

# **Linio Prestashop Integration**

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## 1. Overview

**Linio**, one of the biggest online e-commerce marketplace in Latin America, also stated in 8 countries more with around 300+ million registered users. Countries include: **Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Mexico, Panama, Peru, Venezuela.**

Linio receives an average of 50 million website visits per month, hosts more than 10 thousand marketplace stores and has over 3 million products available for purchase in the category.

Linio Prestashop Integration Extension by CedCommerce is a native addon that establishes a perfect synchronization of the inventory, pricing, orders & other product details between your Prestashop store and Linio Marketplace. This 'easy to use' integration addon simplifies product creation and its management.

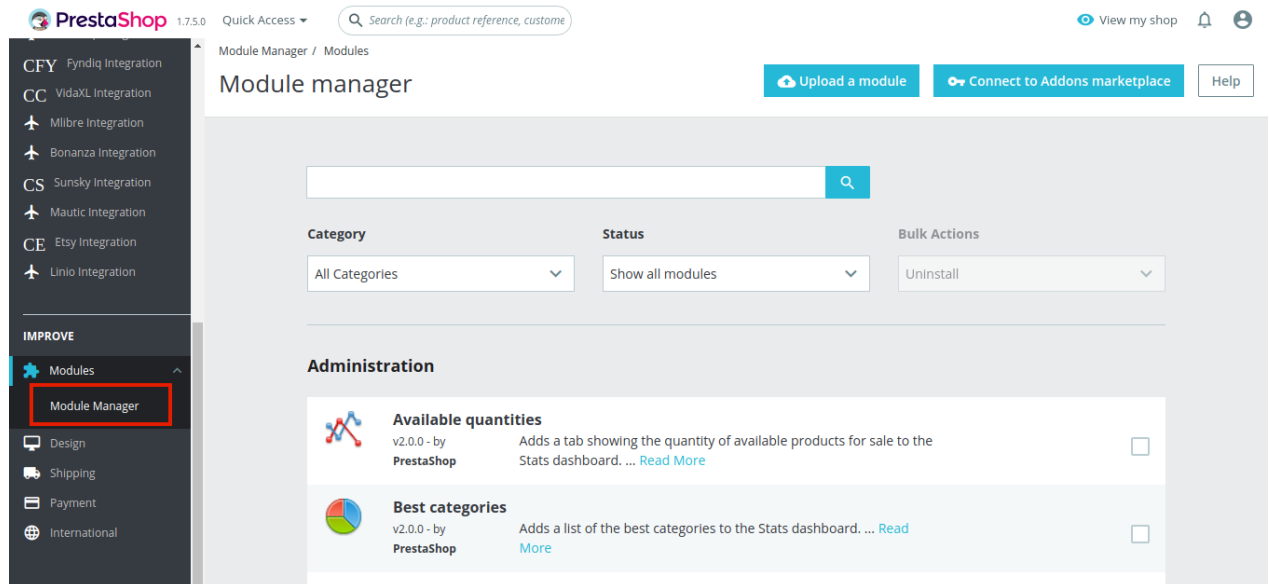
**Key features are as follows:**

- **Synchronized Inventory and Profile Based Pricing:** Inventory Synchronization at regular intervals and product Listing is established between Prestashop store and Linio website. There is a profile based price increase or decrease.
- **Profile based product Upload:** Admin can create a profile and map the Linio category and attributes to the Prestashop category and attributes, and then after assigning the products to the profile can easily upload products to the Linio website.
- **Simple and Configurable Product Upload:** Our Opencart Linio Integration empowers the admin to upload both simple and configurable type of products from the Opencart store to Linio.
- **Archive and Unarchive Products:** Merchants can close and reopen the products on the Linio website using this feature. Archive disables the products on the Linio website and Unarchive enables the archived product.
- **Creation of Prestashop Orders:** The newly placed orders on the Linio website are automatically created in the Prestashop store with all the required details as it is on the Linio website.
- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Admin can map many categories of the Prestashop store to the single category of the Linio website.

