o 2 Marketplace Vendor Product Addon – User Guide

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1. Overview

Vendor Product Addon developed for Magento 2 Multi vendor

extension(https://cedcommerce.com/magento-2-extensions/marketplace)

enables the vendors (sellers) to create the Configurable, the Bundle, and the Grouped products. Also, it provides the custom options to the simple, the virtual, and the downloadable products.

The Vendor Product add-on for Magento 2 Marketplace enables the vendors to have the similar kind of facility as the admin (store owner) has to create the products. This add-on enables the admin to create the required attribute sets available to the vendors to create the products.

Prerequisites: CedCommerce Magento 2 Multi Vendor Marketplace

extension(https://cedcommerce.com/magento-2-extensions/marketplace-basic)

Apart from the vendor product creation, the add-on has the several other features, which are the key features. A few of them are as follows:

- Simultaneous Mass Image Upload.
- Product Custom Options.
- Default Magento 2 Pricing such as tier prices, group prices, and special prices.
- Default Inventory Settings such as the Maximum Quantity allowed in a shopping cart, the backorders feature, and the Quantity increments.
- Dynamic SKU generation.
- Dynamic Weight of the products.
- Dynamic Price in case of the special type of products.

Now to elaborate the main features of the add-on, here is the detailed explanation of each:

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Add All Product Types: With the Multi vendor Marketplace

Basic(https://cedcommerce.com/magento-2-extensions/marketplace-basic) extension, the vendors can only create the Simple products, the Downloadable products, and the Virtual products. But, with the **Vendor Product** add-on, the vendors can create all the types of the products that include Configurable, Bundle, and Grouped.

Vendors have the facility to add variants to their products by creating Configurable Products and differentiating them with the help of attributes such as Size, Color, and so on. They can also create a bundle of products they want to sell together as they cannot sell them individually. They can also sell a group of similar products as a combo offer.

•

Custom Options: Vendors can also add custom options to their products if the product comes in different styles, sizes, and so on. Admin can create the required attribute set available to the vendors to create products. For example, if there is a simple product, which is available in 3 sizes such as Small, Medium, and Large, then the vendors can add these values as custom options to the product and make it available at the front-end to the user to select the required size of the product.

• Allowed Attributes: Through the configuration settings, the admin can create only the required attribute set available to the vendors to create the products. If the admin has created 4 attribute sets and wants to provide 2 of them to the vendor product creation, then the vendor can select those attribute sets from the required configuration settings.


But, this is applicable to all the vendors. This is useful when the admin wants the vendors to provide the extra details with their products those the admin wants to review.

2. Vendor Configuration Settings

After installing the **Vendor Product** add-on, the admin has to set the vendor configuration settings to enable the features of the vendor system and the add-on.

To set up the configurations

- 1. Go to Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **MARKETPLACE** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click Vendor Configuration.

- 4. In the right panel, under the **General** section, do the following steps:
 - a. In the Enable Vendor System list, select Yes.
 - b. In the Enable Advanced Product System list, select Yes.
- 5. Scroll down to the **Vendor Products** tab, and then click the tab.

The tab is expanded and the relevant fields appear under the **Vendor Products** section as shown in the following figure:

- 6. Under **Vendor Products**, do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Require Admin Approval** list select **Yes** if the admin approval is needed to approve the products created by the vendors.
 - b. In the Allowed Product Attribute Set list, select the required Attribute Set.
 - c. In the **Allowed Product Type** list, select the required product type that the admin wants to allow the vendors to create.
 - d. In the **Vendor Products Limit** box, enter the number of products that the admin wants to allow the vendors to create.
 - e. In **Product Categories Display** list, select one of the following options:
 - i. All Allowed Categories: All the available categories are allowed.
 - ii. **Specific Categories**: On selecting this option, the next field **Allowed Categories** appears, from where admin can select the each required category from the list.
 - f. In the **Product approved notification email** list, select the notification email to be sent when the product is reviewed and approved.
 - g. In the **Product rejected notification email** list, select the notification email to be sent when the product is reviewed and rejected.
 - h. In the **Product deleted notification email** list, select the notification email to be sent when the product is reviewed and deleted.
 - i. In the **Enable Related Products** list, select **Yes** to enable the vendors to create the related products.
 - j. In the **Enable Up-Sells Product** list, select **Yes** to enable the vendors to create the Up-Sells products.
 - k. In the **Enable Cross-Sells Product** list, select **Yes** to enable the vendors to create the Cross-Sells products.
 - I. In the **Enable Custom Options Tab** list, select **Yes** to display the Custom Options tab in the Vendor panel.
- 7. Click the Save Config button.
 - The configuration settings are saved.

3. Add Vendor Products

Vendor Product Addon provides several new features to add products from the Vendor panel. The creation of the products from the vendor panel is as similar as creating the products from the admin panel.

The workflow and the User Interface (UI) in the Vendor panel are exactly same as it appears in the Admin panel for the product creation.

The vendor has a facility to add the following types of the products:



3.1. Add a Simple Product

The vendors can use the Magento 2 simple product feature to add a single item without any specific variations. For instance, a coffee cup, a table, and so on.

To add a simple product

- 1. Go to the Vendor Panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the New Product menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click Add Simple Product.

