

Etsy Integration for Magento 2 Guide

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1. Overview

Etsy Integration for Magento 2 at CedCommerce involves the integration of the Magento® 2 store with the Etsy marketplace.

The **Etsy Integration for Magento 2** extension helps the store owner to synchronize the product listing between the **Magento 2** store and the Etsy retailers. The **Magento 2** store owner can also manage the Etsy orders on the **Magento 2** stores without making any significant changes in the operational functionalities.

The **Magento 2** store owner has an ability to synchronize the orders, products, pricing, and inventory through establishing the interaction between the Etsy API and the **Magento 2** store. One of the most important features is that it enables the merchant to create the Etsy Categories and its dependent attributes on the **Magento 2** store. Thus, it helps to configure the desired product category to the **Magento 2** store for automatic submission of the selected product to the same category on Etsy marketplace.

Key Features are as follows:

- **Product Upload Based on Profile:** Enables the admin to create a profile based on a single category, and then assign the products to the profile to automate the product upload.
- **Synchronized Inventory:** Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and the listing of the products along with all the details are established between Magento 2 and Etsy.com.
- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Admin can map many categories of the Magento store to the single category of Etsy.
- **Bulk Upload System:** The merchant has the flexibility to upload any number of products on Etsy.com using the bulk product upload feature.
- **Creation of Magento Orders:** The newly placed orders on Etsy.com are automatically created in the Magento store with all the required details as it is on Etsy.com.
- **New Order Notification:** A notification is sent to the admin if an order is placed on Etsy marketplace for the product after it gets fetched from Etsy to Magento 2.
- **Shipment Automation:** Admin can automate the shipment process with Shipstation, Shipwork, Stamps.com, Linnworks, Xtento, ShipRush.

2. Etsy Integration Extension Installation

To install the extension

1. Log in the **ftp**, and then go to Magento 2 root folder (generally present under the *public_html* folder).
2. Create a new folder named *code* under the *app* folder; under *code* folder, create a folder named *Ced*.
 - Upload or Drag and Drop *app/code/Ced/Game* directory.
 - After successfully uploading the directory, the extension will be installed or upgraded.
 - Now run the following upgrade command in *cmd*
php bin/magento setup:upgrade.

3. Install Etsy PHP SDK

Once the extension is successfully installed on the Magento 2 store, the **ETSY INTEGRATION** menu appears on the left navigation bar of the Magento 2 Admin Panel. Following the below steps to install the Etsy PHP SDK –

To Install Etsy PHP SDK

1. Go to the <https://github.com/cedcommerce/etsy-php>(<https://github.com/cedcommerce/etsy-php>) link.

2. Scroll down to the **Etsy PHP SDK** section.
The page appears as shown in the following figure:

 - And then add the line `extension=oauth.so` to your `php.ini`

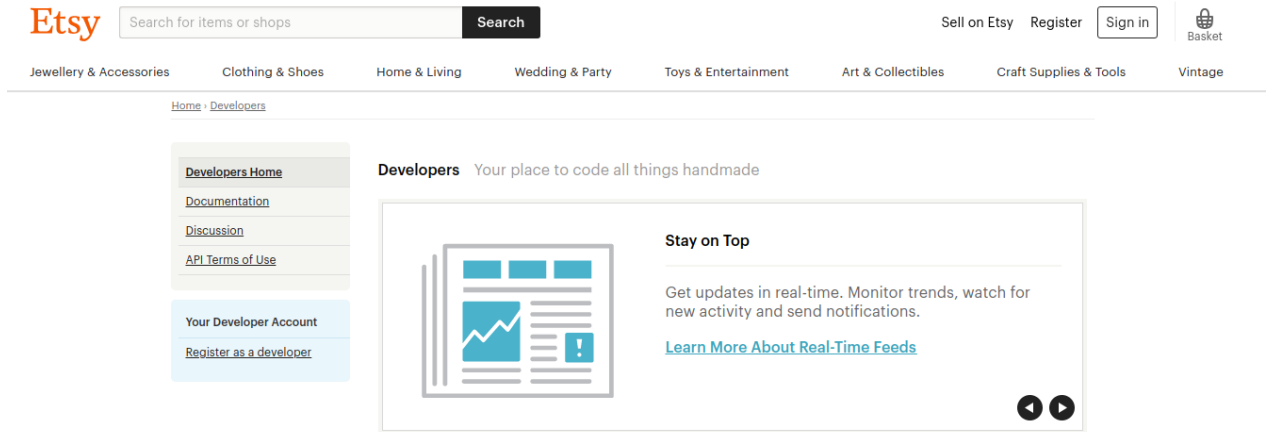
3. Make sure that the mentioned requirements are fulfilled.
4. After fulfilling the requirements, Now run the following command for installing the SDK ***composer require cedcommerce/etsy-php***

