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1. A Brief Overview On MyWorld Integration

The MyWorld Integration for Magento by CedCommerce interacts with the MyWorld marketplace resulting in perfect synchronization of product listings, pricing, inventory, and orders. Sellers can automate the complete workflow of their Magento store and experience efficient selling like never before.

“It is to be noted that unlike any other eCommerce Integration with MyWorld, this is the ONLY native Magento integration to do sales on MyWorld marketplace.” Sellers on MyWorld can now easily leverage from this tailor-made Magento 2 MyWorld extension by customizing their Magento store according to their needs.

Some Key features of MyWorld Magento Integration includes:

- **Profile Based Products Sync:** Admin can create a profile and after assigning the products to the profile can easily add/delist/delete on MyWorld.
- **Simple & Configurable Product Sync:** It enables admin to add/delist/delete both simple & configurable type of product on MyWorld.com.
- **Automated Synchronization:** Auto synchronization of the price, order, inventory, return, and refund, and pricing at regular intervals is established between Magento® 2 store and MyWorld.com.
- **Product Data Validation:** The extension enables the admin to validate the product information in accordance with MyWorld standard and values.
- **Cron:** Cron jobs automate the process to fetch the MyWorld orders from the MyWorld marketplace to the Magento® of customers.
- **Debug Mode:** Provides easy debug process for hassle-free product sync to the MyWorld marketplace.
- **Rejected products report:** If any product containing some invalid details is rejected, then its information is fetched from the auto synchronization request along with the error due to which it is rejected.

2. How To Install MyWorld Integration in Magento 2 Store

To install the extension

1. Create a new folder named `code` (if not exists) under the `app` folder.
 - Extract the Ced.zip on your system and then Drag and Drop `app/code/Ced/MyWorld` and `app/code/Ced/Integrator` directory inside `code`.
2. Update composer.json file by adding the code written below inside autoload ->psr-4 and as shown in the image:


```
"MyWorld\\Sdk\\": "app/code/Ced/MyWorld/Lib/myworld-sdk"
```
3. Now run the following upgrade command in `cmd`
 - `composer dump`
 - `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
 - `php bin/magento setup:di:compile`
 - `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f`


- `php bin/magento indexer:reindex`
- `php bin/magento cache:flush`

4. After successfully uploading the directory, the extension will be installed/updated.

3. How To Perform Configuration Settings

Read along these steps to perform the configuration settings in the Magento 2 Admin panel


1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.



2. On the left navigation bar, click the **MYWORLD INTEGRATION** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click **Configuration**.

4. In the right panel, click the **MyWorld Settings** tab.

The **MyWorld Settings** tab is expanded and the relevant fields appear as shown in the following figure:

5. Under **MyWorld Settings**, do the following:
 - In the **Enabled** list, select the **Yes** option.
 - This will activate the extension and hence enable you to use its full features. **Note:** Make Sure to **Clear the Flush** every time you make any changes in the configuration settings section to ensure smooth flow of the integration.
6. Scroll down to the **MyWorld Product Settings** tab, and then click the tab. The **MyWorld Product Settings** tab is expanded and the expanded section appears as shown in the following figure:

Auto Add Product on MyWorld [global]

The product assigned to profile will be Auto add on MyWorld.

Auto Add Product On Profile [global]

The Product Auto Add On Profile By Magento Category And Upload on MyWorld

Remove Product from profile on Conflict [global]

While saving products to profile, remove product from previous profile if marketplace is same on both the profiles .

NOTE: A profile is a collection of similar type of products which allows you to perform actions in bulk, hence saving time and effort.

8. Under this **Profile Settings**, do the following steps:
 - In **Auto Upload Product on MyWorld**, select **Yes** if you wish to automatically add the product on MyWorld, as soon as the product is added in the profile.
 - In **Auto Add Product On Profile**, select **Yes** if you want to automatically add products to profile and then upload the same products on MyWorld.
 - In **Remove Product from Profile on Conflict**, select **Yes** if you want to remove the products from

the profile if the marketplace is the same on both the profile while saving the products.