- 4. Click the **Enable** icon to enable the Product creation feature of the add-on.
- 5. In the **Attribute Set** list, select the required option. *Note*: Based on the selection, other relevant fields appear.
- 6. Enter the required values in the respective fields.
- 7. In the **Product Name** box, enter the name of the product.
- In the SKU box, enter the product SKU.
 Note: By default the SKU is same as Product Name, But the vendor can change it if required.
- 9. In the **Price** box, enter the product price.
- 10. Click the **Advanced Pricing** link.

- 11. Do the following steps:
 - a. In the **Special Price** box, enter the required offer price value.
 - b. In the **Special Price From** and **To** boxes, click to select the required date from the appeared Calendar.
 - c. In the **Cost** box, enter the actual cost of the product.
 - d. Move to the Tier Price area, and do the following steps:

Tier Price: It is a way to encourage the front-end users to buy larger quantities of a product by applying discounts based on the quantity ordered.

i. Click the Add button.

 - A quantity value to which the tier pricing is applicable.
- v. In the Price box, enter a value.
 An amount value that is being charged to front-end users when they buy the specified quantity of the product.
- 5. In the **Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price** box, enter the required value.
- 6. In the **Display Actual Price** list, select the required option.
 - Select the location where to display the actual price of the product.
- 7. Click the Done button.
- 12. In the $\ensuremath{\text{Tax Class}}$ list, select the required option.
- 13. In the **Quantity** box, enter the required number of products.
- 14. Click the **Advanced Inventory** link.



- 17. In the **Weight** list, select the required option.
- If selected the This item has weight option, then enter the actual weight of the product.
- 18. In the **Categories** list, select the required option.
- 19. In the **Visibility** list, select the required option.
- 20. In the Set Product as New From and To boxes, enter the date range.
- 21. In the Country of Manufacture list, select the required country name.
- 22. In the **Color** list, select the required color.
- 23. In the **Size** list, select the required size.
- 24. Scroll down to the **Content** tab, and then click the tab.

The tab is expanded and the relevant fields appear as shown in the following figure:

This section is used is used to provide some common information related to the product such as the product Name, SKU, Price, Tax Class, Images & Videos, Quantity, Weight, Category, Description, and so on.

The Description and the Short Description fields in the Vendor Product add-on are supported by WYSIWYG editor through which the vendor can provide a formatted description of the product using the font-style, font-size, text-alignment, text-color, images, tables and so on. The vendors (sellers) can choose the layout to display the description of the products in the front-end view.

25. Under Content, do the following steps:

a. In the **Description** box, enter the product description in detail.

- . Click the **Show/Hide** button to show or hide the editor respectively.
- b. In the Short Description box, enter the short description of the product.
 - . Click the Show/Hide button to show or hide the editor respectively.

26. Scroll down to the **Images And Videos** tab, and click the tab. The tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:

Use this section to display the videos showcasing the products, features or benefits, and so on. This tab has been customized in the Vendor Product Addon to include **mass image upload** feature. The vendor can upload multiple images simultaneously and choose to decide the image to set as the default image.

- 27. Under Images And Videos, do the following steps:
 - a. Click the **Browse** area to upload or drag the image from the local system.
 - b. Click the Add Video button to add the product relevant video if required.
- 28. Scroll down to the **Search Engine Optimization** tab, and then click the tab. The tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:


The **Search Engine Optimization** page of the basic product settings includes the primary fields used by search engines to index the product. It is used to provide the keywords or tags, which makes the searching process easier. It means while searching any product with the keywords listed in the Meta Keyword box, the customers are redirected to the page that includes those keywords.

29. Under Search Engine Optimization, do the following steps:

a. In the URL Key box, enter the required URL link.

b. In the Meta Title box, enter the required title.

- c. In the Meta Keywords box, enter the required title.
- d. In the Meta Title box, enter the required title.
- 30. Scroll down to the Related Products, Up-Sells, and Cross-Sells tab and then click the tab.
 - The tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:



- Related products are shown to the customers in addition to the item they can look for.
- An **up-sell** item is offered to the customer as a pricier or higher-quality alternative to the product the customer is looking for.
- The Cross-Sell products are the impulse buy products that appear next to the shopping cart as the cross-sells to the items already existing in the shopping cart.
- 31. Under Related Products, Up-Sells, and Cross-Sells, do the following steps:
 - a. To add the Related Products, do the following steps:
 - i. Click the Add Related Products button.


3.2. Add a Configurable Product

Magento 2 Configurable product feature is used to create a single item with different variations. For example, a coffee cup available with different variations such as different colors and sizes. The creation process is similar to the Simple Product creation with the option to create the Configurations.

Hence, Configurable products enable customers to choose the options such as the shirt color. Vendors need to add a simple product for each configuration, that is, a product for each color.

To add a configurable product

- 1. Go to the Vendor Panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **New Product** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click Add Configurable Product.


3.3. Add a Bundle Product

Vendors can use the Magento 2 bundle product feature to create a bundle of simple (or virtual) products, which are not to be sold separately. For example, a laptop where the customer can choose various items such as hard disk, processor, internal memory, and so on, each of these items are simple (or virtual) products but the vendors can sell them only in a bundle.

In case of Bundle Products, the vendor has a facility to generate Dynamic SKU, Dynamic Price, and Dynamic Weight.

To add a bundle product

- 1. Go to the Vendor Panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the New Product menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:
