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1. Overview

Zalando is a European e-commerce company based in Berlin, Germany founded in 2008. This eCommerce company offers fashion and lifestyle products to customers in 17 European markets. Zalando marketplace was earlier famous for selling footwear. At the end of December 2012, Zalando opened its first, custom-designed logistics centre in Erfurt referred to as "Europe's largest wardrobe" because of its sheer size (120,000 square metres).

Zalando integration for Magento 2 is a tool that integrates Zalando seller panel with Magento 2 store for an automated selling experience. This extension helps sellers to list products on Zalando Marketplace easily. You can also easily manage products, price, inventory and automate orders between your Magento 2 store and Zalando Marketplace.

Key Features


- Bulk Product Upload: You have the flexibility to upload products in bulk on Zalando marketplace.
- Automatic Synchronisation: The extension facilitates inventory, price, orders and other details synchronization between Magento 2 store and Zalando Marketplace at regular intervals of time.
- Manage Multiple Accounts: You can easily integrate your multiple Zalando accounts with a single Magento 2 store.
- Simple & Configurable Products Upload: You can upload both simple and configurable type of products on the Zalando marketplace.
- **Rejected Order Notification:** If a product gets rejected on Zalando, its information is automatically fetched and listed on Magento 2 admin panel.

2. Configuration Settings

To configure the extension,


- 1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu.

The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click on Configuration.

The **Configuration** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. In the right panel, click on **Zalando API Settings**, and the section expands as:

Zalando Api Settings



- 5. Under Zalando Api Settings, do the following steps:
 - In the **Enabled** list, select **Yes** to enable the extension features.
 - In **Mode**, select the account mode from the list.
 - In Sandbox Client Id, enter the client id from the sandbox account.
 - In Sandbox Client Secret, enter the secret key from seller panel.
 - In Use MultiAccount, select Yes if you want to use multiple accounts.
 - In Redirect URL, the store URL is automatically fetched.
 - In Orders Fetch Start Date, select the date to start fetching the orders.
 - In Sale Channel, select the target region for the sales.
 - In the **Debug Log** list, select **Yes** to start Zalando Integration in the debug mode.
 - In the **Select Store**, select the store view.
- 6. Now scroll down and click on Profile Global Settings, the section is expanded as:



- 7. Under Profile Global Settings, do the following steps:
 - In Create Duplicate Profile with Product, select Yes if you want to create a duplicate profile for the products.
- 8. Scroll down and click on Product Global Settings, the section is expanded as:



- 9. Under Product Global Settings, do the following steps:
 - In the **Zalando Product Price** list, select one of the following options:
 - Increase by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
 - Increase by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears. Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the Zalando, product price by the entered value % of Magento price

For Example,

Magento price + 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100

Select Increase By Fixed Percentage option

Enter Percentage = 5

100 + 5% of 100 = 100 + 5 = 105

Thus, Zalando Product Price = 105

- Decrease by Fixed Price: If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
- Decrease by Fixed Percentage: If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears.

Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Zalando product price by the entered value % of Magento price.

For Example,

Magento price – 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100

Select Decrease By Fixed Percentage option


Enter Percentage = 5

100 - 5% of 100 = 100 - 5 = 95

Thus, Zalando Product Price = 95

10. Now scroll down and click on Order Settings, the section is expanded as:




- 11. Under Order Settings, do the following steps:
 - In the Create Product field, select Yes if you want to create a product if it does not exist in Magento and yet has been ordered on Zalando.
 - In the Zalando Order Id Prefix box, enter the text as a prefix for Zalando Increment ID.
 - In the Customer Email field, enter the email for which customer will be created for Zalando

Orders.

- In **Shipping**, select the shipping method of the order.
- In Payment, select the payment method of the order.
- 12. Scroll down and click on Zalando Inventory Rules, the section is expanded as:



- 13. Under Zalando Inventory Rules, do the following steps:
 - In the Set Inventory on Basis of Threshold list, select Enable to send the inventory based on the threshold.
 - In the **Inventory Threshold Value** box, enter the required value.
 - In the Send Inventory for Lesser Than Threshold Case box, enter the required value.
 - In the Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case box, enter the required value.
- 14. Scroll down and click on **Zalando Cron's**, the section is expanded as:



- 15. Under Zalando Cron, do the following steps;
 - In the **Order Cron** list, select **Enable** to enable the order fetch cron.
 - In **Price Cron**, select **Enable** to sync the price through cron.
 - $\circ\,$ In Inventory Cron, select Enable to sync the inventory.
 - In Shipment Cron, select Enable to generate the shipments automatically.
- 16. Scroll down and click on **Chunk Size Setting**, the section is expanded as:

17. Under **Chunk Size Setting**, do the following steps:


- In the Validation Size field, enter the chunk size for the products. The products that will get
 validated before being uploaded on Zalando would be the same as the number you enter in this
 field.
- In the **Upload field**, enter the number of products that you want to upload in one go from Magento to Zalando.
- In Inventory Update, enter the chunk size for inventory to be updated.
- In **Price Update**, enter the chunk size for the price.
- In the **Sync Status** field, enter the chunk size of the products. The number of products that you will be able to sync the status for would be the same as the number that you enter in this field.
- 18. Click on the **Save Config** button.

The configuration settings will be saved.

3. Account Settings


To manage the accounts in the extension,

- 1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click on Accounts.

The Manage Account page appears as shown below:



4. To add a new account, click on **Add Account** button on the top right corner. You'll be redirected on a new accounts page:




- 5. Under **Account Information**, do the following steps:
 - In Account Code, enter a unique code for your account.
 - In Client Id, enter the Client Id from the Zalando seller panel.
 - In Secret Key, enter the secret key from the Zalando Seller panel.
 - In **Account Type**, select the type of account.
 - In Valid/Invalid, the seller details status entered by you will be shown that it is valid or not.
 - In **Account Status**, select **Enable** to enable the status of the account.
 - In Account Store, select the store view.
 - In the Access Token, the token will be fetched automatically once the account is validated.
- 6. Click on Save button.


The New Account will be created and displayed in the manage orders grid.

To Edit an Account.

1. On **Zalando Accounts page**, click the **edit** button for the account that you want to edit, as shown in the image below:



2. The Edit Account page will appear as:




- 3. Make the changes as per requirement in the respective section.
- 4. Click on Save button.

The edits in the account will be saved.

To Authorise an account.

1. On **Zalando Accounts page**, click the **Authorise** button for the account that you want to authorise, as shown in the image below:



2. The account will be authorised and the status will be updated as Valid.

4. Manage Zalando Profiles


Under manage profile you can perform the following actions:

4.1. Add New Profile


To add a new profile,

- 1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click on Manage Profile.

The Manage Profile page appears as shown in the following figure:




4. Click the Add New Profile button.

The **New Profile** page appears as shown in the following figure:




- 5. In the right panel, under the **Profile Information** section, do the following steps:
 - In **Profile Code**, enter the unique code for the profile.
 - In Profile name, enter the name of the profile.
 - In Profile Status, select the status of the profile.
- 6. In the left navigation panel, click on Mapping.

The menu appears as shown below:



- In the right panel under **Category Mapping**, do the following steps:
 - In the **Account**, select the account in which you want to upload the product.
 - In **Outline**, select the root category of the product.
- Under **Zalando/Magento Attribute Mapping(Required/Optional mapping)**, map the Zalando attributes to the Magento store attributes.
- Under **Zalando/Magento Attribute Mapping(Variant Attribute mapping)**, map the different Zalando attributes to the Magento attributes.
- 7. In the left navigation panel, click the **Profile Products** menu.




- 8. All the products listed are displayed here.
- 9. Click the Save Profile button.

The profile is saved and listed on the Manage Profile page.

4.2. Edit an Existing Profile


To edit a profile,

- 1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click on Manage Profile.

The Manage Profile page appears as shown in the following figure:



- 4. Scroll down to the required profile.
- 5. In the Action column, click Edit.

You will be redirected to the profile page.




- 6. Make the changes as per the requirement.
- 7. Click the **Save Profile** button.

 The profile is saved with the updated changes and listed on the **Manage Profile** page.

4.3. Submit Bulk Actions on Profile


To perform actions in bulk,

- 1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on Manage Profile.

The Manage Profile page appears as shown in the following figure:




- 4. Click the Arrow button next to the Actions field.
 - The **Actions** list appear as shown in the above figure.
- 5. In the **Actions** list, click **Delete** to delete the selected profiles. The profiles will be deleted.
- 6. To change the status of the profiles, click on **Change Status** in the **Actions** field. The status of the selected profiles will be changed.
- 7. To create the duplicated profiles, click on **Create Duplicate** in the **Actions** field.

The duplicate profiles will be created.

5. Manage Products


To manage Zalando products,

- 1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:




3. Click on Products.

The Manage Products page appears as shown below:




- 4. To edit a product, click on the **Edit** button under **Actions** column and do the required edits in the product details.

To perform bulk actions on products.

1. In the **Actions** list, click the arrow button. A list appears as shown in the figure:




- 2. Select the checkboxes associated with the required products.
- 3. To validate products, click on the Validate Products. Selected Products will be validated.
- 4. To validate and upload products, click on **Validate and Upload Products**. Selected products will be validated and uploaded.
- 5. To update inventory, click on the **Update Inventory**. The inventory for selected products will be updated.
- 6. To update the price, click on **Update Price**. The price for selected products will be updated.

6. Manage Orders


To View Orders,

- 1. Go to the Magento 2 Admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on Orders.

The **Manage Orders** Page appears as shown below:




4. To fetch new orders click on **Fetch All New Account Orders** button. The orders will be fetched and displayed in the Order grid.

7. Cron Logs


To View Cron Logs,

The **Cron Grid** page appears as shown in the following figure:




- 4. The running crons along with the details will be displayed.

8. Activity Logs


To view activity details,

The **Zalando Log Grid** page appears as shown in the following figure:




4. The activity details will be displayed here in the grid.

9. View Outlines


To View outlines,

The Manage Outlines page appears as shown below:




- 4. The outline details will be displayed in the grid.
