

# **Instagram Feed Extension for Magento 2**

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## 1. Overview

Instagram Feed Extension for Magento helps the online store owners to embed their Instagram page photos and videos to their web page build on the Magento platform. The images on the web page appear in the same order as they are on the Instagram account.

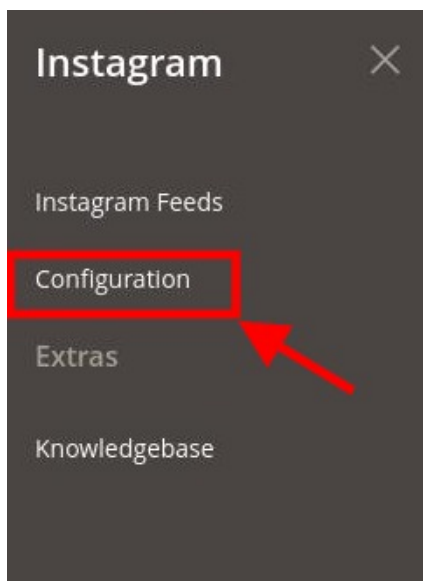
### Key features of Extension:

- Embeds all the photos and videos on the home page.
- Admin can control the displayed images with the Approved manager feature..

## 2. Configuration Settings

To configure Instagram Feed Extension,

1. Go to your **Magento 2** admin panel.
2. On the left navigation bar menu click on **Instagram**.



3. Click on **Configuration**.  
The **Configuration** page appears as shown below:

4. In the **Enable**, select **Yes** to enable the configuration settings.
5. Then before you proceed further, you need to create an app through Facebook by going on the link: <https://developers.facebook.com/docs/instagram-basic-display-api/getting-started>(<https://developers.facebook.com/docs/instagram-basic-display-api/getting-started>)
6. You can follow the steps stated in the above link to create an app. Once the app is created, the **Client ID** and **Client Secret keys** will be generated in your developer section.
7. Now, copy the **Instagram App Id** from the developer portal and paste it into the **Client Id** box.

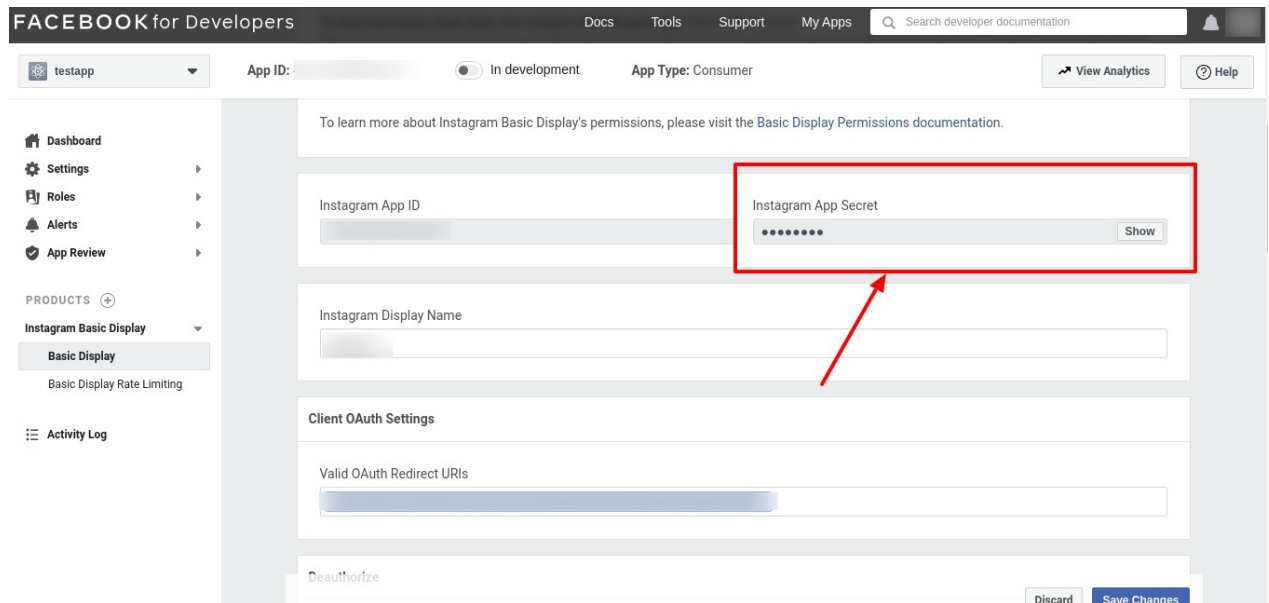

- For Client Secret, copy the **Instagram App Secret Key** from the developer portal and paste it into the Magento panel in the **Client Secret** box.



- In the **Redirect URI**, enter the site URL.
- Then click on **Generate Access Token Button** in the Config section to fetch the token. The token fetched will be displayed in the **User Token** box.
- In the **Feeds Quantity**, select the number of media you want.
- Click on the **Save Config** button. The configuration settings will be saved.

### 3. Update Instagram Feeds

To update Instagram feeds,

- Go to your **Magento 2** admin panel.
- On the left navigation bar menu click on **Instagram**.



3. Click on **Instagram Feeds**.  
The **Feed** page appears as shown below:

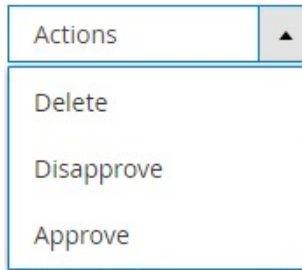

4. To update new feeds in the admin panel, click on the **Update Feeds** button and the feeds will be displayed.
5. To show any image on the frontend, you can click on **Approve**.
6. To hide any image from the frontend, click on **Disapprove**.
7. To delete an image, click on the **Delete** option under **Actions**.

### Submit Actions in Bulk

1. To perform **Approve**, **Disapprove**, **Delete** actions in Bulk, go to the **Actions** list.

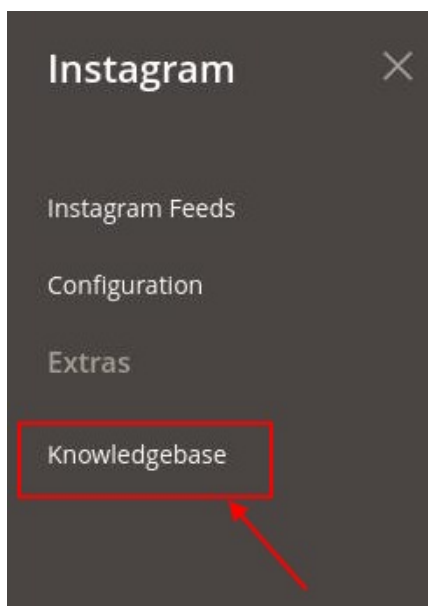


2. Click on the required action you want to perform.
