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#### 1. Overview

Rakuten was founded in 1997 and is referred to as "Amazon of Japan". Across 30,000 countries and regions across the globe, it is helping 44,000 sellers to sell on the Rakuten marketplace. Rakuten accounts for 27% of the eCommerce market share in Japan.

Rakuten US integration for Magento 2 by CedCommerce connects your Magento 2 store with the Rakuten marketplace to give you a seamless selling experience in the US. The integration also enables real-time synchronization of inventory, price, and other product details that provide ease for you to manage your Magento 2 store and your products at Rakuten US simultaneously.

#### **Key Features-**

- **Bulk Upload Feature:** Sellers can upload any number of products on the Rakuten US marketplace using bulk upload feature.
- **Auto Synchronisation:** Automatically synchronize the product listing, orders, inventory and other product-related details between Magento 2 store and Rakuten US marketplace.
- Auto Acknowledgement of Orders: Whenever a new order is placed on the Rakuten US marketplace, you will receive a notification on mail.
- Automated Shipment: With the Rakuten US Integration for Magento 2, manage Orders and their shipment from your Magento 2 panel using various shipment services.
- Rejected product Notification: If any error occurs while uploading the product on Rakuten US, you will receive a notification along with the error log.
- **Product category mapping:** Follows the many-to-one category mapping technique. You can map many categories of the Magento 2 store with the single category of Rakuten US.

# 2. Rakuten Integration Installation



You can also install the extension manually.

#### To install the extension-

- 1. Log in the **FTP**, and then go to Magento 2 root folder (generally present under the *public\_html* folder).
- 2. Create a new folder named *code* under the *app* folder; under the *code* folder, create a folder named *Ced*.
  - Upload or Drag and Drop app/code/Ced/Rakuten directory.
  - After successfully uploading the directory, the extension will be installed/upgraded.
  - Now run the following upgrade command in cmd

php bin/magento setup:upgrade php bin/magento setup:di:compile


php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f php bin/magento indexer:reindex php bin/magento cache:flush

• Once the extension is installed it appears in the main menu of the Magento panel

# 3. Configuration


#### To Configure the Rakuten US Extension,

- 1. Goto Magento 2 admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Rakuten Integration** menu. The menu appears as shown below:




3. Click on **Configuration**.

The **Rakuten Configuration** page appears as shown:




4. In the right panel click Rakuten API Settings.

The tab is expanded as shown below:



- In the **Enabled**, select the option Yes to enable the extension.
- In the BaseUrl, enter the URL shown in the above image.
- In the **Secret Key**, enter the secret key you have received from the Rakuten marketplace.
- In the **ShopURL**, paste the URL from the seller account.



- In Orders Fetch Start Date, select the date to start fetching orders.
- In **Debug Log**, select the option **Yes** to fetch issues.
- 5. Now in the right panel, click on Rakuten Order Settings.

The tab expands as shown below:




- In the Increment Id Prefix, enter the prefix for Rakuten increment ID.
- In Order Email, enter the email on which you wish to receive orders.
- In Force Product Create an Order, Enable it to create forced product orders.
- In the **Mock Order**, select Enable to create test order.
- 6. Scroll down and click on Rakuten Inventory Settings, the section is expanded as shown below:



7. Under Rakuten Inventory Settings do the following steps:

- In Warehouse, enter the Warehouse name for Rakuten inventory.
- 8. Now in the right panel click on Rakuten Cron Settings.

The tab expands as shown below:



- In Rakuten Order Cron, select Enable to fetch orders through cron.
- In Rakuten Price/Full Item Cron, select Enable to price syncing through cron.
- In Rakuten Inventory Cron, select Enable to synchronize the inventory of the Cron.