9. Click **MyWorld Chunk Settings**, the section will expand as:

Product Chunk Size [global]

Enter the size of a chunk for a product add/delete/delist task

Inventory Price Chunk Size [global]

Enter the size of a chunk for a inventory & price sync task

Product Status Chunk Size [global]

Enter the size of a chunk for product status sync task

In the **Product Chunk Size** box, enter the size number of a chunk for adding, deleting, or delisting products.

In the **Inventory Price Chunk Size** box, enter the size number of a chunk for the synchronization of inventory and price.

In the **Product Status Chunk Size**, enter the size of the chunk for the synchronization of product status.

10. Click **MyWorld Price Settings**, the tab gets expanded as:

Currency Conversion Marketplace Wise [global]

i. Choose **YES** in the Enable column to to enable the Price Sync from Magento 2 to MyWorld.

ii. In the **Product Price** list, select one of the following options:

You can select the default Magento price by selecting **Default Magento Price**. This will make the product price on MyWorld the same as your Magento store panel.

Increase by Fixed Price: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Price** field appears.

Increase by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the **Modify by Percentage Price** field appears.

Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the **MyWorld**, product price by the entered value % of the Magento 2 store price.

For Example,

Magento 2 price + 5% of Magento 2 price.

Magento 2 Price = 100

Select **Increase By Fixed Percentage** option

Modify by Percentage Price = 5

$100 + 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 + 5 = 105$

Thus, MyWorld Product Price = 105

Decrease by Fixed Price: If selected, then the **Modify by Fix Price** field appears.

Decrease by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the **Modify by Percentage Price** field appears.

Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the MyWorld product price by the entered value % of Magento 2 price

For Example,

Magento 2 price – 5% of Magento 2 price.

Magento 2 Price = 100

Select **Decrease By Fixed Percentage** option

Modify by Fix Price = 5

$100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$

Thus, MyWorld Product Price = 95

- iii. In **Map Attributes** section, you can Map your price attribute for the marketplace with any custom attribute (such as barcode, sku, price, etc) of your Magento store. You can choose multiple attributes by clicking on Add attributes.
- iv. In **Customer Group**, choose the targeted customer group if you have selected 'Tier Price' attribute or price syncing.
- v. In **Currency Conversion Marketplace wise**, select **Yes** if you want to send price after converting it to marketplace currency.

11. Now click on **MyWorld Inventory Settings**, the section is expanded as:

Under **MyWorld Inventory Settings**, do the following steps:

- Choose **Yes** in the **Enable** section to enable the inventory sync from Magento 2 to MyWorld.
 - In **Set Inventory on Basis of Threshold**, select **Enable** if you want to send inventory on MyWorld by condition of Threshold value for your inventory.
 - In **Inventory Threshold Breakpoint Value**, enter the threshold quantity on which lesser and greater condition will act upon.
 - In **Inventory Value for Less Than**, enter the value that will be sent to your MyWorld seller panel for those products, whose inventory is LESS than or equal to the inventory threshold breakpoint.
 - In **Inventory Value for Greater Than**, enter the value that will be sent to your MyWorld seller panel for those products, whose inventory is MORE than the inventory threshold breakpoint.
 - In **Map Attribute**, map MyWorld qty attribute with the Magento Attribute
 - You can Map your more **qty** attribute for the marketplace with any **custom** attribute by Clicking on **Add Attributes** button.
 - In **Default Quantity**, choose a default value of the stocks to be displayed on the MyWorld panel if manage stock is set to No.
12. Scroll down to the **MyWorld Order Settings** tab, and then click the tab.
The tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:

Ex: US-1100001

Ex: 111-111111-111111
- **Add Prefix:** It will add a prefix provided in the Magento Order Increment Id.
Ex: MYWORLD-1100001
- **All Rules Applied:** the increment id will look like
Ex: MYWORLD-US111-111111-111111

- If you have different MyWorld SKU then Magento SKU. Then map the custom SKU field in above and provide the values as mentioned.
- **Single MyWorld SKU:** Just add the value of SKU in the selected attribute.
- **Multiple MyWorld SKU:** Just add the value of SKU in the selected attribute separated by pipe.
Ex: " || MYWORLD-SKU-1 || MYWORLD-SKU2 || MYWORLD-SKU-3 || "
- Default value is Magento "sku" attribute.

