1. Overview

Claro Shop is an eCommerce store with an extensive number of products from stores such as Telmex, Sanborns, Sears, Telcel, Samsung and Grupo Pagui which has its headquarters in Mexico. The annual revenue of Claro Shop marketplace is \$2 million.

Claro Shop integration for Magento 2 is a tool that integrates Claro Shop seller panel with Magento 2 store for an automated selling experience. This extension helps to sell products on Claro Shop Marketplace. With the help of this extension, you can easily manage products, price, inventory and automate orders between your Magento 2 store and Claro Shop Marketplace.


Key Features:

- **Profile Based Bulk Product Upload:** You can create profiles and then map the category and attributes of the Claro Shop marketplace to Magento 2 store. After assigning the products to the profiles, you can also upload the products to Claro Shop.
- **Real-Time Sync:** This extension automatically synchronizes the inventory, price, product and other details at regular intervals of time.
- **New Order Notifications:** Whenever a new order is fetched from the Claro Shop marketplace, you will be notified through mail about that new order.
- **Creation of Magento Orders:** The orders received on Claro Shop are also created automatically on the Magento 2 store with the same details as it is on the Claro Shop marketplace.

2. Configuration Settings


To set up the configuration settings

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Claro Shop Integration** menu.
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on **Configuration**.

The **Configuration** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. In the **Enabled**, select **Yes** to configure the settings.
5. In the **App Id**, enter the application id from the Claro Shop seller panel.
6. In **End Point Url**, select the API url.
7. In **Public Key**, enter the key from the Claro Shop seller panel.
8. In **Private Key**, enter the private key from the seller panel.
9. In the **Select Store**, select the store view.
10. Click on **Save Config** button.
The configuration settings will be saved.

3. Manage Profile


In the Manage Profile Section, admin can perform the following functions:

3.1. Add New Profile


To add a new profile,



5. Under **Information**, do the following steps:
 - In the **Profile Status**, select **Yes** to enable the profile that you are creating.
 - In **Profile Name**, enter the name for the profile.
6. Under **Mappings**, select a category and map all the Claro Shop attributes with Magento attributes.
7. In the **Products Section**, add the products for that profile.
8. Click on **Save** button.
The profile will be created.

3.2. Edit Existing Profile

To edit a profile,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Claro Shop Integration** menu.


- Click the required section, and then make the changes as per requirement in the respective section.

3.3. Upload Products to Profile


To upload the profile products,


4. Scroll down to the required profile row.

3.4. Delete Profile


To delete a profile,

5. A box will appear asking you to confirm your action of deleting a profile.


6. Click **OK**.

The profile will be deleted.


3.5. Submit Actions in Bulk on Profiles

To perform actions in bulk,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Claro Shop Integration** menu.

3. Click on **Manage Profiles**.
The **Manage Profile** page appears as shown in the following figure:




4. *To delete the selected profiles, do the following steps:*
 - Select the profiles those are no more required.
 - Click the **Arrow** button next to the **Actions** field.
 - Click the **Delete** option.
A confirmation dialog box appears.
 - Click the **OK** button.
The selected profiles are deleted.
5. *To change the status of the selected profiles, do the following steps:*
 - Select the required profiles.
 - Click the **Arrow** button next to the **Actions** field.
 - Click the **Change Status** option. On selecting it, the options for status appear as **Enable** or **Disable**.
 - Selected profiles get enabled or disabled and a message appears as on top of the page. Also, under the **Status** column, the status gets changed.

4. Manage Products

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Claro Shop Integration** menu.





- To view Order details, click on **View** icon in the **Actions** column.




Order details will be displayed.

- To delete an order click on **Delete** button under the **Actions** column.




The selected order will be deleted.