4. Retrieve the Etsy API Credentials

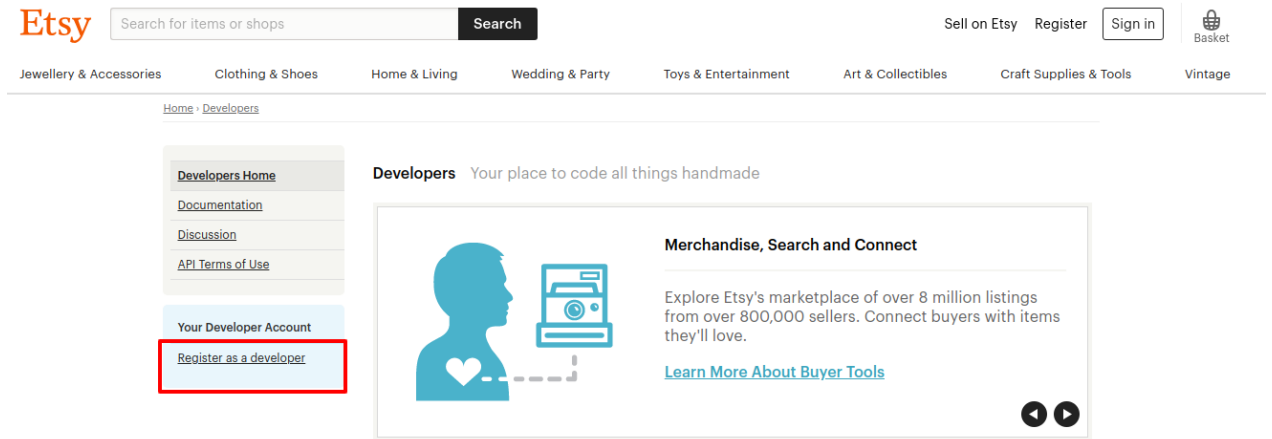
The merchant has to first create a seller account in the Etsy seller panel. Once the seller account is created and is approved by Etsy, the store owner has to retrieve the API Credentials. The merchant has to enter these **API Key details** on the **Etsy Developers** page.

To retrieve API Key Details from the Etsy

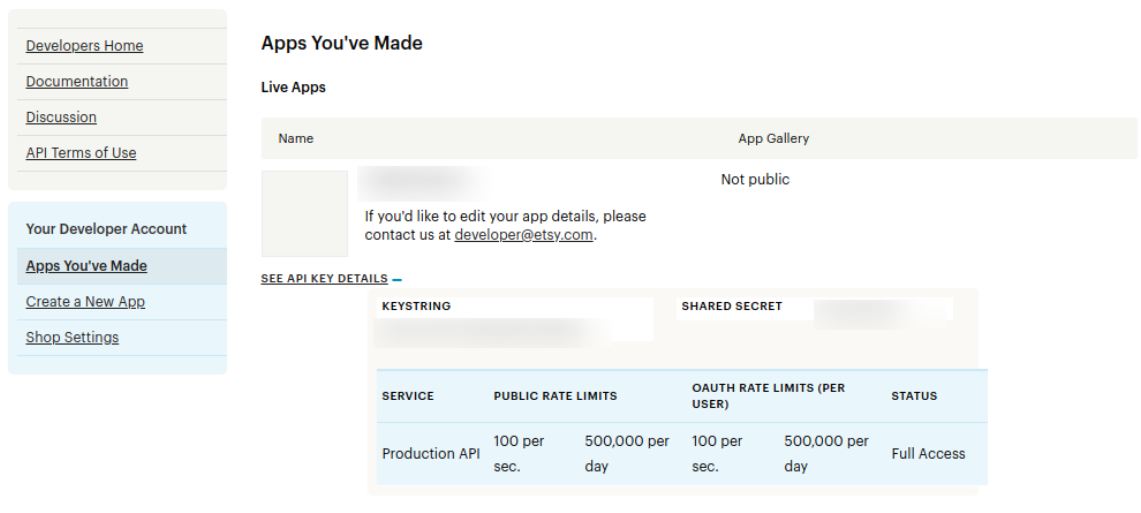
1. Go to the <https://www.etsy.com/developers>(<https://www.etsy.com/developers>) link.
The page appears as shown in the following figure:



2. Enter your Username and password to sign up your Etsy account.
3. Once get logged in, then Register as a developer

4. Once registration is done, your App has been made.
5. Then, get the API key credentials,
 - o Key string
 - o Shared Secret
 The page appears as shown in the following figure:

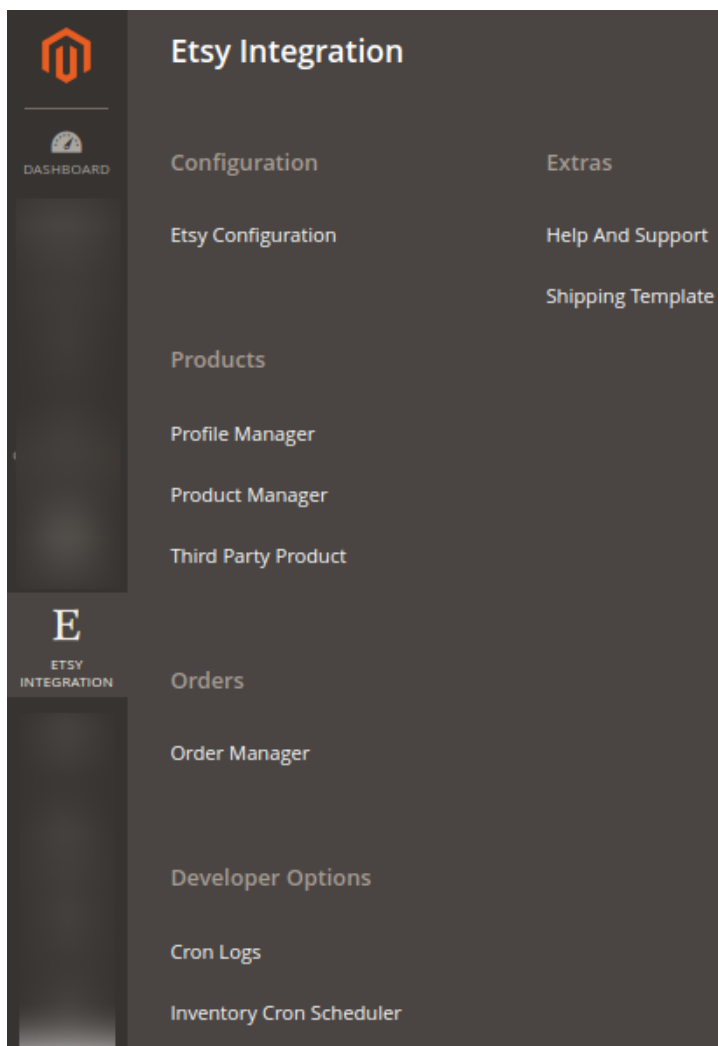


5. Etsy Configuration Settings

After obtaining the **API credentials** from the Etsy Developer account, the Magento 2 store owner has to paste them into the respective fields displayed on the **Etsy Configuration** page of the admin panel.

To set up the configuration settings in the Magento 2 Admin panel

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **ETSY INTEGRATION** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click the **Etsy Configuration**.