The **Manage Profile** section while selling on Rakuten US with our extension includes the following actions that you may take:

## 4.1. Add New Profile


### To Add a New Profile,

- 1. Goto Magento 2 admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the Rakuten Integration menu.
- 3. The menu appears as shown below:




4. Click on Manage Profiles.

The Manage Profile page appears as shown below:




5. To add a new profile, click on the Add New Profile button.

The **New Profile Page** appears as shown:




- 6. In the left panel, under **Profile Info.** do the following steps:
  - In the **Profile Code** box, enter the unique profile code.
  - In the **Profile Name** box, enter the name of the profile.
  - In the **Profile Status** box, select the **Enable** option to enable the profile status. If the profile status is **Disabled** then the products won't be displayed and no action will be performed on them.
- 7. In the left panel, click the Mapping menu.



- In the right panel, under **Category Mapping**, do the following steps:
  - In the Root Level Category list, select the required Rakuten category that you want to

map.

- Search the category in the Search Category option.
- Now in the right panel, under Rakuten/Magento Attribute Mapping(Required/Optional Mapping) do the following steps:
  - In the **Rakuten Attribute** column, select the required Rakuten attribute to map it with the corresponding Magento store attribute.
  - In the **Magento Catalog Attribute** column, select the required Magento store attribute to map it with the corresponding Rakuten attribute.
  - Repeat the steps to map all the required Rakuten attributes to the corresponding Magento store attributes.
- 8. In the left panel click the Profile Products menu.



Since no products are assigned to the profile, there are no products listed in the table.


- Click the Reset Filter link.
  All the products listed in the table will be shown.
- Select the checkboxes associated with the required products that you want to assign to the new profile.
  - Note: Admin can assign a product only to one profile.
- If the selected product is already assigned to some other profile, then a warning dialog box appears.
- Click the **OK** button to remove the selected product from the profile to which it is already assigned.
- 9. Click the Save Profile button.

The profile is saved and listed on the **Manage Profile** page.

## 4.2. Edit a Profile


#### To Edit a Profile,

- 1. Goto Magento 2 admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the Rakuten Integration menu.
- 3. The menu appears as shown below:




## 4. Click on Manage Profiles.

The profile is saved and listed on the Manage Profile page.

To save and manage the products, click the **Save and Manage Product** button.


OR

# 4.3. Submit Actions in Bulk


#### To Submit Actions in Bulk,

- 1. Goto Magento 2 admin panel.
- 2. On the left navigation bar, click the Rakuten Integration menu.
- 3. The menu appears as shown below:

The **Manage Profile** page appears as shown below:




- 5. Select the checkboxes associated with the required profiles.

  - In the **Actions** list, click **Disable** to disable the selected profiles.
  - A confirmation dialog box appears. Click the **OK** button.
    The selected profiles are disabled.

- In the **Actions** list, click **Enable** to enable the selected profiles.
- A confirmation dialog box appears. Click the **OK** button.
  The selected profiles are enabled.

# 5. Manage Products


## To Manage the Products,

- 3. The menu appears as shown below:




4. Click on Manage Products.

The **Manage Products** page appears as shown:




# To Edit a Product,

- 2. If the product is uploaded successfully, then the success message appears on the top of the page. If there is an error, then the error message appears on the top of the page.


#### **Submit Bulk Actions On Products**

- 1. On the Product Listing page, click on the **Actions** list.
- 2. To validate the products, select the products you want to validate and click on Validate Products.

4. To update the inventory, select the products and click on **Update Inventory**.




The inventory will be updated.

# 6. View Rakuten Orders


#### To View Rakuten Orders.

#### 4. Click View Rakuten Orders.


The Orders Page appears as shown below:

1. To cancel the orders, click on Cancel Order under the Actions list.




The selected orders will be canceled.

2. To sync the status of the orders, click on Sync Order Status in the Actions list.




The selected orders status will be synced.

4. To delete the orders in bulk, click on **Delete Order(s)**.




The selected orders will be deleted.

# 7. Failed Imported orders


## To View Failed Imported Orders,

4. Click on Failed Imported Orders.


The **Failed Orders** page open as shown:

# 8. API Feeds


#### To View API Feeds,




