

# **Wayfair Integration for Magento 2 User Guide**

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## 1. Overview

Wayfair is an American marketplace where you can find the ultimate collection of furniture, Kitchen and Tabletop, Kid's furniture, playroom, Bed and Bath, and so on. It was founded in 2002 and offers 14 million items from more than 11,000 global suppliers.

Wayfair Integration for Magento 2 helps the Magento 2 store owners to synchronize inventory, price, and other product details for the product creation and its management between the Magento 2 store and the Wayfair website. It has a feature that enables you to smoothly create the Wayfair Categories and its dependent attributes on the Magento store.

### Key Features:

- **Shipment Automation:** You can automate the shipment process with various services like Shipstation, Shipwork, Stamps.com, Linnworks, Xtento, ShipRush.
- **Synchronized Inventory:** Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and the listing of the products along with all the details is established between Magento 2 and Wayfair.
- **Creation of Magento Orders:** The newly placed orders on Wayfair are automatically created in the Magento 2 store with all the required details as it is on the Wayfair marketplace.

## 2. Extension Installation

### To install the extension,

1. Upload and unzip the Wayfair.zip file inside the magento\_root Directory. (Directory structure should be [app/code/Ced/Wayfair](#))
2. Check the Ced directory permission(it should be 755).

#### For Wayfair SDK-

Map the SDK with Magento root composer.json file in autoload psr-4 section.

`"Ced\\Wayfair\\Sdk\\": "vendor/cedcoss/wayfair/sdk/lib/wayfair/src"`

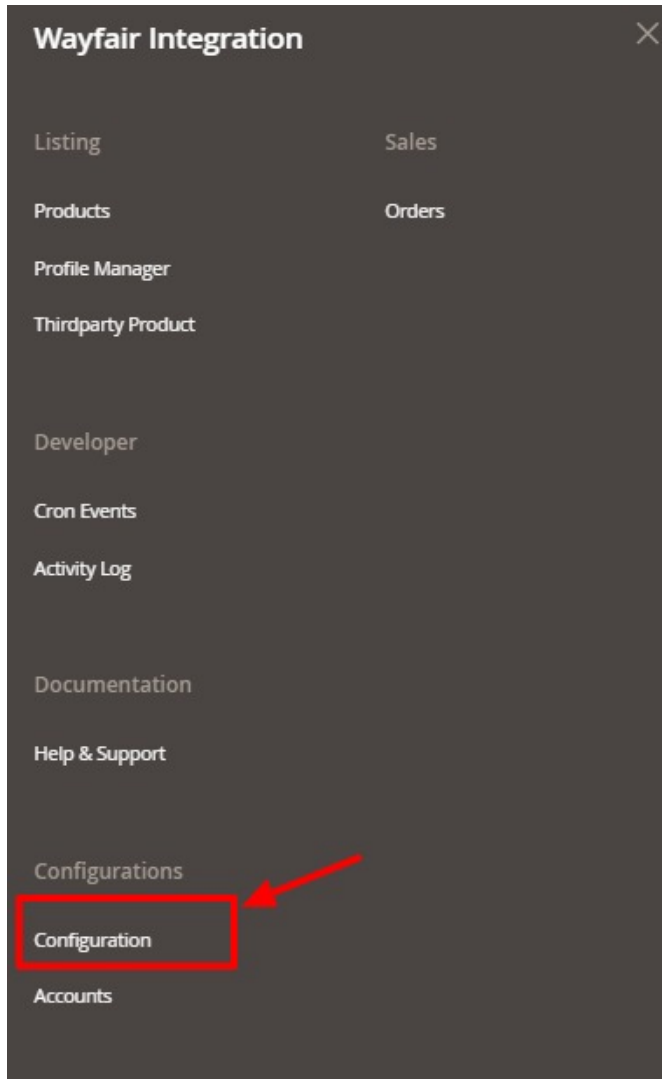
3. Run the Installation commands-

```
composer dump
php -dmemory_limit=5G bin/magento setup:upgrade
php -dmemory_limit=5G bin/magento setup:di:compile
php -dmemory_limit=5G bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f
php bin/magento index:reindex
php -dmemory_limit=5G bin/magento cache:clean
php -dmemory_limit=5G bin/magento cache:flush
```

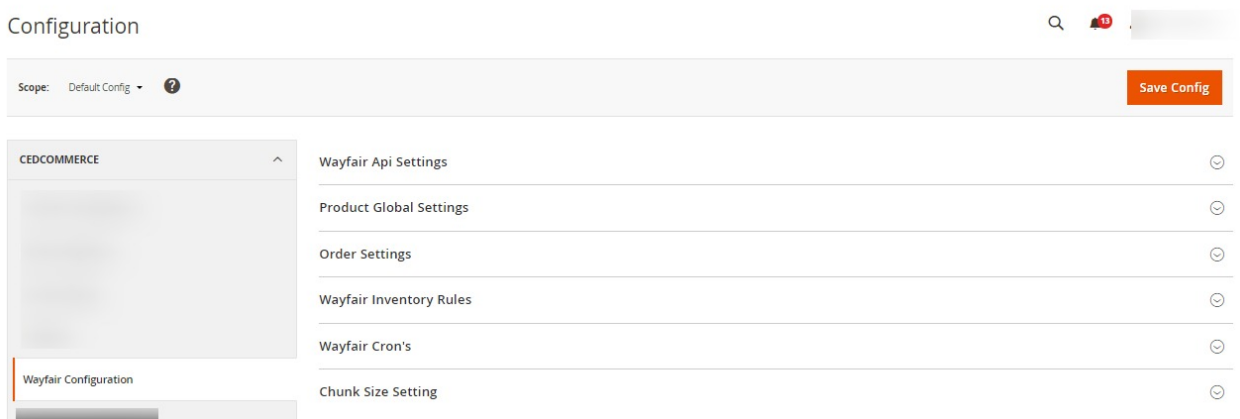
## 3. Configuration

### To configure the extension,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Wayfair Integration** menu.  
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



3. Click on **Configuration**.  
The **Configuration** page appears as shown in the following figure:



4. In the right panel, click on **Wayfair API Settings**, and the section expands as:

- In the **Enabled** list, select **Yes** to enable the extension features.
  - In the **Debug Log** list, select **Yes** to start Wayfair Integration in the debug mode.
5. In the right panel, click on **Product Global Settings**, and the section expands as:

Select to send a different product price to **wayfair.com**

- In the **Wayfair Product Price** list, select one of the following options:
    - **Increase by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
    - **Increase by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears. Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the Wayfair, product price by the entered value % of Magento price  
**For Example,**  
 Magento price + 5% of Magento price.  
 Magento Price = 100  
 Select Increase By Fixed Percentage option  
 Enter Percentage = 5  
 $100 + 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 + 5 = 105$   
 Thus, Wayfair Product Price = 105
    - **Decrease by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
    - **Decrease by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears.  
 Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Wayfair product price by the entered value % of Magento price.  
**For Example,**  
 Magento price – 5% of Magento price.  
 Magento Price = 100  
 Select Decrease By Fixed Percentage option  
 Enter Percentage = 5  
 $100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$   
 Thus, Wayfair Product Price = 95
6. In the right panel, click on **Order Settings**, and the section expands as:

**Customer Email** [global]

Enter the Email for which customer will be created for Wayfair Orders.

- In the **Create Product** field, select **Yes** if you want to create a product if it does not exist in Magento and yet has been ordered on Wayfair.
- In the **Wayfair Order Id Prefix** box, enter the text as a prefix for Wayfair Increment ID.
- In the **Customer Email** field, enter the email for which customer will be created for Wayfair Orders.

7. In the right panel, click on **Wayfair Inventory Rules**, and the section expands as:

## Wayfair Inventory Rules



**Set Inventory on Basis of Threshold** [global]

Choose yes to send inventory on wayfair by condition

**Inventory Threshold Value** [global]

Set inventory quantity on which lesser and greater condition can control.

**Send Inventory for Lesser Than Threshold Case** [global]

Send Quantity to Wayfair for those products, whose inventory is LESSER than the inventory threshold.

**Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case** [global]

Send Quantity to Wayfair for those products, whose inventory is GREATER than the inventory threshold.

- In the **Set Inventory on Basis of Threshold** list, select **Enable** to send the inventory based on the threshold.
- In the **Inventory Threshold Value** box, enter the required value.
- In the **Send Inventory for Lesser Than Threshold Case** box, enter the required value.
- In the **Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case** box, enter the required value.

