Discogs To Magento 2 Product Importer User Manual

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1. Overview

Discogs to Magento 2 Product Importer is an extension that allows sellers to import Discogs products from the Discogs marketplace to the Magento 2 store easily. This product importer facilitates the importing of simple and configurable products in your Magento 2 store. The extension is designed with exclusive features to enhance the product importing.

Key Features:

- Import any number of products on the Magneto 2 store in a single click.
- The product details are automatically imported to Magento 2 store from the Discogs marketplace, making it effortless for sellers.
- The product attributes can easily be imported from the Discogs marketplace to Magento 2 store.

2. Discogs Product Importer Configuration Settings

To set up the Discogs Product Importer Configuration Settings,

- 1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar click on the **Discogs Importer** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on **Configuration**.

3. Account Configuration

To set up Accounts Configuration

- 1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar click on the **Discogs Importer** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on Account Configuration.
