

Etsy Multi-Account Magento 2 Integration User Guide

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1. Overview

CedCommerce has developed Etsy Multi-Account Magento 2 Integration extension to enable the seller's list products easily on Etsy using the multi-accounts. The advanced, easy to use Etsy Multi-Account Integration for Magento from CedCommerce brings you an exclusive option to list your products using multiple accounts on the Etsy marketplace and earn globally.

Key Features of Extension:

- **Switch between multiple Etsy Accounts easily** – Start managing your eCommerce business and sell using multiple Etsy accounts, all at a single place.
- **Sending products on Etsy gets easy** – Create a profile for the similar type of products, add the products to it, and send those on Etsy every time, easily.
- **Upload products on Etsy in one go** – With the seller-friendly interface, it enables you to send the Magento products on Etsy in an instant.
- **Activate/Deactivate products on Etsy** – Deactivate your listed products on the Etsy marketplace and retire them. When needed, activate them once again.
- **Map Magento attributes with Etsy** – The advanced extension enables you to map the Magento 2 store's product attributes to that of the Etsy marketplace.

2. Installation of Extension

To Install Extension:

1. Log in the FTP, and then go to Magento 2 root folder (generally present under the public_html folder).
2. Create a new folder named code under the app folder; under code folder, create a folder named Ced.
3. Upload or Drag and Drop [app/code/Ced/EtsyMultiAccount](#)
4. After successfully uploading the directory, the extension will be installed or upgraded.
5. Now run the following upgrade command in cmd:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade  
php bin/magento setup:di:compile  
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy  
chmod -R 777 generated/  
chmod -R 777 pub/  
chmod -R 777 var/
```

3. Install PHP SDK

To Install PHP SDK,

1. Go to the <https://github.com/cedcommerce/etsy-php>(<https://github.com/cedcommerce/etsy-php>)
2. Scroll down to the Etsy PHP SDK section.
The page appears as shown in the following figure:

Based on [Etsy Rest API description](#) output, this wrapper provides a simple client with all available methods on Etsy API (thanks to the `__call` magic PHP method!), validating its arguments on each request (Take a look to [this link](#) for full list of methods and its arguments).

- cURL devel:
 - Ubuntu: `sudo apt-get install libcurl4-dev`
 - Fedora/CentOS: `sudo yum install curl-devel`
- OAuth pecl package:
 - `sudo pecl install oauth`
 - And then add the line `extension=oauth.so` to your `php.ini`

3. Make sure that the mentioned requirements are fulfilled.

4. After fulfilling the requirements, Now run the following command for installing the SDK composer require [cedcommerce/etsy-php](#)


4. Retrieve the Etsy API Credentials

The merchant has to first create a seller account in the Etsy seller panel. Once the seller account is created and is approved by Etsy, the store owner has to retrieve the API Credentials. The merchant has to enter these API Key details on the Etsy Developers page.


To Retrieve API Key Details from Etsy,

1. Go to the <https://www.etsy.com/developers>(<https://www.etsy.com/developers>) link.


The page appears as shown in the following figure:



2. Enter your Username and password to sign up for your Etsy account.
3. Once get logged in, then Register as a developer

4. Once registration is done, your App has been made.
5. Then, get the API key credentials,
 - o Key string
 - o Shared Secret
 The page appears as shown in the following figure:




5. Etsy Multi-Account Configuration

After obtaining the API credentials from the Etsy Developer account, the Magento 2 store owner has to paste them into the respective fields displayed on the Etsy Multi-Account Configuration page of the admin panel.

To Set up Configuration Settings,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Etsy Multi-Account Integration** menu.
The menu appears as shown below:



3. Click **Configuration**.
The **Configuration Page** appears as shown in the following figure:

- Under **Product Upload Settings**, do the following steps:
 - In the **Who Made** list, select the option of who made the product.
 - In the **When Made** list, select the option from the list when was the product made.
 - In the **State list**, select the state of the product.
 - In the **Product Price** option, select one of the following options:
 - a. **Increase by Fixed Price**: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Price** field appears.
 - b. **Increase by Fixed Percentage**: If selected, then the **Modify by Percentage Price** field appears.
 Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the Etsy product price by the entered value % of Magento price.
For Example,
 Magento 2 price + 5% of Magento 2 price.
 Magento 2 Price = 100
 Select **Increase By Fixed Percentage** option
Modify by Percentage Price = 5
 $100 + 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 + 5 = 105$
 Thus, Etsy Product Price = 105
 - c. **Decrease by Fixed Price**: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Price** field appears.
 - d. **Decrease by Fixed Percentage**: If selected, then the **Modify by Percentage Price** field appears.
 Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Etsy product price by the entered value % of Magento 2 price.
For Example,
 Magento 2 price – 5% of Magento 2 price.
 Magento 2 Price = 100
 Select **Decrease By Fixed Percentage** option
Modify by Fix Price = 5
 $100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$
 Thus, Etsy Product Price = 95
 - In **Product Inventory** option, select one of the following options:
 - a. **Increase by Fixed Quantity**: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Quantity** field appears.
 - b. **Decrease by Fixed Quantity**: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Quantity** field appears.
 - In the **Watermark image** box, select the **Yes** option, if you want to send a watermark image on Etsy multi-account.
 - In the **Convert Currency** option, select the option **Yes** if you want to convert the currency based on location account.
6. In the right panel, click on the **Etsy Multi-Account Order Setting**.
 The tab expands as shown below:

- Under **Etsy Multi-Account Order Settings**, do the following steps:
 - In **Order Notification Email**, enter the email id on which you want to receive the order notifications.
 - In **Etsy Order Id Prefix**, enter Prefix for Etsy Order Increment id.
 - In **Order Fetch for Out of Stock Product**, select the **Yes** option to fetch the order for out of stock products.
 - In **Auto Order Fetch**, select the **Yes** option to auto-fetch order from Etsy multi-account.
 - In **Tracking Number Available**, select the **Yes** option if you require a tracking number for the shipment.
 - In the **Select Store**, select the store view.
 - In the **Shipping Method for Etsy Orders**, select the shipment method for Etsy multi-account orders.
 - In the **Payment Method of Etsy Orders**, select the payment method for Etsy multi-account

orders.

- In **Create Real Customer**, select the option Yes if you want to create a customer with its name.

***Note**: If the admin select No option then, another field appears as shown in the figure above. Fill out the details of **Customer First Name**, **Customer Last Name**, **Customer Group**, **Customer Group**, **Customer Email**, and **Customer Password**. These details entered will be shown instead of the real customer name when the option is selected as **No**.*

- In the **Create New Product(If Not Exist)**, create new products if SKU not found in the Magento store.

7. In the right panel, click on the **Etsy Multi-Account Third Party Product Setting**.

- Under **Etsy Multi-Account Third Party Product Setting**, do the following steps:
 - In **Sync Product on the bases**, select the option on which basis you need to sync the Etsy multi-account products.
 - In **Magento Attribute**, select the Magento attribute for listing.
 - In **Auto Fetch Third Party Product**, select the **Yes** option to automatically fetch third-party products.
 - In **Auto Sync Third Party Product**, select the **Yes** option, to automatically synchronize third party products.

8. In the right panel, click on the **Cron Setting**.

The tab expands as shown below:

- Under **Cron Settings**, do the following steps:
 - In **Auto Inventory Sync**, select Yes option to automatically update inventory while the products edit.

- In Auto Update Order Status, select the Yes option, to automatically update the status of orders from Etsy multi-account.
9. Click on the **Save Config** button to save the configurations done.


After the configuration, you need to manage the account in Etsy Multi-Account. To manage accounts you can perform the following actions:

- **Edit, Fetch and Regenerate categories**
- **Perform Actions in Bulk**

6.1. To Create New Account

To Create A New Account,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Etsy Multi-Account Integration** menu.
The menu appears as shown below:



3. Click **Manage Accounts**.





6. Under **Account Information**, do the following steps:


- In **Account, Status Enabled**, enable the status of your account.
 - In **Account Code**, enter the code for your account.
 - In **Key String**, paste the corresponding value copied from the Etsy Developer panel.
 - In **Shared Secret**, paste the corresponding secret key copied from the Etsy Developer panel.
- *Note: For Username and Shop name, you first need to login in Etsy developer account, Click on Profile Button. The page appears as shown in the following figure:**



- In the **User Name** box, enter the User Id from the Etsy Developer panel account. The page appears from where you get the username as shown in the following figure:



- Copy the user name from the highlighted section as shown in the image above.
- In the **Shop Name** box, enter the Shop Name from the Etsy Developer panel account. The page appears from where you get the Shop name as shown in the following figure:



- You can copy the Shop Name and paste in the Magento Admin Seller panel.
- After entering all the above details click on the **Save** button.


- After saving, the details in **Access Token**, **Access Token Secret** and **Verifier Code** will automatically be fetched.





7.1. Add New Profile

To Add a New Profile,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Etsy Multi-Account Integration** menu.

3. Click **Profile Manager**.

 - Note:** It is only for internal use. Use the unique profile code with no spaces. Start with small letters.
 - In the **Profile Name** box, enter the name of the profile.
 - Note:** Use the unique name to identify the profile.
 - In the **Profile Status** list, select Enabled to enable the profile.
 - Note:** The Inactive option disables the profile.
6. Click **Save and Continue**.
7. In the left navigation panel, click the **Category & Attribute**.

8. In the right panel under **Category Mapping**, do the following steps:
 - In the **Root Level Category** list, select the required category.
If the selected category has subcategories, then the next category level field is activated.
 - In the **Level 1 Category** list, select the required subcategory.
Similarly, if this sub-category consists of the next level of subcategory, then the next category level is activated.
 - Select the categories until the last level of the selected category.
9. Scroll down to the **Etsy-Magento Required Attributes Mapping** section, and do the following steps:
 - In the **Magento Catalog Attribute** column, select the required Magento attribute from the corresponding list to map it with the corresponding Etsy attribute.

- Repeat the mapping of all the required Magento attributes listed with the corresponding Etsy attributes.
10. Click the **Save and Continue** button.
 11. Now scroll down to **Etsy / Magento Attribute Mapping (Variant Attribute Mapping)**. Under this section, the configurable products are mapped from Magento attributes to Etsy attributes.
 12. In the left navigation panel, click **Other Details**.
In the right panel, the page appears as shown in the following figure:



Note: You can assign one product to one profile only. It means, you can assign multiple products to the same profile but can associate a product only with one profile at one time. To assign a product to another profile, you have to remove that product from the currently assigned profile.

 The created profile is saved and listed on the **Manage Profile** page.


7.2. Edit the existing Profile








