1. Overview

VidaXL is an eCommerce website based in the Netherlands and is present in 29 European countries, Australia and the USA.

VidaXL Multi-Channel Integration for Magento 2 helps the Magento 2 store owners to synchronize the product listing between the Magento 2 store and the VidaXL sellers. It also manages the VidaXL orders on the Magento stores without making any significant changes in the operational functionalities.

Key Features:

- **Profile Based Product Upload:** Enables sellers to upload the products by assigning them into the profile and then uploads it based on the profiles.
- Bulk Upload System: No need to manually list products one by one on the VidaXL as sellers can easily upload products in bulk.
- **Notifications**: Keeps the sellers updated about the new orders, change in quantity, price, product title or description through emails.
- **Rejected Products Notification:** If any product gets rejected from the VidaXL then its information is fetched automatically along with the errors.
- **Real-Time Synchronisation:** At regular intervals of time the inventory, price, orders and other details get automatically synchronised.
- **Product Management:** Create products manually with our integration, upload items via XML or import data in Magento 2 store, and also easily fix data issues.

2. Configuration Settings

• Under this VidaXL Price Settings tab, do the following steps:

- Increase by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
- Increase by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears.

Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the **VidaXL**, product price by the entered value % of Magento 2 price.

For Example,

Magento 2 price + 5% of Magento 2 price.

Select Increase By Fixed Percentage option Modify by Percentage Price = 5100 + 5% of 100 = 100 + 5 = 105Thus, VidaxL Product Price = 105

Decrease by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
 Decrease by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears.

Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the **VidaXL** product price by the entered value % of Magento 2 price

For Example,
Magento 2 price – 5% of Magento 2 price.
Magento 2 Price = 100
Select Decrease By Fixed Percentage option
Modify by Fix Price = 5
100 - 5\% of 100 = 100 - 5 = 95
Thus, VidaXL Product Price = 95

 - In the Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case, enter the required value.

 - In Order Notification Email, enter the mail id on which you want to receive notifications.
 - In Auto Accept Order, select Yes if want the orders to be accepted automatically.
 - In **Enable Default Customer**, select **Yes** if you want the customer to be created by default and then a box will appear to enter his email id.
 - In **Refund Order on VidaXL**, select **Yes** for the order refund on the marketplace. Once you select yes you also need to select the reason for the refund.
- 9. Scroll down and click on VidaXL Cron Settings, the tab is expanded as:
