejected based on fulfillment status.

5. Manage Catch Profiles

Admin can create a new profile and assign the required products to the profile. While creating and editing the profile, admin can map the Prestashop attributes to the Catch attributes. These attributes are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

Admin can do the following tasks:

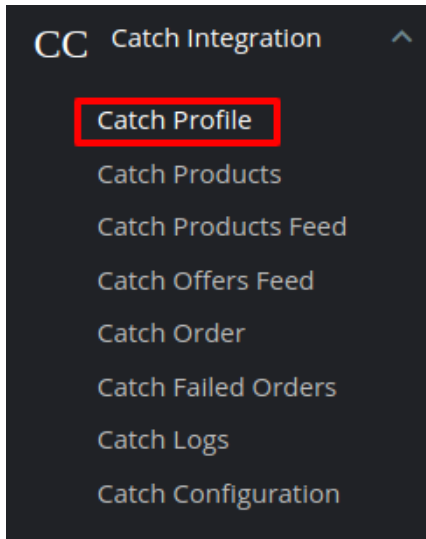
- Add a new profile

5.1. Add A New Profile

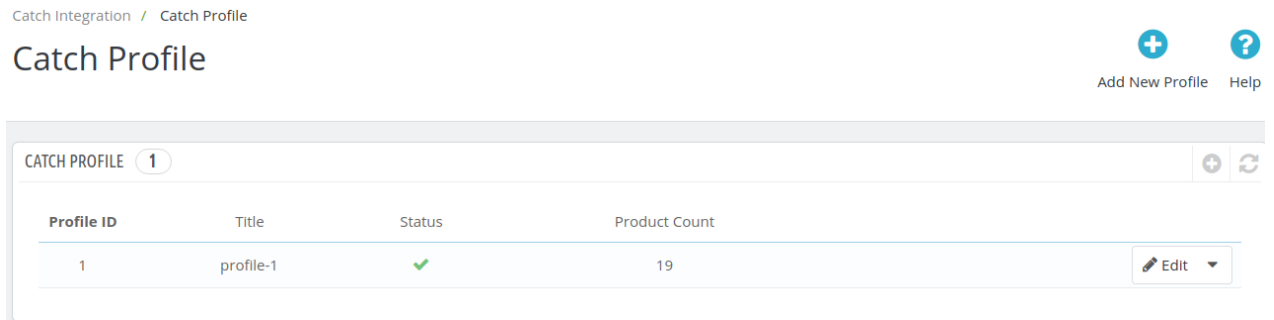
Note: A profile is where you may assign multiple products to be sold on Catch from the Prestashop store.

To add a new profile

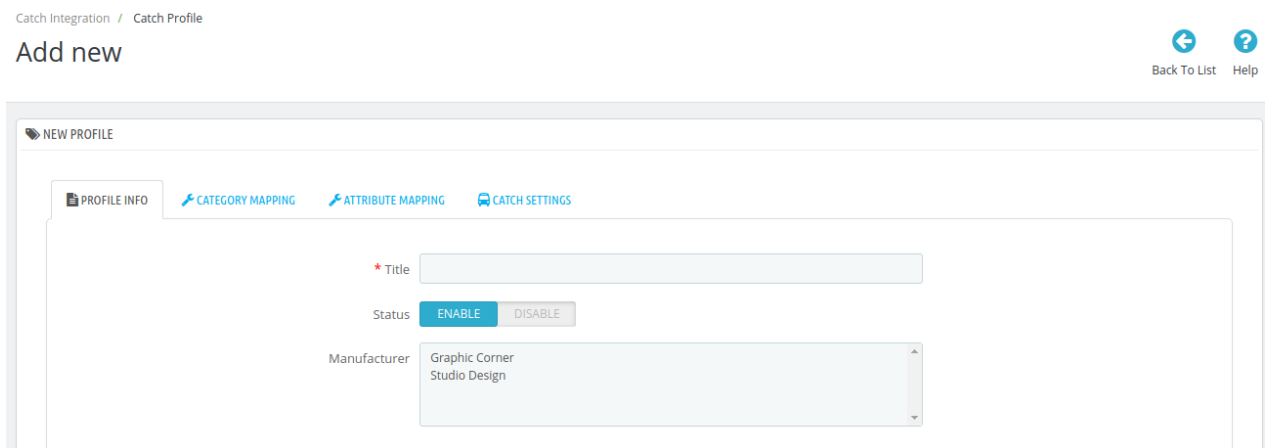
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on Catch Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:



- Click on **Catch Profile** and you will be navigated to a page as shown below:

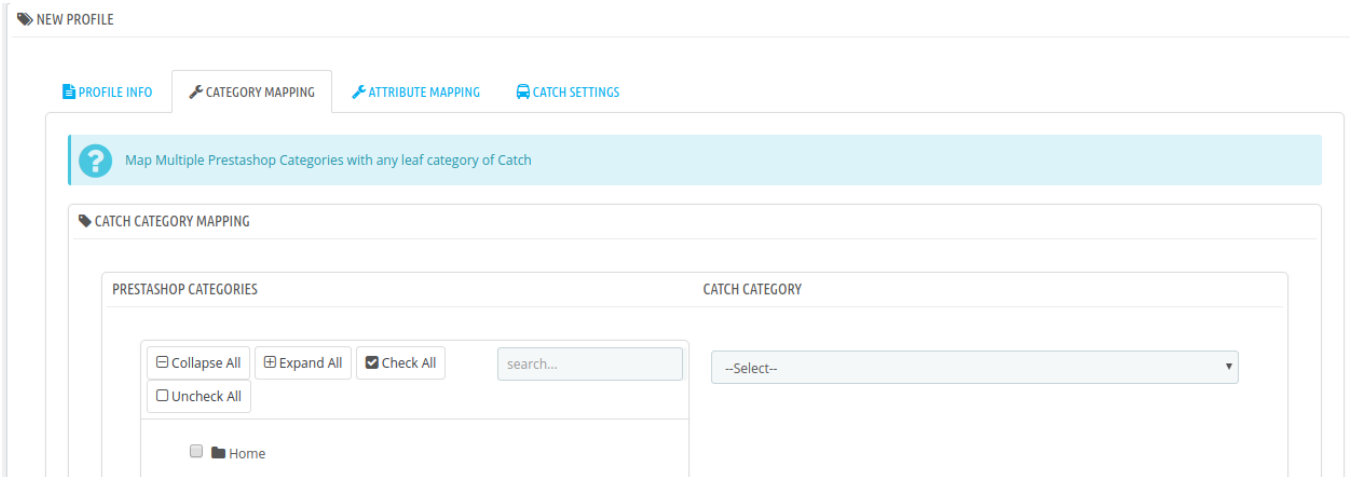


- Click on **Add New Profile**, to add a profile. On clicking, you'll see the page as below:



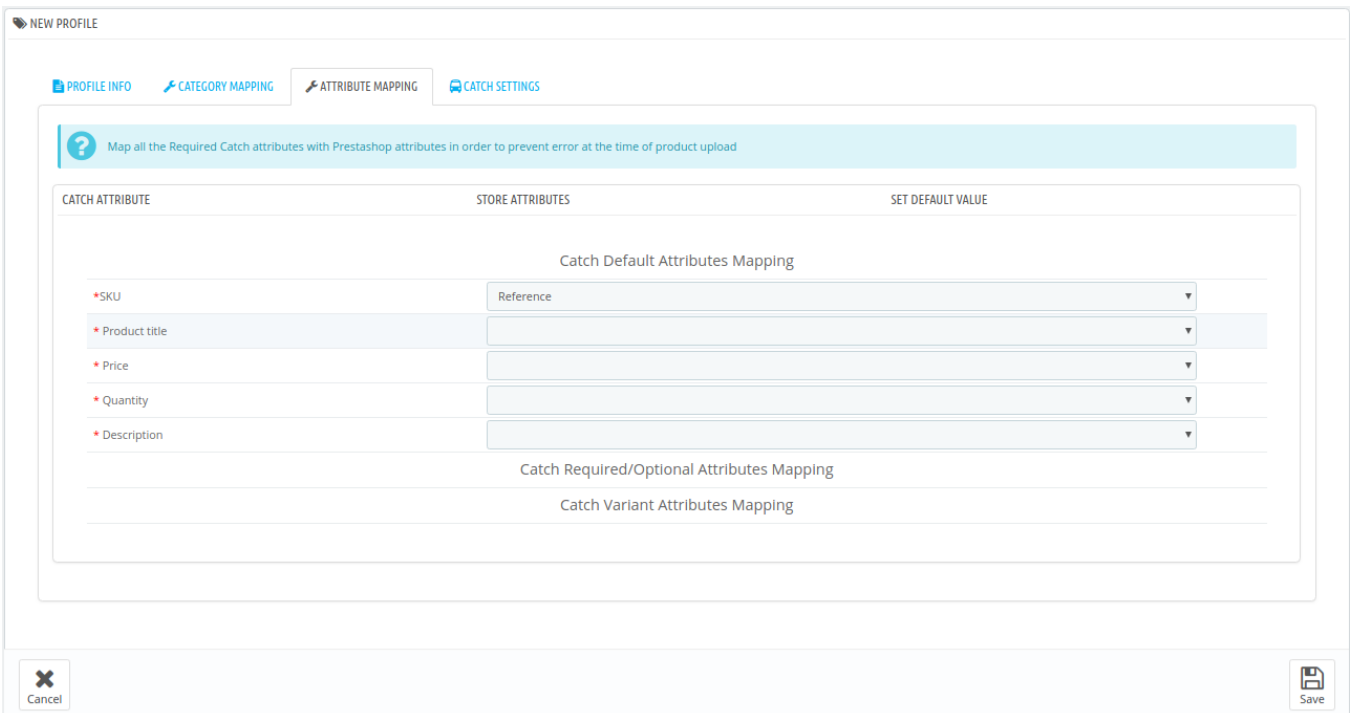
- In the **Title**, enter the name of your profile. This is for your own identification.
- Select **Enable** as the status to enable the profile.
- Choose the desired **Manufacturer** for the profile.

Now move to **category mapping** and the section expands as:



- In this section
 - You have to map your PrestaShop category with **suitable Catch leaf category**.
 - The PrestaShop categories are mentioned on the left & Catch Categories on the right.
 - Map **Multiple Prestashop categories** with a single Catch leaf category.

Now Click on **Attribute Mapping** adjacent to the **Profile Info** tab, and you'll come across a section as below:



- Map the desired Catch attributes with Prestashop store attributes
- The Prestashop attributes mentioned on the right can be selected via the dropdown menu.

Now move on to the last section of the Configuration settings, ie Catch Settings:

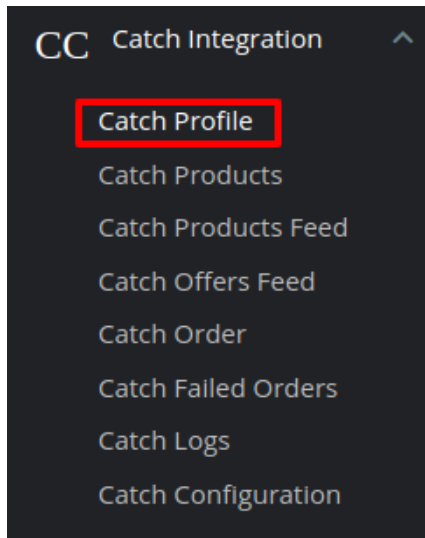
At the bottom of the window, there are 'Cancel' and 'Save' buttons.

- In the **Offer State** enter the current state of the products ie. new or refurbished.
- In **Product Reference Type** select the desired product identifier. This establishes a reference connection between product upload and offer.
- In **Logistic Class**, select the type of weight class the item belongs.
- If you want to allow free delivery or you are a part of catch club then select Yes in **Catch Club Eligible**.
- If you wish to receive an alert when the stock runs below a specific number, then enter the threshold value in **Min Quantity Alert**.
- Enter **Offer Description** and **Offer External Description** in the columns below.
- In the Price Variant type you have the options to select the pricing to be reflected on **Catch** for your products, as shown below:
 - **Increase by Fixed Amount:** If you select this option, a bar gets opened as shown in the image below:
Now suppose if your product price on Prestashop is 100 and you enter 50 in this tab, the price of the product that will be reflected on Catch will be 150 now. It is because you have selected Increase By Fixed Amount and entered 50 in the corresponding field. Suppose, your product is available on Prestashop for 100 and you enter 50 in the corresponding box, then the 50% of your product's Prestashop price will be added to it and it will be reflected on Catch. So now your product will be available on Catch for 150. (As 50% of 100=50.)
 - **Increase by Fixed Percentage:** If you select this option, you may increase the product price by a fixed percentage.
 - **Decrease by Fixed Amount:** It works in the same manner as Increase by Fixed Amount works, **but** it decreases the price of the Prestashop product on Catch marketplace by a fixed amount.
 - **Decrease by Fixed Percentage:** It works in the same manner as Increase by Fixed Percentage works, **but** it decreases the price of the Prestashop product on Catch marketplace by a fixed percentage.
- Click on save button to save the profile