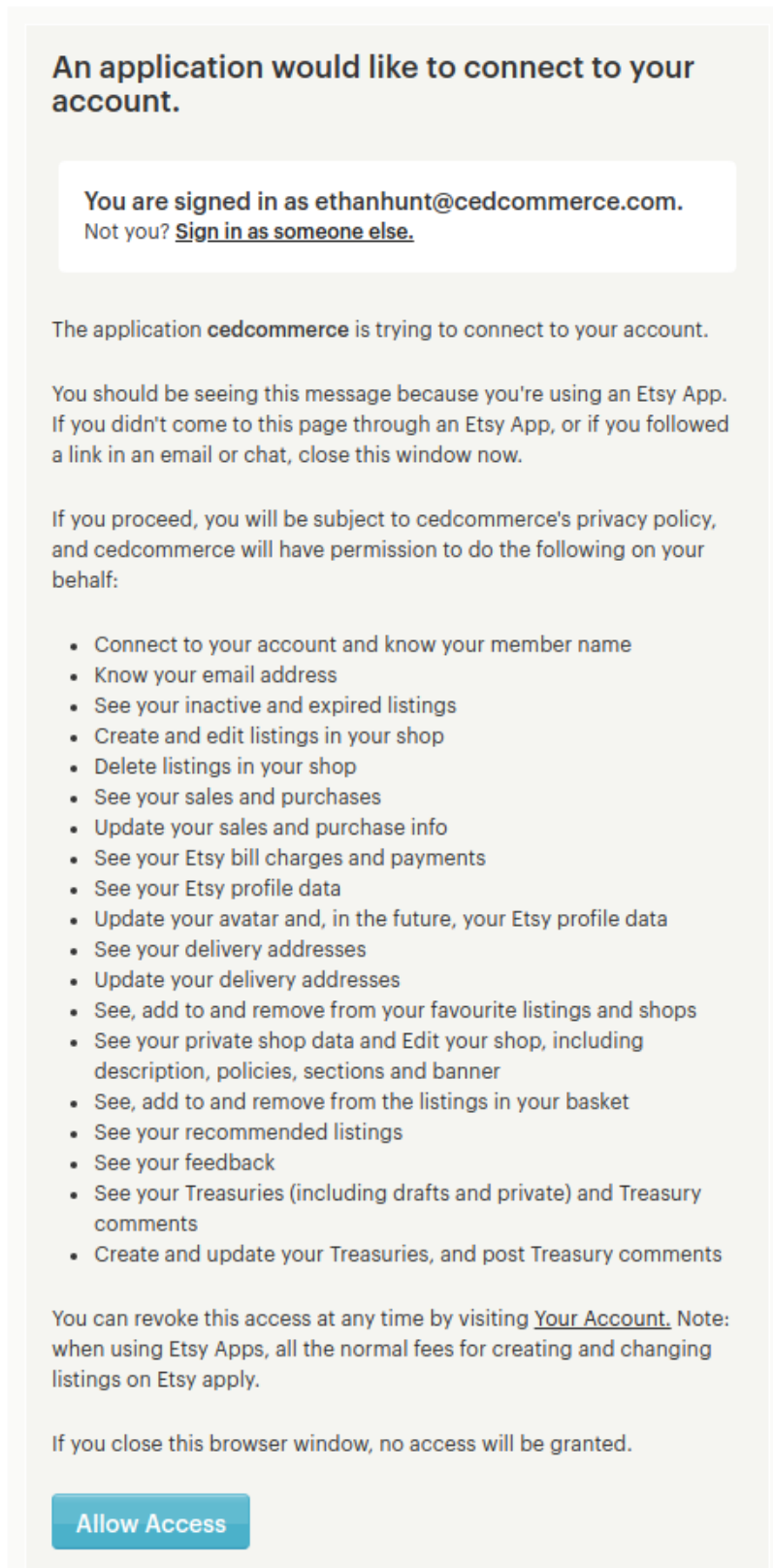

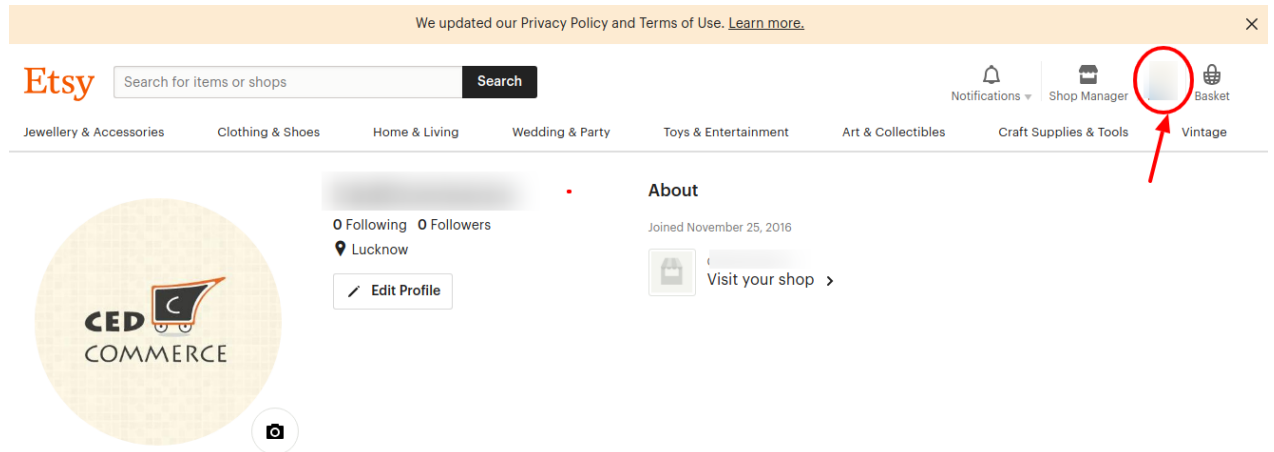

 - a. In the **Etsy Key String** box, paste the corresponding value copied from the Etsy Developer panel.
 - b. In the **Shared Secret Key** box, paste the corresponding value copied from the Etsy Developer panel.
6. Click the **Fetch Token** button. The page appears as shown in the below figure:



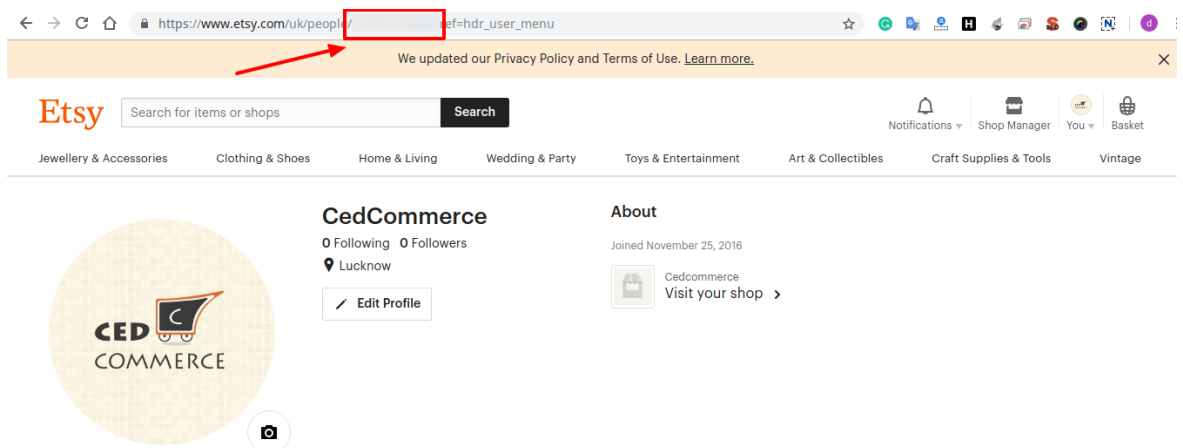
Click on the **Allow Access** button, after a click Access Token, Access Token Secret, Verifier Code will get filled automatically.

For Username and Shop name, you first need to login in Etsy developer account, Click on Profile Button: The page appears as shown in the following figure:



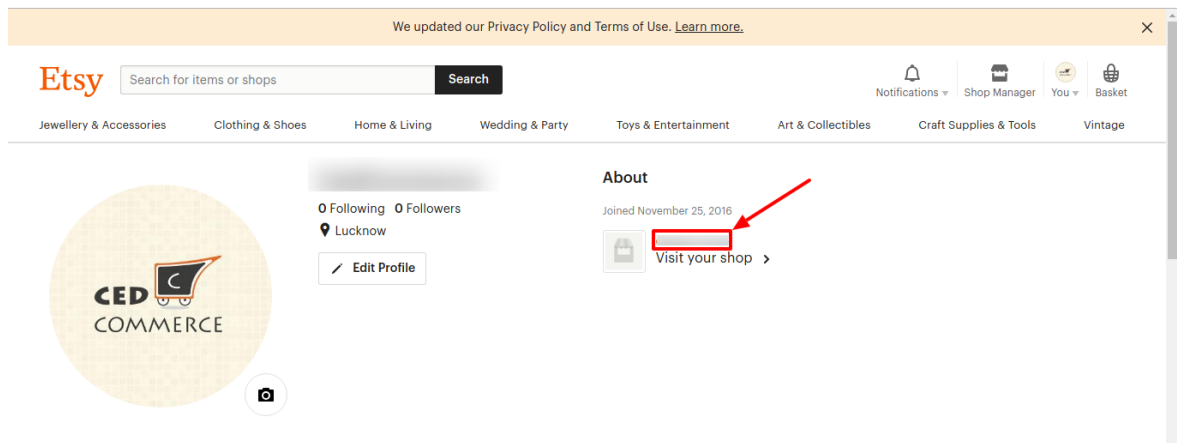
7. In the **User Name** box, enter the User Id from the Etsy Developer panel account.

a. The page appears from where you get the username as shown in the following figure:



b. In the **Shop Name** box, enter the Shop Name from the Etsy Developer panel account.

- c. In the **Country Name** list, select the required country.
 - d. In the **Etsy Store Language** box, select the language of your Etsy store.
 - e. In the **Select Store** list, select the single store.
 - f. In the **Active Products** on Etsy box, enter the count of active products.
 - g. Click on **Fetch Category** button, then the category is fetched from Etsy and a success message appears on the page.
8. Scroll down to the **Product Upload Settings** tab, and then click the tab.

1. Under **Product Upload Settings**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Who Made** a list, select the appropriate option.
 - b. In the **When Made** list, select the appropriate option.
 - c. In the **State** list, select the appropriate option.
 - d. Click the **Product Price** tab,
 - i. The **Product Price** tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:

In the **Product Price** list, select one of the following options:

i) **Increase by Fixed Price**: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Price** field appears.

ii) **Increase by Fixed Percentage**: If selected, then the **Modify by Percentage Price** field appears.

Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the Etsy, product price by the entered value % of Magento price.

Magento 2 Price = 100

Thus, Game Product Price = 105

iii) **Decrease by Fixed Price**: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Price** field appears.

iv) **Decrease by Fixed Percentage**: If selected, then the **Modify by Percentage Price** field appears.

Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Etsy product price by the entered value % of Magento 2 price.

For Example,

Magento 2 price – 5% of Magento 2 price.

Magento 2 Price = 100

Select **Decrease By Fixed Percentage** option

Modify by Fix Price = 5

$100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$

Thus, Game Product Price = 95

iii. Under **Shipping Template**, do the following step:

In the **Select Shipping Template** list, select the required Shipping template.

iv. In the **Select Shop Section** box, select your shop section.

v. Click on **Product Inventory** tab,

1. The **Etsy Product Inventory Settings** tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:

2. Under **Etsy Product Inventory Settings**, do the following step:

- i. **Increase by Fixed Quantity:** If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Quantity** field appears.
 - ii. **Decrease by Fixed Quantity:** If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Quantity** field appears.
 - vi. In the **Watermark image** box, select the **Yes** option, if you want to send watermark image on Etsy.
 - vii. In the **Convert Currency** tab, select the options, if you need to convert the currency based on location account.
 - viii. In the **Currency Convert Into** tab, select the option based on your account location.
2. Scroll down to the **Etsy Order Setting** tab, and then click the tab.
The tab is expanded and the expanded the section appears as shown in the following figure:

3. Under **Etsy Order Setting**, do the following steps:
- a. In the **Order Notification Email** box, enter the required email id.
 - b. In the **Etsy Order Id Prefix** box, enter Prefix for Etsy Order Increment id.
 - c. In the **Order Fetch for Out of Stock Product** box, select the **Yes** option, to fetch the order for out of stock products.
 - d. In the **Auto Order Fetch** box, select the **Yes** option, to auto-fetch order from Etsy.
 - e. In the **Tracking Number Available** box, select the **Yes** option, if you require a tracking number for

the shipment.

- f. In the **Shipment Method for Etsy** box, select the shipment method for Etsy order.
- g. In the **Payment Method of Etsy Order** box, select the payment method for Etsy order.
- h. In the **Create Real Customer** box, select the **Yes** option, to create a real customer of Etsy.

Note: If the admin select **No** option then, another field appears as shown in the figure:

- i. In the **Create New Product(if not exist)** box, create new products if SKU not found in Magento store.
4. Under **Etsy Third-Party Product Setting**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Sync Product On the Bases of** the box, select the option on which basis you need to sync the Etsy Products.
 - b. In the **Third Party Product Status** box, select the product current status.
 - c. In the **Auto-Fetch Third-Party Product** box, select the **Yes** option, to auto-fetch third-party products.
 - d. In the **Auto Sync Third-Party Product** box, select the **Yes** option, to auto sync third party products.
 5. Under **Etsy Cron Setting**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Auto Sync Inventory** box, select the **Yes** option, to auto-update inventory on Etsy while product edit.
 - b. In the **Auto Update Order Status** box, select the **Yes** option, to auto-update status of orders from Etsy.
 6. Click the **Save Config** button.
The configuration settings are saved.

6. Manage Etsy Profiles

Admin can create a new profile and assign the required products to the profile. While creating and editing the profile, admin can map the Magento 2 attributes to the Etsy attributes. These attributes are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.