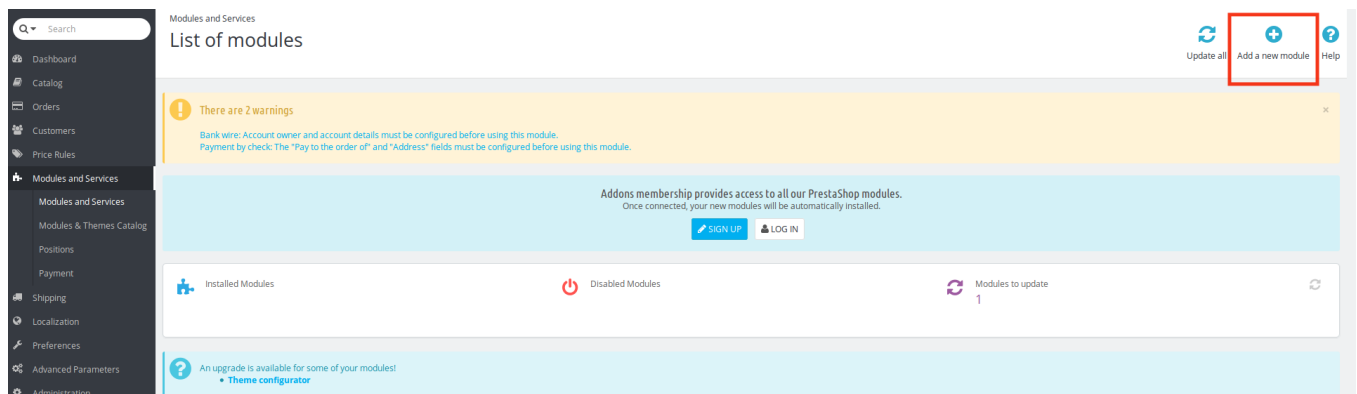
## 2. Linio Prestashop Integration Extension Installation

### To install the extension:

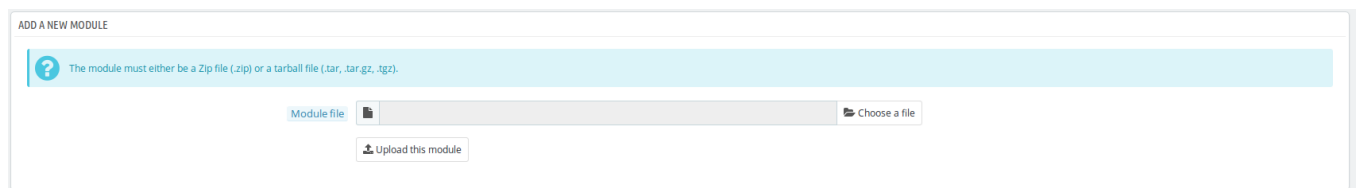
- Go to the **Prestashop Admin panel**.
- On the left navigation bar, point cursor to the **Modules and Services**.  
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



- Now click the **Modules and Services** menu, and you will come across a page like shown below.

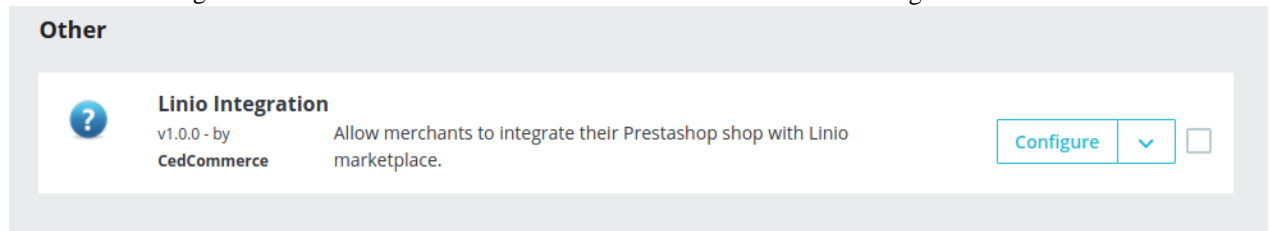


- Now you need to click on **Add a New Module** on the top right corner of the page.
- On doing so, the page opens a section like shown in the image below:



- Now in the Module File tab, choose the package file of Wish marketplace from your system.
- Once selected, click on the **Upload this module** button.

- On the same page, scroll down and in the Modules list, search for Wish and it will be listed in the right side like shown in the image below. You have to click on the **Install** button shown in the image.

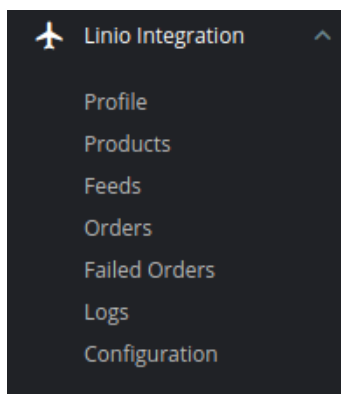


- Once you click on **Install** button, you can see a message like shown below, on the same page, asking you if you wish to proceed with the installation. You may click on **Proceed with the installation**.
- The module will be installed and you will be navigated to the **Configuration** page for further steps to be taken.

Update Inventory/Price on Product Edit: YES NO *Update inventory and price on linio when you edit product on store .* **Select 'yes' to enable update and price on linio when you edit product on store.**

Delete Product Data on Product Delete: YES NO *Disable product on linio when you delete product on store .* **Select 'yes' to enable the cron if you delete product on store then it gets disable on Linio.**

7. In the **Product Settings**, do the following steps:

- In the **Debug Mode**, choose Yes to enable the debug mode,
- In the **Price Type**, choose the price variations.
- In the **Store language**, select your store language.
- In the **Auto Inventory and Price by cron**, select **Yes** to enable the auto update inventory and price cron.
- In the **Update Inventory/Price on Product Edit**, select **Yes** to enable the update inventory/Price on linio when you edit product on store.
- In the **Delete Product Data on Product delete**, select **Yes** to enable the cron if you delete product on store then it gets disable on Linio.

8. Now Go to **Order Settings**.

The tab appears as shown in the following figure:


**Order Payment**  Choose payment method while importing orders.

9. In the **Order Settings**, do the following steps:

- In the **Customer ID**, enter the customer id to create order on store which are imported from Linio.
- In the **Order Email** box, enter the email to create order on store which are imported from Linio.
- In the **Prestashop order status when import**, select the status when linio orders import in Prestashop order section.
- In the **Prestashop order status when cancelled at Linio**, select the status when order cancel on Linio.
- In the **Order Status**, select the status after cancel orders.
- In the **Prestashop order status when Shipped**, select the status when after the orders gets shipped.
- In the **Prestashop order status when delivered**, select the status after order marked as delivered at linio.
- In the **Order Carrier**, choose the order carrier through which you ship the order.
- In the **Import Linio orders from**, select the range to fetch to fetch order.
- In the **Order Payment**, choose your payment method.

10. Lastly, Go to **Cron Settings**.

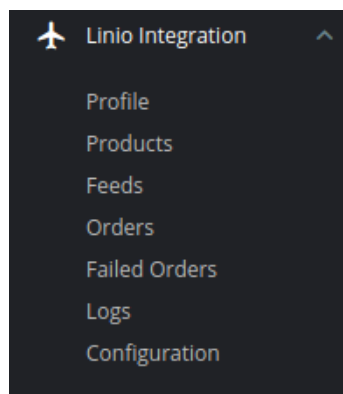
11. In the **Cron Settings**, do the following steps:
  - a. In **Cron Secure Key**, you can make a combination of secure key consisting of the alphabet, number, and special characters.
  - b. You may see cron URL, name and recommended time.
12. Click the **Save** button and the configuration will be saved.

## 4. Manage Linio Profiles

This tab contains information about creating product profiles which can later be utilized to implement bulk product functionality for particular product types.

### *To set up the Linio Profile settings in the PrestaShop Admin panel*

1. Go to the **Prestashop admin** panel.
2. In the left navigation panel, place cursor on **Linio Module** menu.  
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:

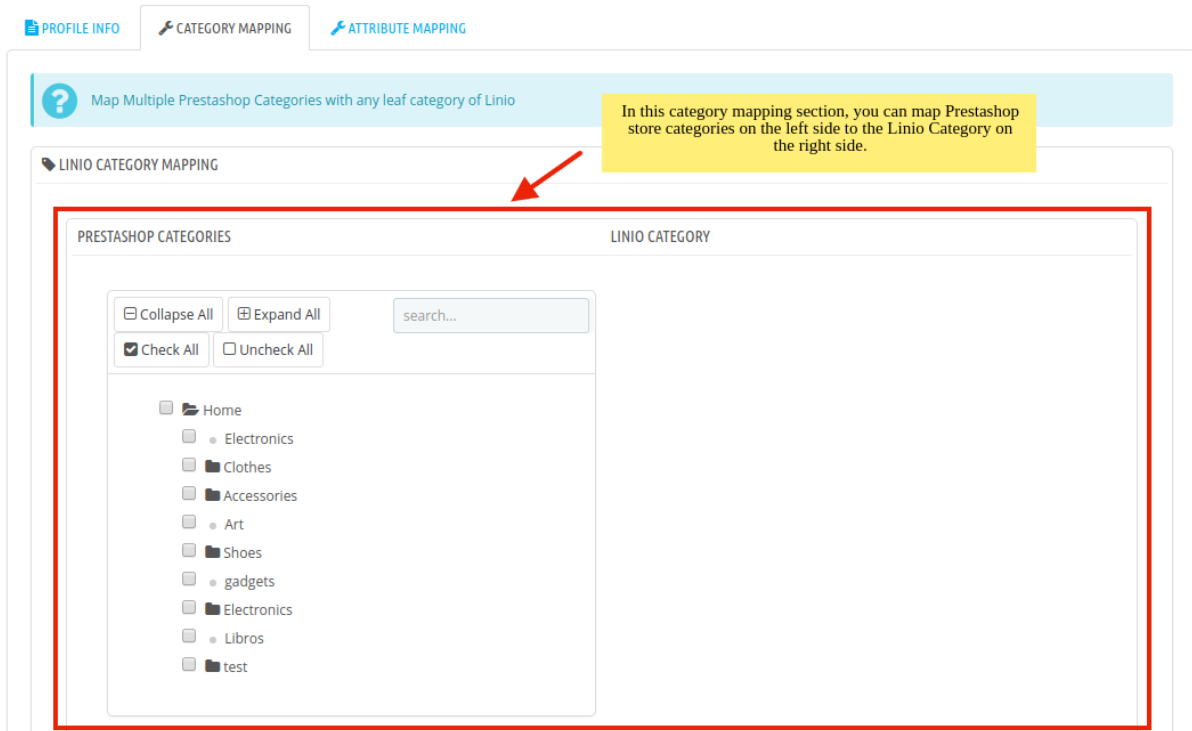

- In the **Profile code**, enter the code for the profile you are making.
- In the **Profile name**, enter the name of the profile.
- Select **Enable** as the status to enable the profile.
- Click on the **Save** button.

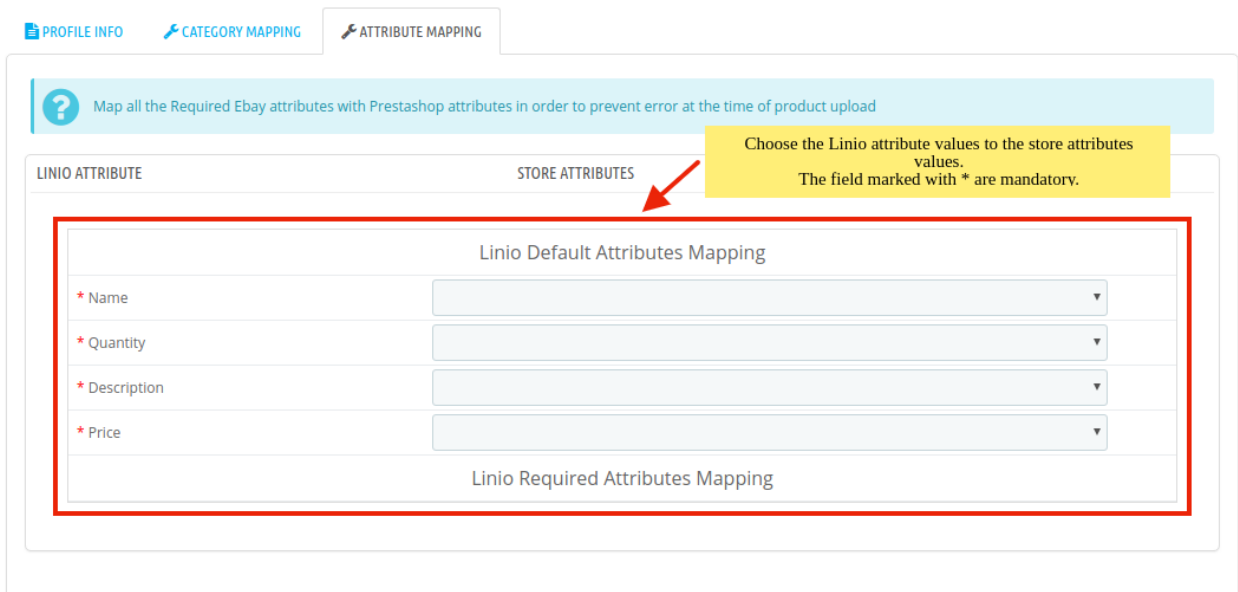
5. Now Click on **Category Mapping** adjacent to the **Profile Info** tab, and you'll come across a section as below:



6. In this section

- You have to map your PrestaShop category attribute with **Linio** Category.
- Select the options **Collapse All**, **Expand All**, **Check All**, **Uncheck All** to perform these operations to select the directory.
- Select the category of Linio.

7. Now Click on **Attribute Mapping** adjacent to the **Category Mapping** tab, and you'll come across a section as below:



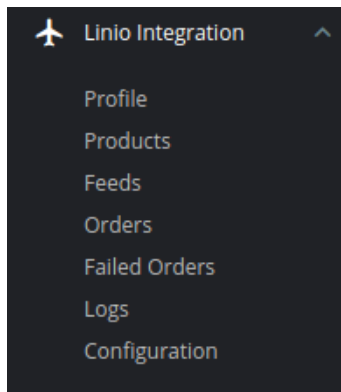
8. In this tab, map the relevant attributes of the product profiles with that of attributes of items on Linio.

9. Once you're done profiling everything proceeds to **Save** to store the changes and **Cancel** to discard them.

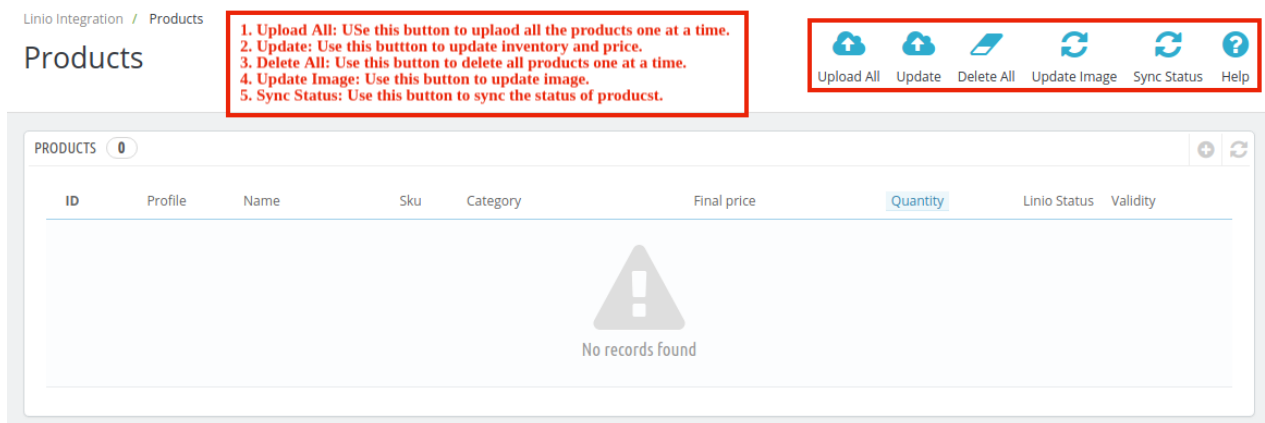
## 5. Manage Linio Products

### *To set up the Linio Profile settings in the PrestaShop Admin panel*

1. Go to the **Prestashop admin** panel.
2. In the left navigation panel, place cursor on **Linio Module** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Once you click on the **Products**, you're redirected to screen containing all the information and related operation you can perform on your Prestashop store products.



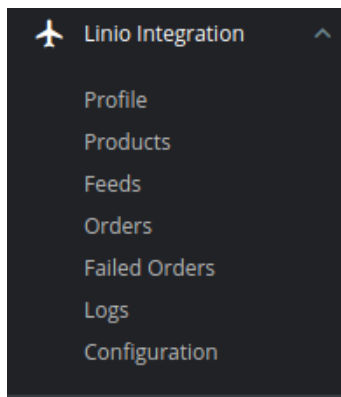
4. In the **Product Settings**, do the following steps:
  - a. In the **ID** box, the auto-generated product ID for your products in the module.
  - b. In the **Profile**, you can see the name of the profile.
  - c. In the **Name** box, you can see the name of the item.
  - d. In the **SKU** box, you can see the unique identifier of the item.
  - e. In the **Final Price** box, you can see the price of the item at Linio.
  - f. In the **Quantity** box, you can see the total no. of the quantity of the item.
  - g. In the **Status** box, you can see the status of the item (as saved while creating product profile)
  - h. In the **Validity** box, you can see the time duration for the item.

