1. Overview

Discogs to Magento 2 Product Importer is an extension that allows sellers to import Discogs products from the Discogs marketplace to the Magento 2 store easily. This product importer facilitates the importing of simple and configurable products in your Magento 2 store. The extension is designed with exclusive features to enhance the product importing.

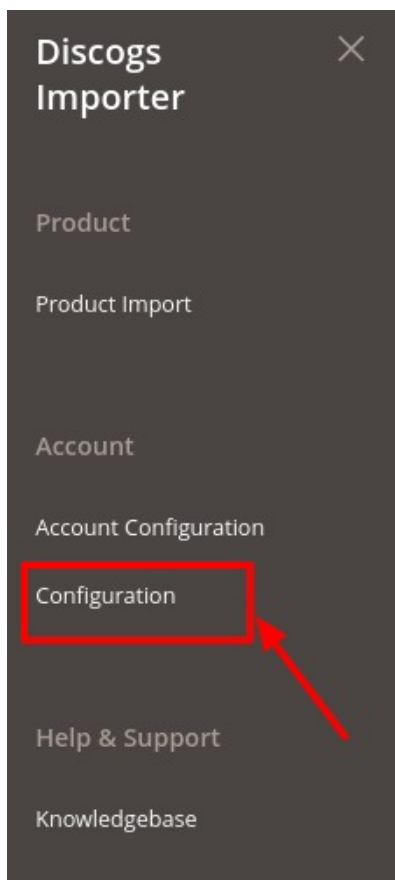
Key Features:

- Import any number of products on the Magneto 2 store in a single click.
- The product details are automatically imported to Magento 2 store from the Discogs marketplace, making it effortless for sellers.
- The product attributes can easily be imported from the Discogs marketplace to Magento 2 store.

2. Discogs Product Importer Configuration Settings

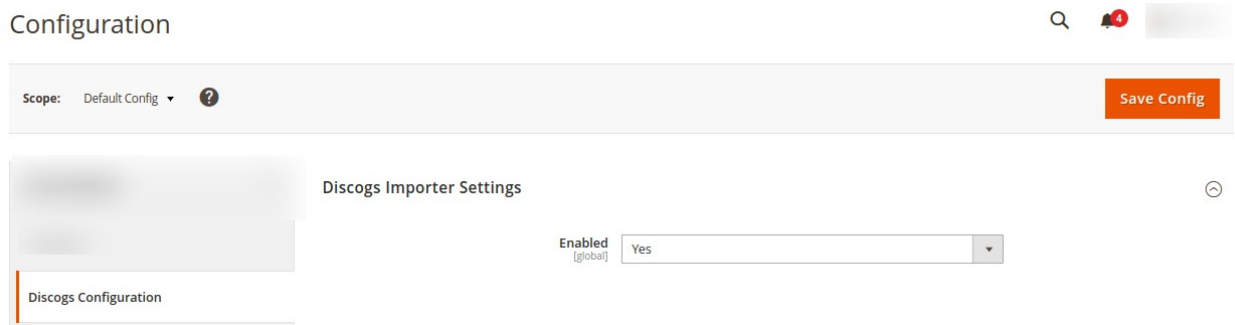
To set up the Discogs Product Importer Configuration Settings,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin panel**.
2. On the left navigation bar click on the **Discogs Importer** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on **Configuration**.

The **Configuration** page appears as shown in the following figure:

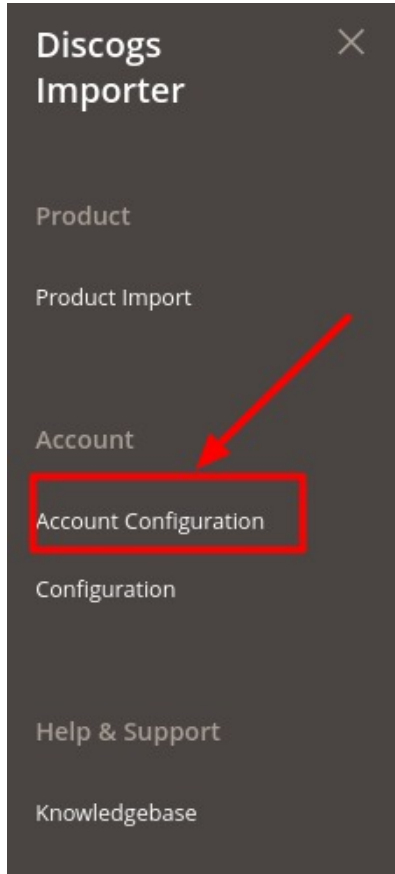


4. In the **Enabled**, select **Yes** under the **Discogs Importer Settings Section**.

3. Account Configuration

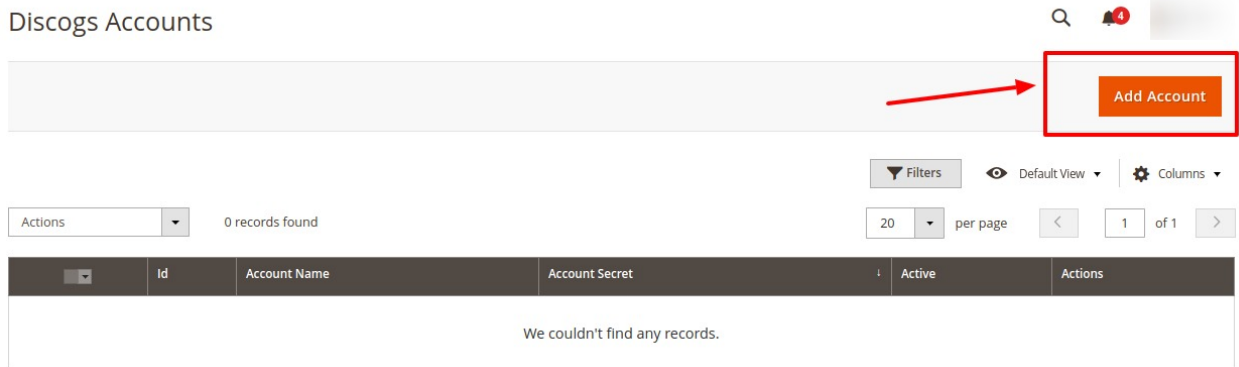
To set up Accounts Configuration

1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar click on the **Discogs Importer** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on **Account Configuration**.

4. Click on **Add Account**.

5. In the **Active** switch the button to **Yes**.

6. In **Account Name**, enter the name.

7. In the **Default Store**, select the view of the store.

8. In Acces Token, follow the steps shown in video and copy the access token and paste it here.

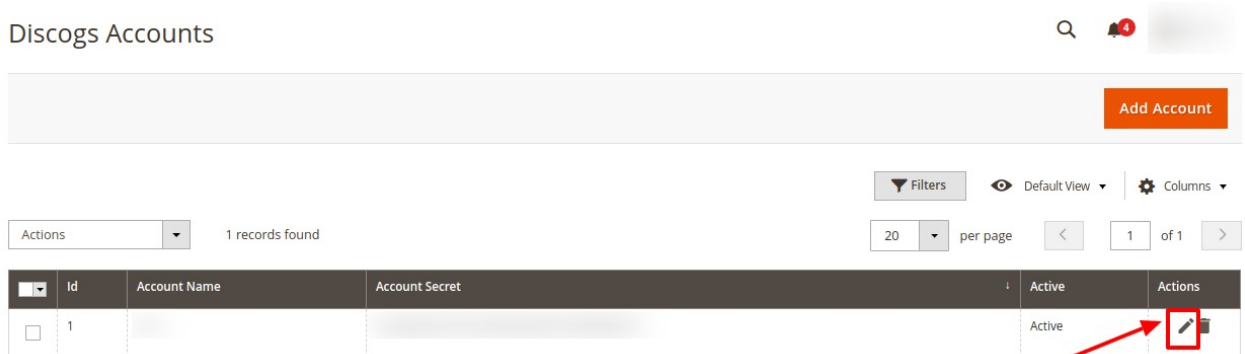
9. Then **Click on Validate**.

10. Now Click on **Save** Button.

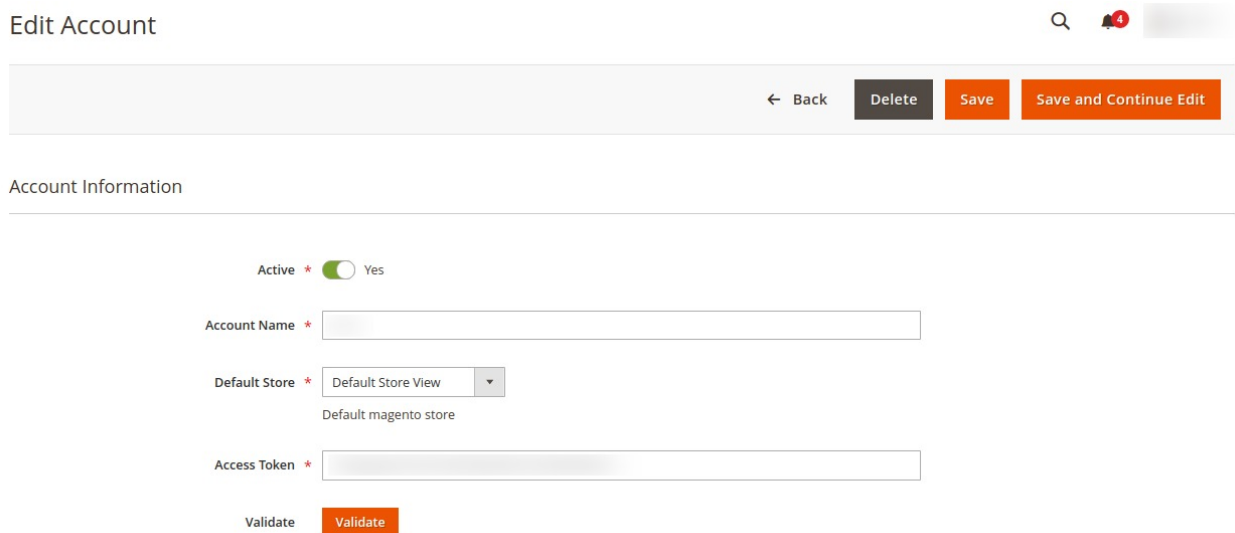
The new account will be created.

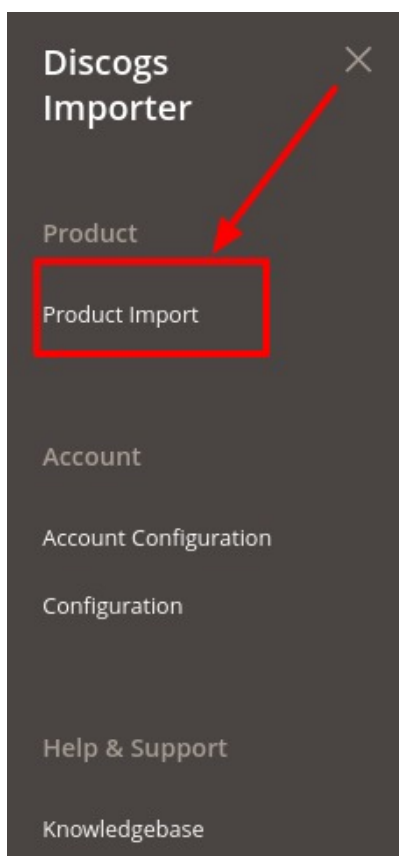

4. Import Product


To Import Products,



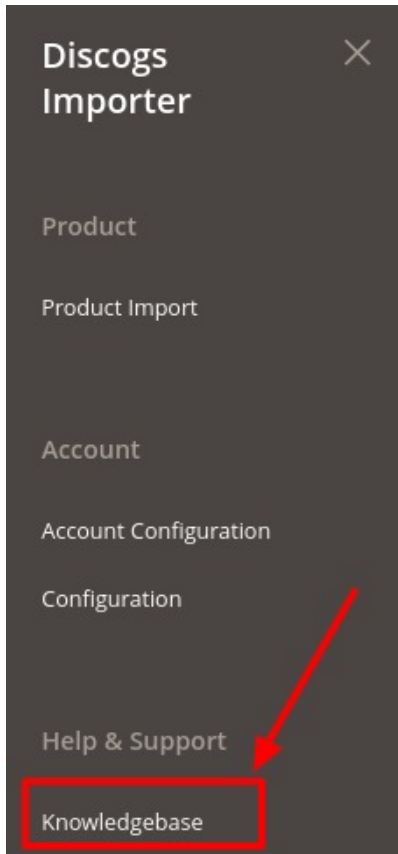
8. Click on **Save** button.

5. Knowledge base

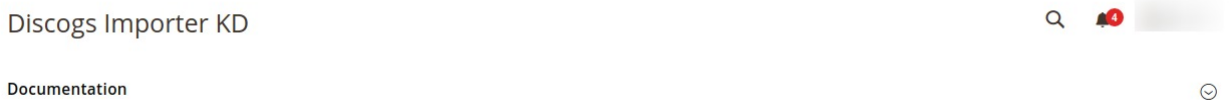
1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