8. In the right panel, click on **Wayfair Cron's**, and the section expands as:

- In the **Order Cron** list, select **Enable** to enable the order fetch cron.
- In **Inventory/Price Cron**, select **Yes** to synchronize inventory and price through crons.

9. In the right panel, click on **Chunk Size Setting**, and the section expands as:

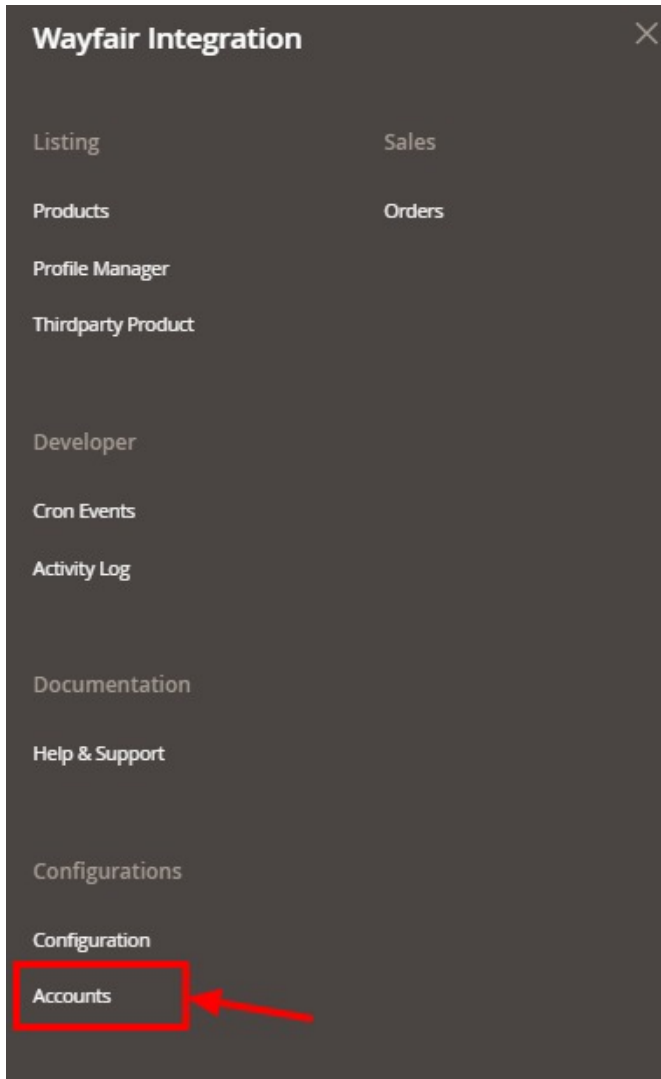

- In the **Validation Size** field, enter the chunk size for the products. The products that will get validated before being uploaded on Wayfair would be the same as the number you enter in this field.
  - In the **Upload** field, enter the number of products that you want to upload in one go from Magento to Wayfair.
  - In **Inventory/Price Update**, enter the chunk size for inventory and price.
  - In the **Sync Status** field, enter the chunk size of the products. The number of products that you will be able to sync the status for would be the same as the number that you enter in this field.
10. Click on the **Save Config** button.  
The configuration settings will be saved.

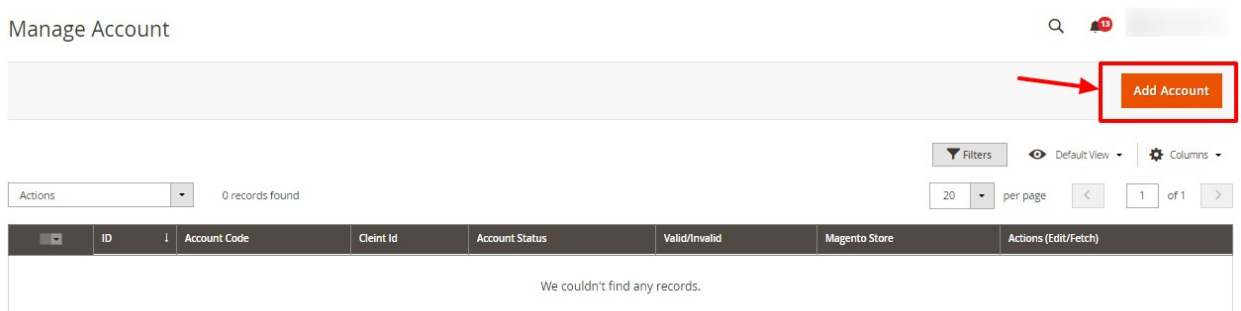
## 4. Account Settings

### To manage accounts on Wayfair,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Wayfair Integration** menu.  
The menu appears as shown in the following figure:

6. Under **Wayfair Account Information**, do the following steps:
- In **Client Id**, enter the client id from the seller panel of Wayfair.
  - In **Client Secret**, enter the secret key from the seller panel.
  - In **Supplier id**, enter the id of the supplier from the seller panel.
  - In **Dray Run**, select **Enable** if you want your account to run in test mode.
  - In **Token**, the token will be automatically fetched once the account is created.
7. Click on the **Save** button.  
The new account will be created.

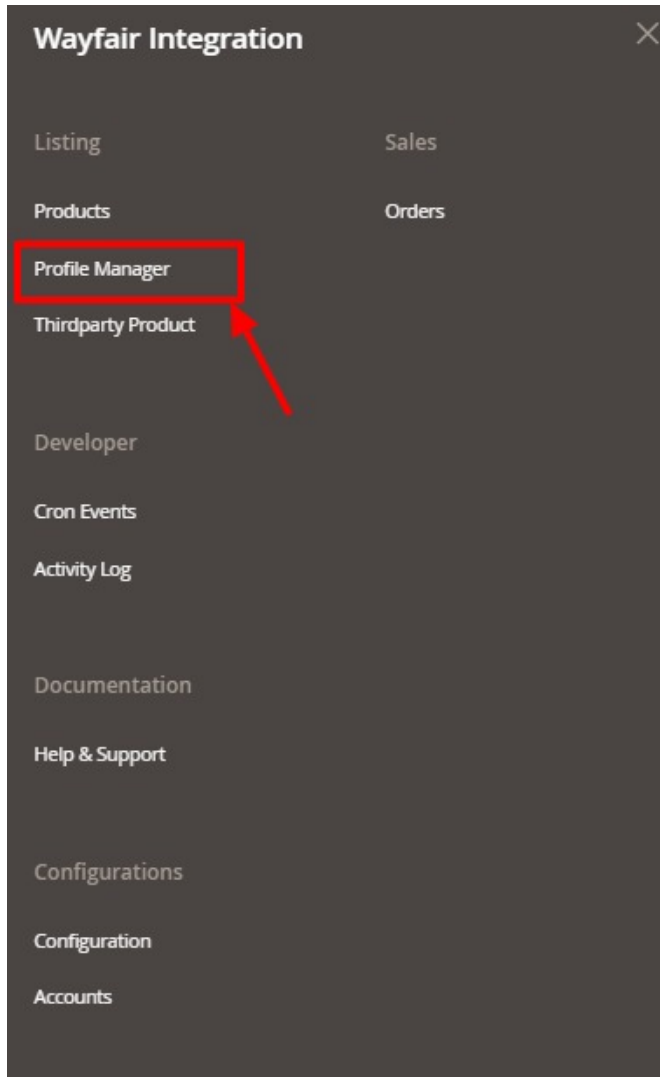

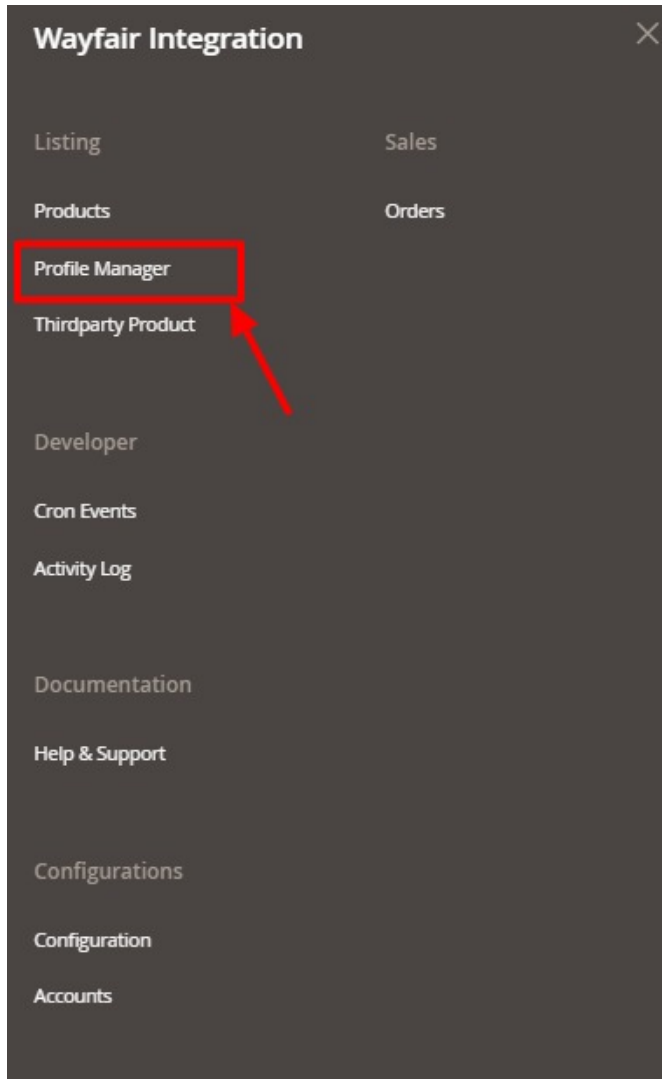

## 5.2. Edit a Profile

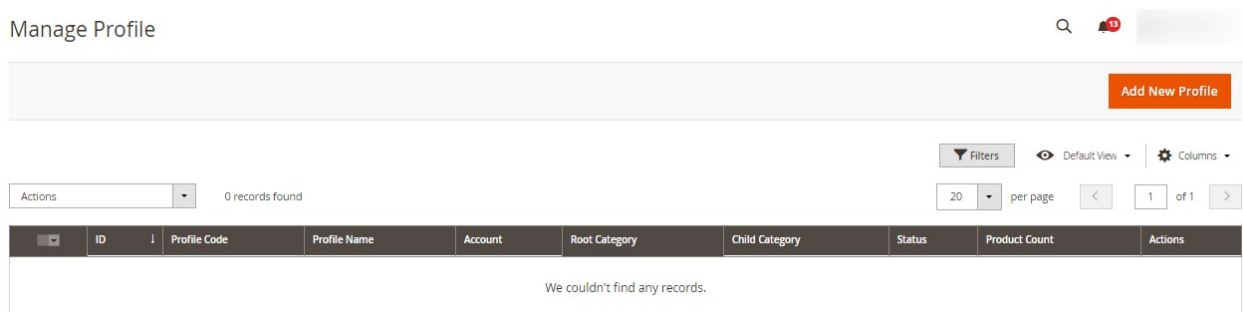
### To edit a profile,

6. Make the changes as per the requirement.

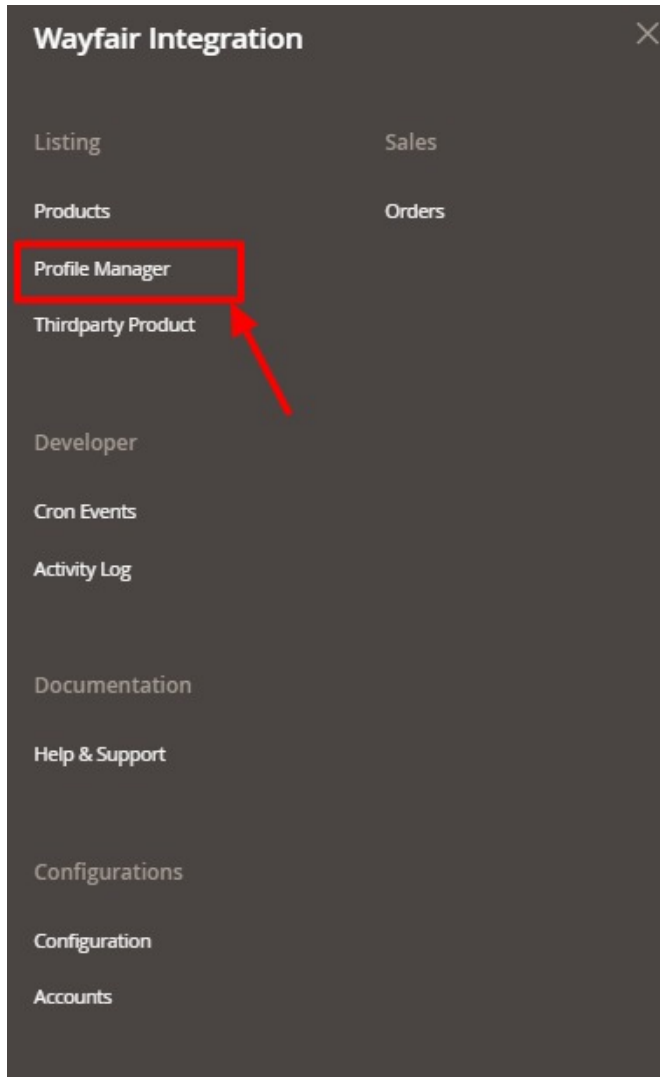
7. Click the **Save Profile** button.

The menu appears as shown in the following figure:



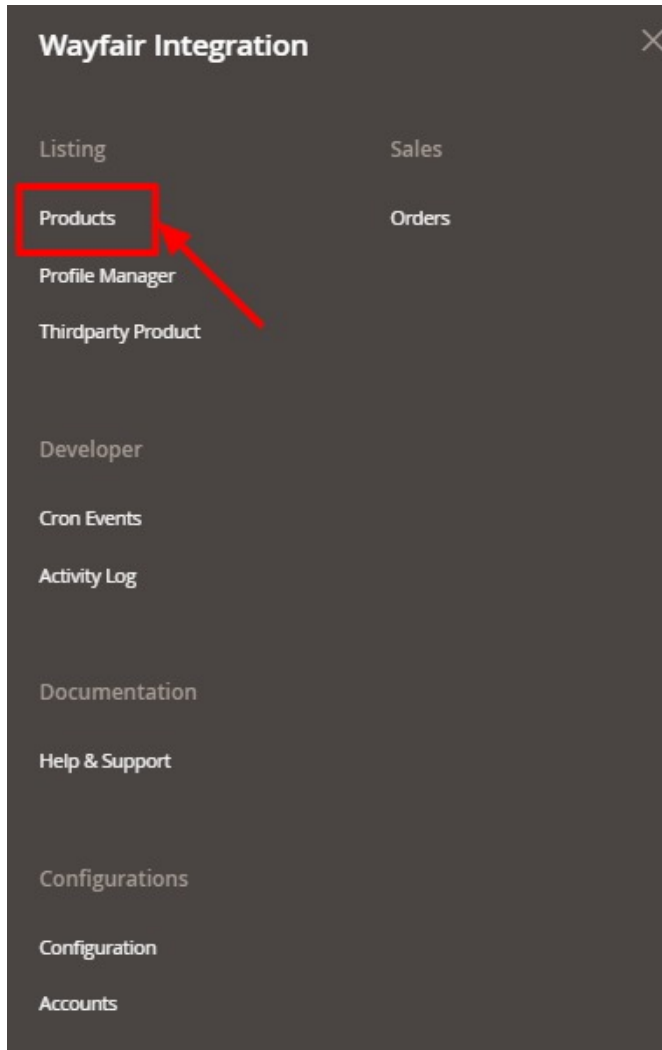
3. Click **Profile Manager**.

## 6. Manage Products

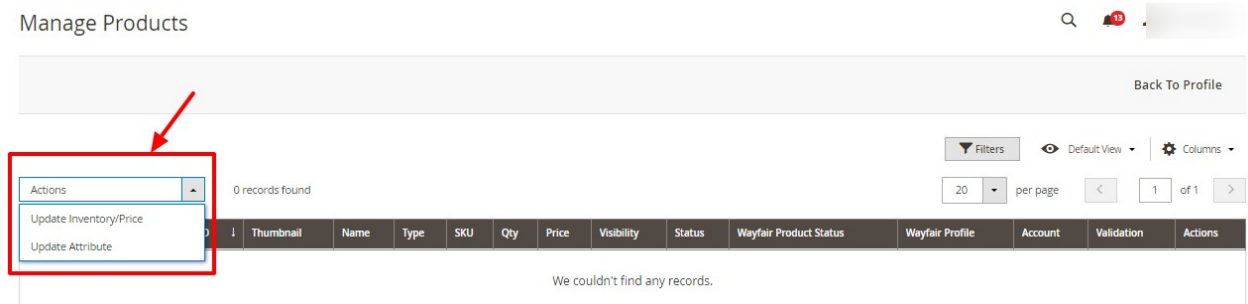
To manage Wayfair products,

5. For updating the attributes of the products, click on **Update Attributes** under the **Actions** field.

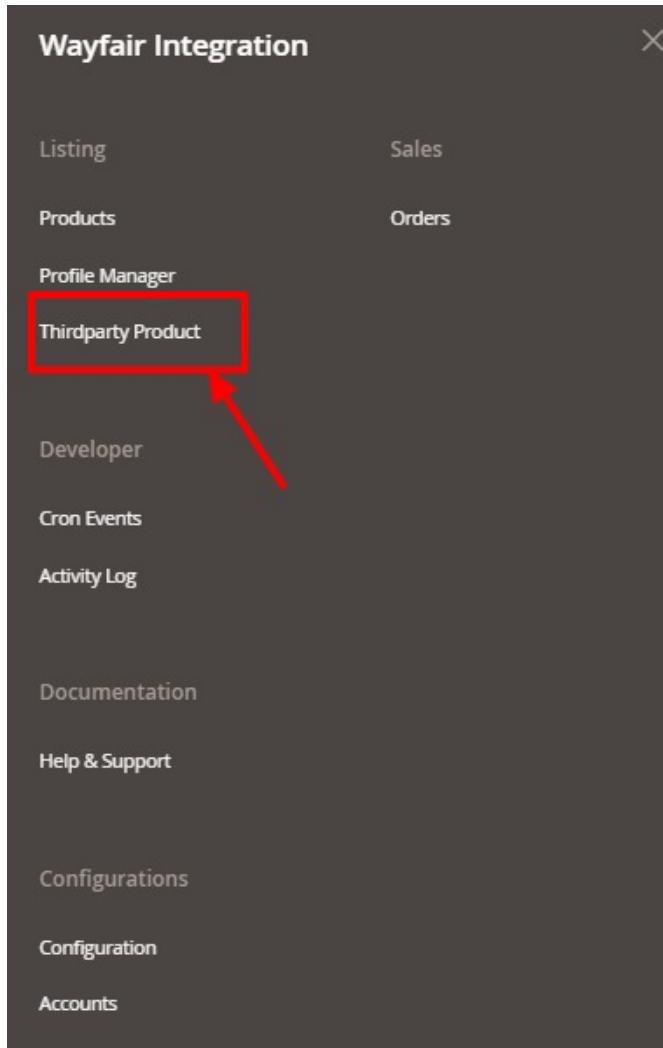

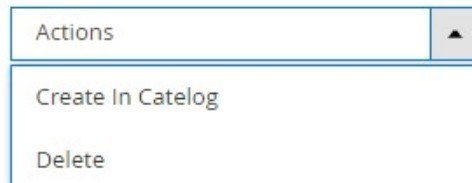

1. On the third party product listing page, click on **Actions** list.