Automatically create unavailable product [global] ▼

If yes, then it will automatically create unavailable product during order import.

- In **Time for Auto Import**, select the time for which cron will automatically import the order.
- In **Auto Invoice Imported Order**, select **Enable** to create an invoice in Magento for imported order in any case of any successful import.
- In **Cancel Orders Reason**, select a reason to be sent to MyWorld in case of an order Cancellation.
- In **Refund Orders Reason**, select a reason to be sent to MyWorld in case of an order Refund.
- In **Increment Id Rules**, you have the rules to **Add Marketplace Code, Add MyWorld Order Id, Add Prefix**.
- In the **MyWorld Order Id Prefix** box, enter the required order Id prefix.
- In the **Create Backorder**, select **Yes** if you want to create an order if the product is out of stock.
- In **Enable Default Customer**, select **Yes** if you want to create an order with default customer, no new customer will be created during order import.

- Once you select **Yes**, a field appears of **Default Customer**, enter the email of the customer.
- In **Use Default Customer's Billing Address**, select **Yes** if you want to use the billing address of the customer.
- In **Enable Guest Customer**, select **Yes** if you want to create guest customers on order import.
- In **Create Region/State**, select **Yes** if you want to create the region or state in the Magento directory if it is not present at the time of order import.
- In **Create Default Region**, select **Yes** if you want to create the region for the order by default.
- If Magento SKU does not match with MyWorld SKU, then select **alternate Magento attribute** which consist of MyWorld SKU.
- In **Automatically create unavailable product**, select **Yes** to create the product automatically if it is not available.

13. Click **MyWorld Cron Settings** and the section will expand as:

- In the **Order Cron** list, select the **Enable** option to enable the fetch order cron.
 - Once you Enable this, you need to set the time frame for the order cron to run. In the **Order Cron Time**, set the time frame for which you wish to automatically set the cron.
 - In the **Inventory And Price Cron** list, select the **Enable** option to enable the inventory and price sync cron.
 - Similarly select the time frame by clicking on **Inventory And Price Cron Time**.
 - In the **Shipment Cron** list, select the **Enable** option to enable the shipment cron and to generate shipments automatically.
 - Similarly select the time frame by clicking on **Shipment Cron Time**.
14. Scroll down to the **MyWorld Developer Settings** tab, and then click the tab.
The tab is expanded and the section appears as shown in the following figure:

Throttle Mode [global]

MyWorld API allows only **60 calls per hour** for product upload.
Hence, the module works in 2 modes:
1. **Throttle Mode**: By default, it takes the Magento request and process it later, which never exceed the 60 calls per hour.
2. **Non-Throttle Mode**: It process the request immediately, but may exceed the API throttle. **Disable only for integration testing**.

Debug [global]

Logging Level [global]

16. In the **Throttle Mode** list, select the Enable option to process the upload and sync task through the queue. Disable only for integration testing.
17. In **Debug**, select **Enable** for the logs to be created.
18. In **Logging Level**, select the level of the logs created, select **No Muting** for all the levels.
19. Click the **Save Config** button to save the entered values and information. The configuration will be saved.

Note: Make Sure to **Clear the Cache** every time you make any changes in the configuration settings section to ensure smooth flow of the integration


4. How To Add & Manage Multiple MyWorld Seller Accounts

The merchant has to first create a seller account in the MyWorld seller panel. Once the seller account is created and is approved by MyWorld, the Magento 2 store owners have to obtain multiple seller credentials such as API Key values from the MyWorld Seller account, and then have to paste it in the respective fields displayed on the MyWorld Account Form of the admin panel of CedCommerce Integration.

To add the account.

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Store Admin**
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **MYWORLD INTEGRATION**

A menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click **Manage Accounts**.



- The **Payment Method** is also automatically assigned by MyWorld. Similar to the shipping method, if you want to make changes in these, the go to your MyWorld seller panel and make the changes there.

10. Scroll down and click on **Developer** section and it will appear as:


