

Zalando Integration for Magento 2 User Guide

by CedCommerce Products Documentation

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1. Overview

Zalando is a European e-commerce company based in Berlin, Germany founded in 2008. This eCommerce company offers fashion and lifestyle products to customers in 17 European markets. Zalando marketplace was earlier famous for selling footwear. At the end of December 2012, Zalando opened its first, custom-designed logistics centre in Erfurt referred to as “Europe’s largest wardrobe” because of its sheer size (120,000 square metres).

Zalando integration for Magento 2 is a tool that integrates Zalando seller panel with Magento 2 store for an automated selling experience. This extension helps sellers to list products on Zalando Marketplace easily. You can also easily manage products, price, inventory and automate orders between your Magento 2 store and Zalando Marketplace.

Key Features

- **Bulk Product Upload:** You have the flexibility to upload products in bulk on Zalando marketplace.
- **Automatic Synchronisation:** The extension facilitates inventory, price, orders and other details synchronization between Magento 2 store and Zalando Marketplace at regular intervals of time.
- **Manage Multiple Accounts:** You can easily integrate your multiple Zalando accounts with a single Magento 2 store.
- **Simple & Configurable Products Upload:** You can upload both simple and configurable type of products on the Zalando marketplace.
- **Rejected Order Notification:** If a product gets rejected on Zalando, its information is automatically fetched and listed on Magento 2 admin panel.

2. Extension Installation

To install the extension,

- Log in the FTP, and then go to Magento 2 root folder (generally present under the public_html folder).
- Create a new folder named `code` under the `app` folder; under the `code` folder, create a folder named `Ced`.
- Upload or Drag and Drop `app/code/Ced/Zalando` directory.
- After successfully uploading the directory, the extension will be installed/upgraded.
- Now run the following upgrade command in cmd- `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
`php bin/magento setup:di:compile`
`php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f`
`php bin/magento index:reindex`
`php bin/magento cache:flush`


3. Retrieving API Credentials

To Retrieve API Credentials,


Note: The process explained below is for merchants who do not have any app created but if you already have an existing app then it can be skipped.

1. For app creation, you can ask your seller panel admin, who has complete access to the seller panel, to open this URL <https://zdirect.zalando.com/technical-integration/partners>(<https://zdirect.zalando.com/technical-integration/partners>)

You will be redirected to the page as shown below:




2. The **Add Technical Partner** page will appear as shown below:




3. Select the existing technical partner. (It is compulsory to choose the existing partner.)
4. Then in **Technical Partner Details**, enter the Account Id provided to you.
Account Id- *e42da3f4-d882-4284-a232-08898bedeb35*

Note-This Account Id will be provided by us to you. If the ID will be correct then the Green tick will be shown as verified.

5. In Technical Partner, the technical partner account will be fetched automatically.
6. Now the second step of the merchant's section will appear as shown below:



7. Select the merchants your Technical partner can access and give the access permission.
8. Then click on the **Summary** button on the right side at the bottom. The summary page appears as shown:




9. The summary of all the information entered will be displayed as shown above.


To configure the extension,

 - In the **Debug Log** list, select **Yes** to start Zalando Integration in the debug mode.
 - In the **Select Store**, select the store view.
6. Scroll down and click on **Product Global Settings**; the section is expanded as:

7. Under **Product Global Settings**, do the following steps:
 - In **Send Product Image**, the parent/child/both images will be sent to Zalando.
 - In **Product Price Multi Attribute**, if you want to send each sales channels price with different attributes.
 - In the **Zalando Product Price** list, select one of the following options:
 - **Increase by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
 - **Increase by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears. Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the Zalando, product price by the entered value % of Magento price
For Example,
 Magento price + 5% of Magento price.
 Magento Price = 100
 Select Increase By Fixed Percentage option
 Enter Percentage = 5
 100 + 5% of 100 = 100 + 5 = 105
 Thus, Zalando Product Price = 105
 - **Decrease by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
 - **Decrease by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field

appears.

Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Zalando product price by the entered value % of Magento price.

For Example,

Magento price – 5% of Magento price.

Magento Price = 100

Select Decrease By Fixed Percentage option

Enter Percentage = 5

$100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$

Thus, Zalando Product Price = 95

- In **Shipping Settings**, map the Zalando shipment setting along with the Magento attribute code.

8. Now scroll down and click on **Order Settings**, the section is expanded as:

9. Under **Order Settings**, do the following steps:

- In the **Create Product** field, select **Yes** if you want to create a product if it does not exist in Magento and yet has been ordered on Zalando.
- In the **Zalando Order Id Prefix** box, enter the text as a prefix for Zalando Increment ID.
- In the **Customer Email** field, enter the email for which customer will be created for Zalando Orders.

10. Scroll down and click on **Zalando Inventory Rules**; the section is expanded as:

11. Under **Zalando Inventory Rules**, do the following steps:

- In the **Set Inventory on Basis of Threshold** list, select **Enable** to send the inventory based on the threshold.
- In the **Inventory Threshold Value** box, enter the required value.
- In the **Send Inventory for Lesser Than Threshold Case** box, enter the required value.
- In the **Send Inventory for Greater Than Threshold Case** box, enter the required value.

12. Scroll down and click on **Zalando Cron's**, the section is expanded as:

- Under **Zalando Cron**, do the following steps;
 - In the **Order Cron** list, select **Enable** to enable the order fetch cron.
 - In **Price Cron**, select **Enable** to sync the price through cron.
 - In **Inventory Cron**, select **Enable** to sync the inventory.
 - In **Shipment Cron**, select **Enable** to generate the shipments automatically.
- Scroll down and click on **Chunk Size Setting**, the section is expanded as:



- Under **Chunk Size Setting**, do the following steps:
 - In the **Validation Size** field, enter the chunk size for the products. The products that will get validated before being uploaded on Zalando would be the same as the number you enter in this field.
 - In the **Upload field**, enter the number of products that you want to upload in one go from Magento to Zalando.
 - In **Inventory Update**, enter the chunk size for inventory to be updated.
 - In **Price Update**, enter the chunk size for the price.
 - In the **Sync Status** field, enter the chunk size of the products. The number of products that you will be able to sync the status for would be the same as the number that you enter in this field.
- Click on the **Save Config** button.
The configuration settings will be saved.


5. Account Settings

To manage the accounts in the extension,

1. Go to the **Magento 2 Admin** panel.
2. On the left navigation bar, click the **Zalando Integration** menu.




5. Under **Account Information**, do the following steps:
- In **Account Code**, enter a unique code for your account.
 - In **Client Id**, enter the Client Id from the Zalando seller panel.
 - In **Secret Key**, enter the secret key from the Zalando Seller panel.
 - In **Account Type**, select the type of account.
 - In **Valid/Invalid**, the seller details status entered by you will be shown that it is valid or not.
 - In **Account Status**, select **Enable** to enable the status of the account.
 - In **Account Store**, select the store view.
 - In the **Access Token**, the token will be fetched automatically once the account is validated.
 - In **Sales Channels and Country** select the country from the list.
6. Click on the **Save** button.
The New Account will be created and displayed in the manage orders grid.

To Edit an Account.

1. On the **Zalando Accounts page**, click the **edit** button for the account that you want to edit, as shown in the image below:



2. The **Edit Account page** will appear as:




3. Make the changes as per requirement in the respective section.












5. To upload a product, click on the **Upload** icon under the **Actions** column.

1. In the **Actions** list, click the arrow button. A list appears as shown in the figure:




2. Select the checkboxes associated with the required products.

7. To update the price, click on **Update Price**. The price for selected products will be updated.








2. To synchronise the order status, click on **Sync Order Status**.

4. To delete the orders, click on **Delete**.









7. To delete the outlines, click on **Truncate** button. The selected outlines will be deleted.