Admin can do the following tasks:

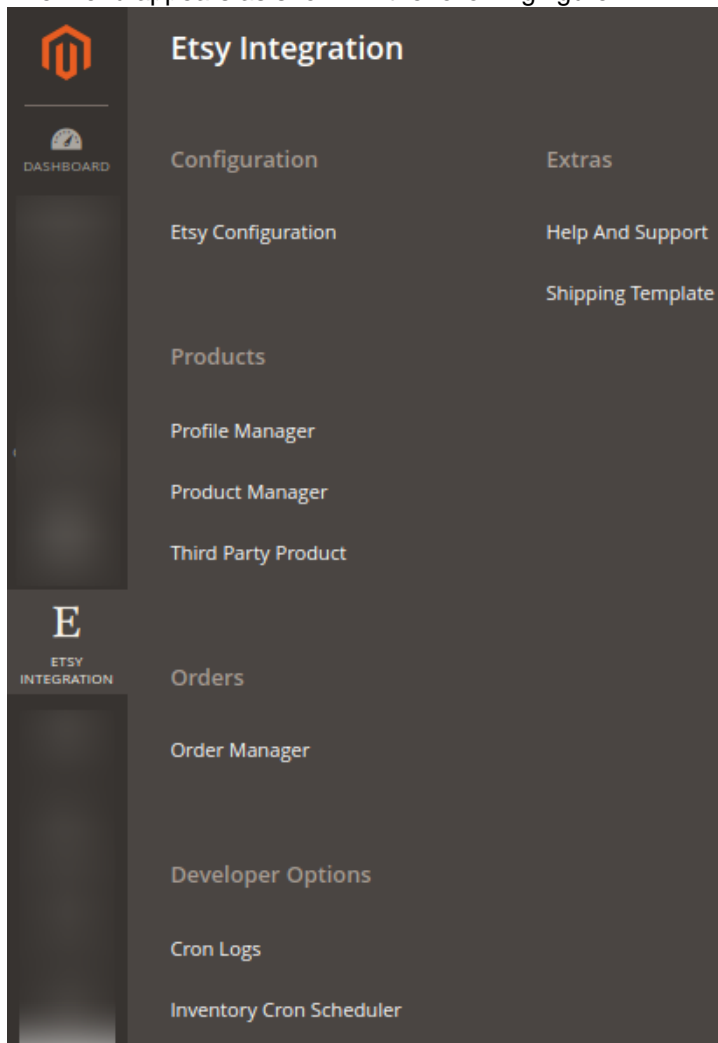

Note: Admin can assign one product to one profile only. It means, admin can assign multiple products to the same profile but can associate a product only with one profile at one time. To assign a product to another profile, the admin has to remove that product from the currently assigned profile.

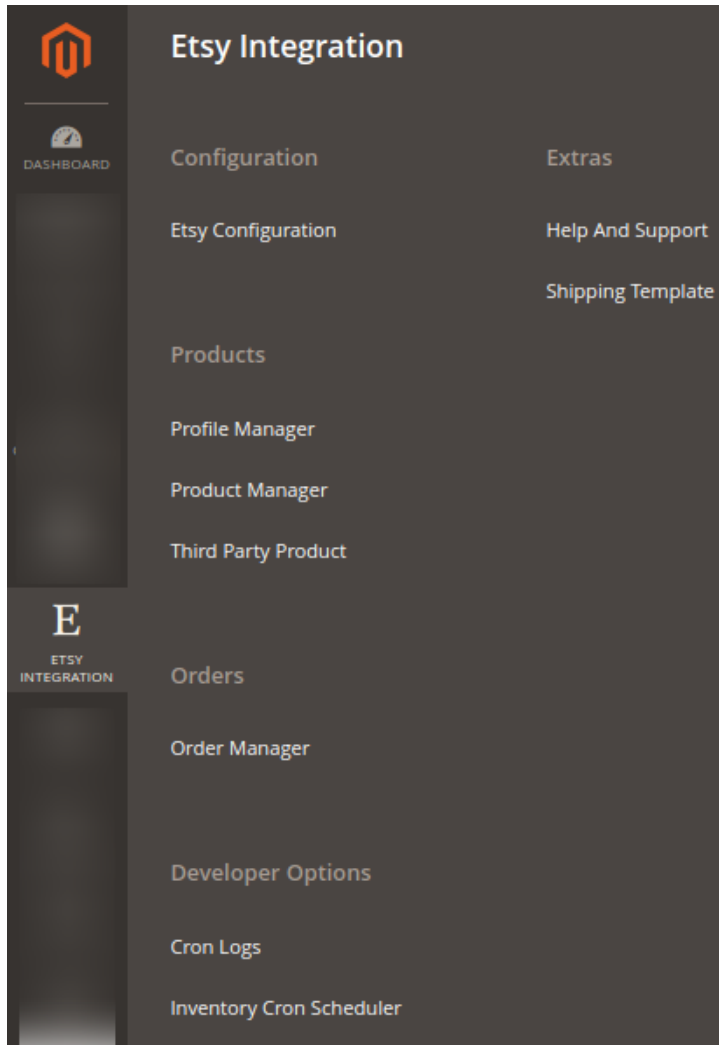

7. Etsy Product Listing

On this page, all the products listing available in the Magento 2 store are listed. If the store owners have their products listed in the Etsy store and want to get those item listing ids in the Magento 2 store, then they can use a feature provided by this extension to map them with the corresponding products listed on the Etsy Product Listing page. They can also upload the selected products on the Etsy website.