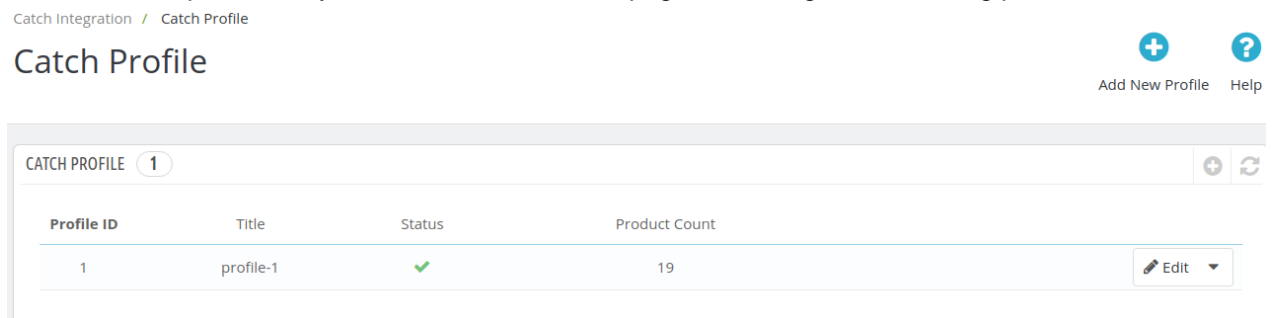
5.2. Edit the Existing Profile

To edit an existing profile:

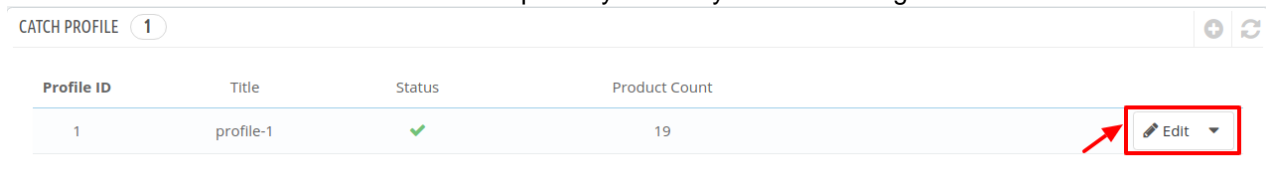
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel

- Click on Catch profile and you will be redirected to a page containing all the existing profiles:



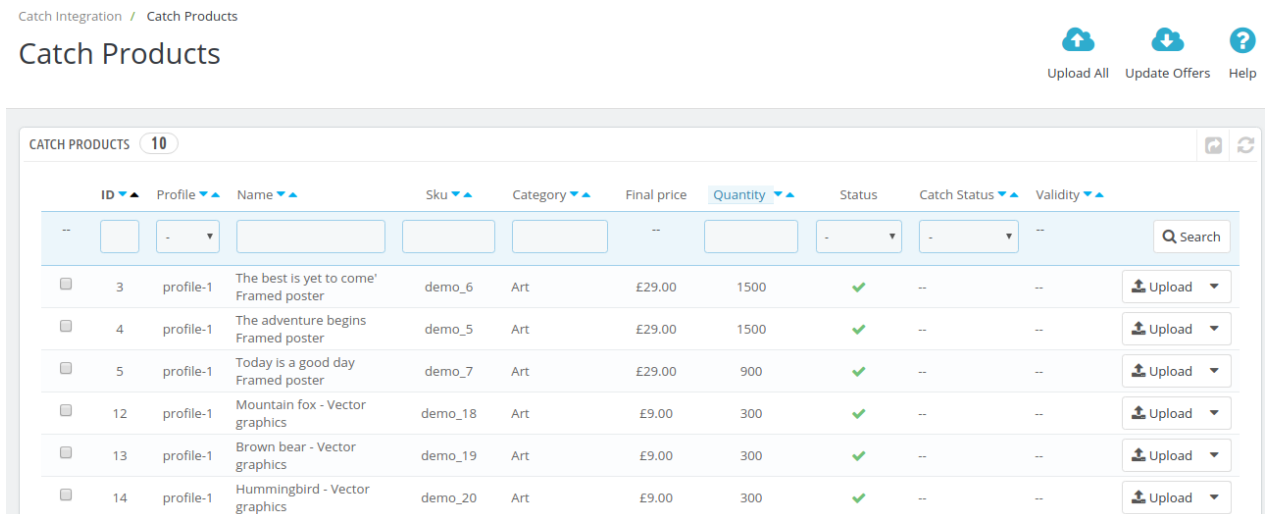
6.1. Upload Selected Products

To upload/update a product, a seller needs to:

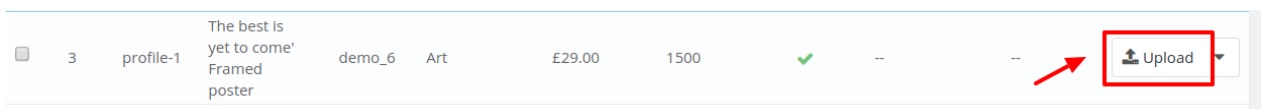
- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, click on Catch Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:



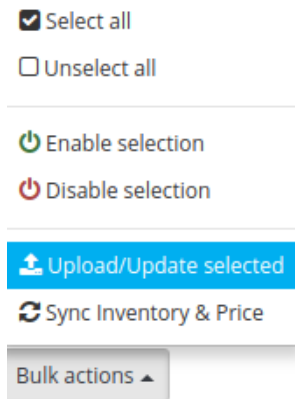

- For bulk upload, select the product(s) and then you need to click on the **Bulk Actions** button on the bottom left of the page and you may see the options for actions, as shown below:

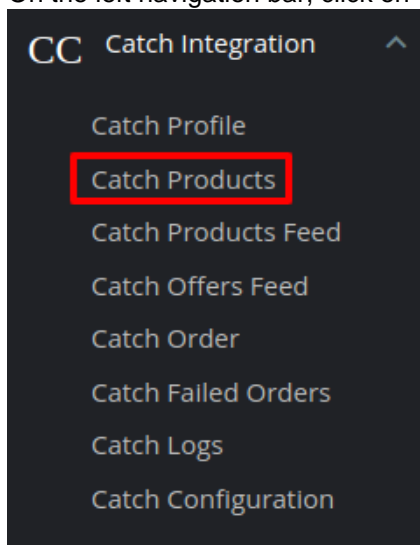

7.3. Catch Failed Orders

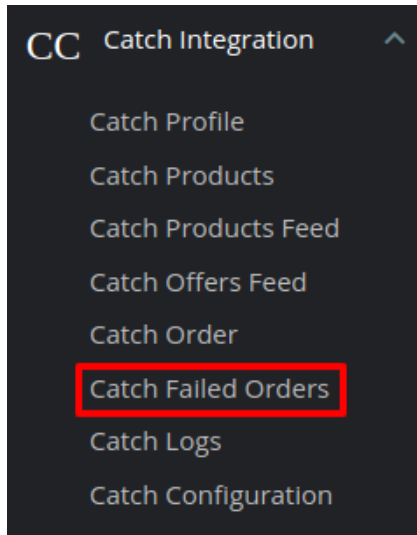
Orders are failed on Prestashop because of one or more of the following reasons:

- If any product in the Catch Order is Out of Stock in Prestashop store.
- If any product in the Catch Order is disabled in Prestashop store.
- If any Product does not exist in Prestashop store or is deleted from Prestashop after uploading on Catch.
- If the selected Payment Method in Catch System Configuration Setting is not available in Prestashop store.

The admin can see the failed Catch orders from the Prestashop admin panel.

To see the failed order:

- Go to Prestashop Admin Panel
- On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on Catch Integration and you will see it getting expanded as below:

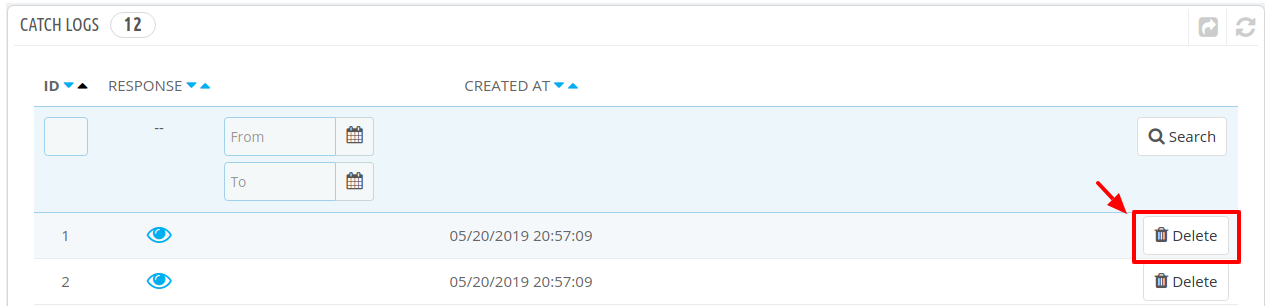

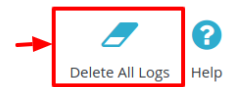