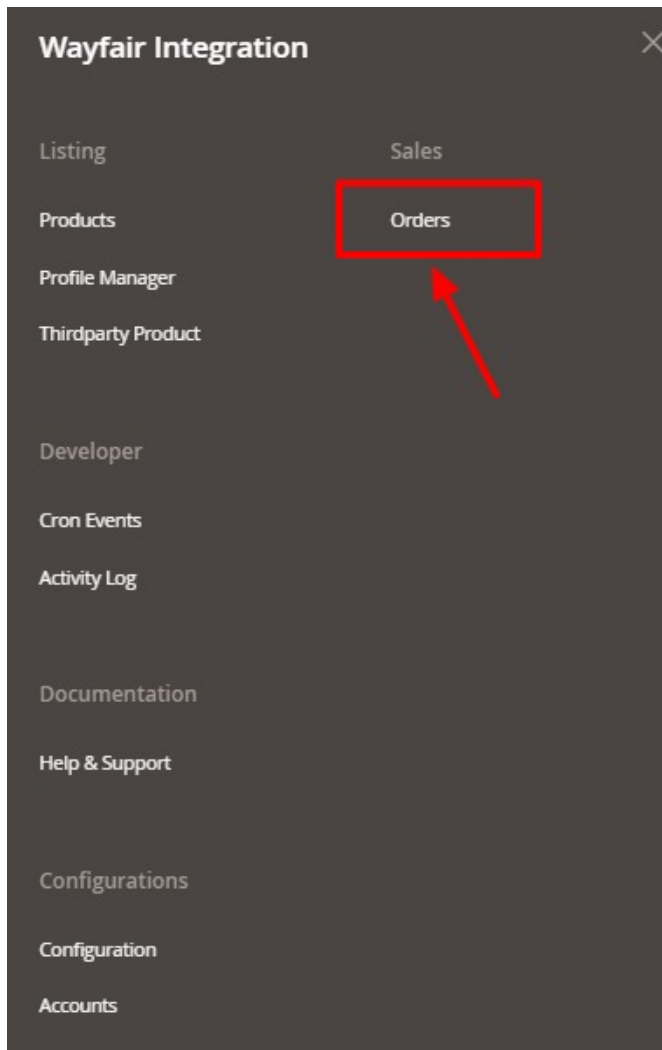


2. For creating the products in Catalog, click on **Create in Catalog** under the Actions list. The selected products will be created in the catalog.

1. Click on **Delete** under the **Actions** list.

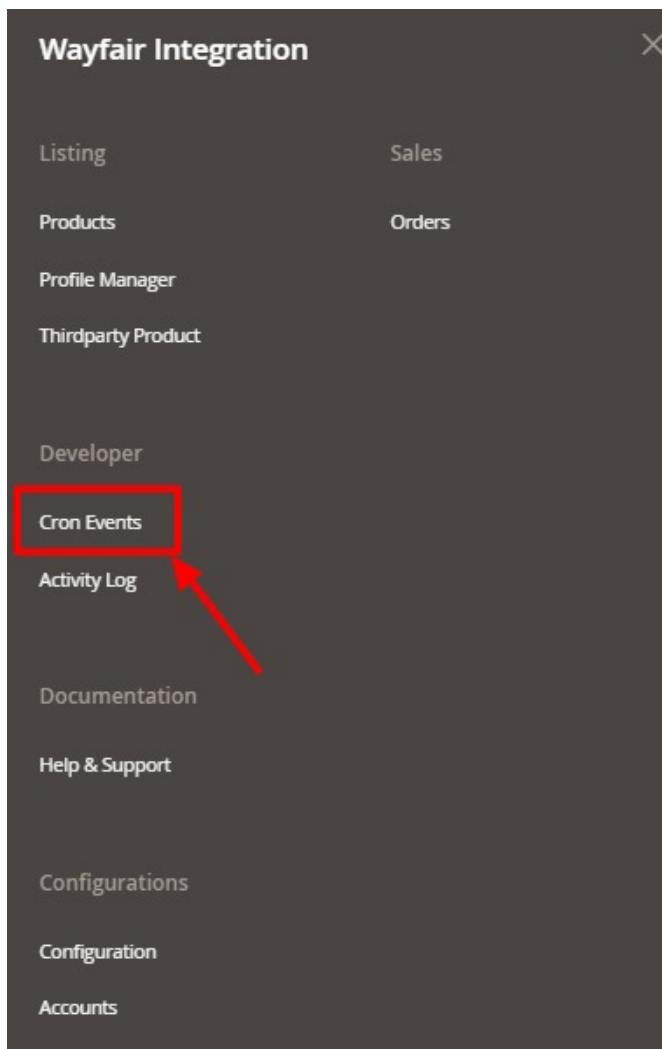


2. The selected orders will be deleted.



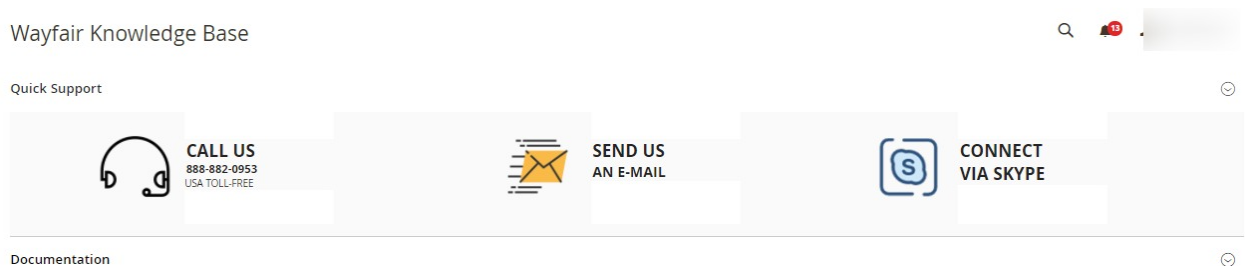