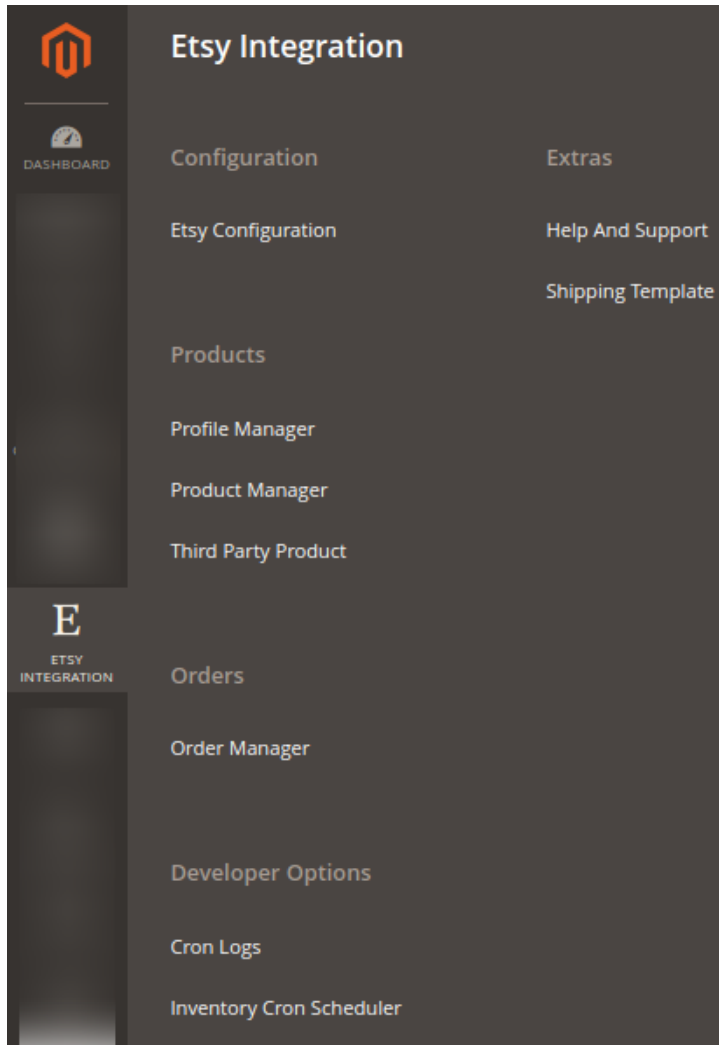
The admin can do the following tasks:

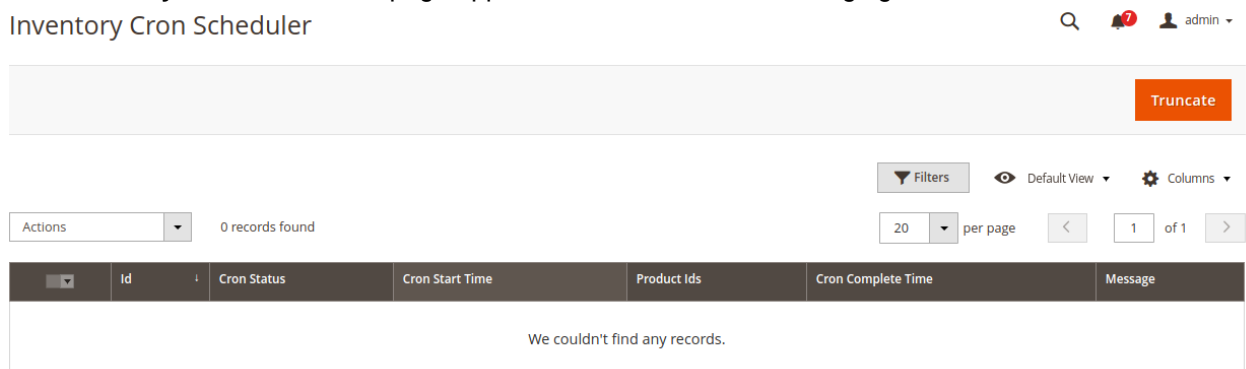