- i. In the **Upload All**, use this button if you want to upload all of the listings at once on the Linio.
- j. In the **Delete All**, use this button if you want to delete all of the listings at once on the Linio.
- k. In the **Update Image**, use this button if you want to update image on the Linio.
- l. In the **Sync Status**, use this button if you want to sync status on the Linio.

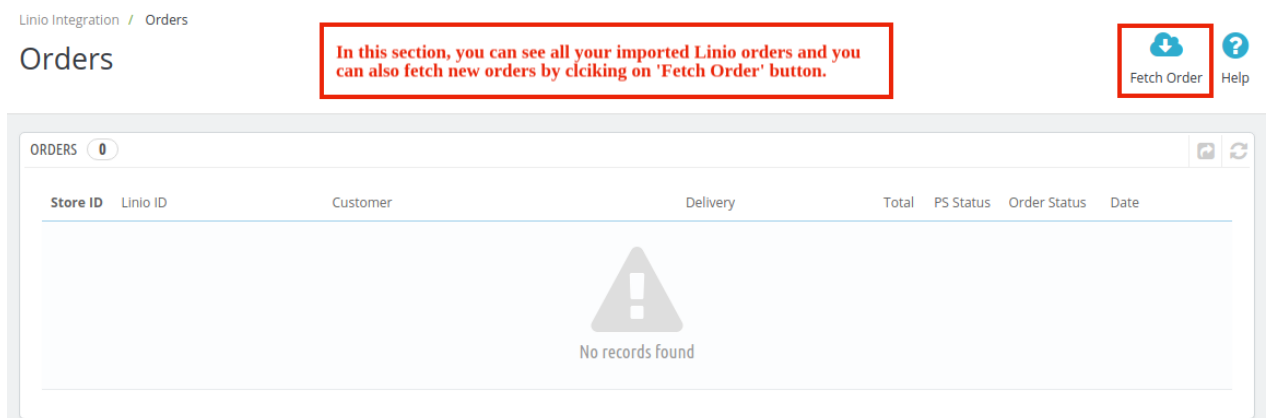
## 6. Manage Linio Orders

### *To manage Linio orders in the PrestaShop Admin panel*

1. Go to the **Prestashop admin panel**.
2. In the left navigation panel, place cursor on **Linio Module** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Once you click on this submenu, you will be redirected to the page containing the orders as shown in the figure:



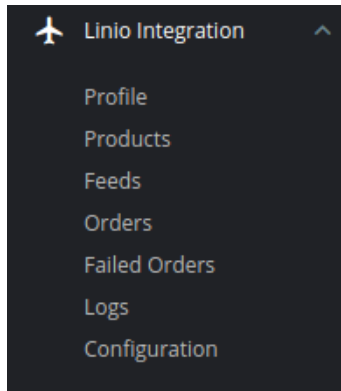
4. In the **Linio Orders**, do the following steps:
  - a. In the **Store ID** box, you can see your Prestashop store ID.
  - b. In the **Linio ID**, you can see your eBay account ID.
  - c. In the **Delivery**, you can see the name of the shipment method.
  - d. In the **Customer**, you can see the name of the customer.
  - e. In the **Total**, you can see the Average Order amount.
  - f. In the **PS Status**, you can see the status of the order at Prestashop (as set in the product profile).
  - g. In the **Order Status**, you can see the status of the order at eBay.

- h. In the **Date**, you can see the date when the orders were received.
5. By clicking on the **Fetch Order** button, you can fetch the orders instantly.

## 7. Manage Failed Orders

*To cancel the failed order:*

1. Go to **Prestashop Admin Panel**
2. On the left navigation bar, place the cursor on **Linio Integration** and you will see it getting expanded as below:



3. Click on **Mlibre Failed Orders**.

4. Now, this can be done both in bulk or by canceling a particular failed order.
