1. Overview

****Note: The term 'Etsy' is a trademark of Etsy, Inc. This application uses the Etsy API but is not endorsed or certified by Etsy, Inc.**

Etsy Integration for Magento 2 at CedCommerce involves the integration of the Magento® 2 store with the Etsy marketplace.

The **Etsy Integration for Magento 2** extension helps the store owner to synchronize the product listing between the **Magento 2** store and the Etsy retailers. The **Magento 2** store owner can also manage the Etsy orders on the **Magento 2** stores without making any significant changes in the operational functionalities.

The **Magento 2** store owner has an ability to synchronize the orders, products, pricing, and inventory through establishing the interaction between the Etsy API and the **Magento 2** store. One of the most important features is that it enables the merchant to create the Etsy Categories and its dependent attributes on the **Magento 2** store. Thus, it helps to configure the desired product category to the **Magento 2** store for automatic submission of the selected product to the same category on Etsy marketplace.

Key Features are as follows:

- **Product Upload Based on Profile:** Enables the admin to create a profile based on a single category, and then assign the products to the profile to automate the product upload.
- **Synchronized Inventory:** Auto synchronization of the inventory at regular intervals and the listing of the products along with all the details are established between Magento 2 and Etsy.com.
- **Product Category Mapping:** Follows many-to-one category mapping philosophy. Admin can map many categories of the Magento store to the single category of Etsy.
- **Bulk Upload System:** The merchant has the flexibility to upload any number of products on Etsy.com using the bulk product upload feature.
- **Creation of Magento Orders:** The newly placed orders on Etsy.com are automatically created in the Magento store with all the required details as it is on Etsy.com.
- **New Order Notification:** A notification is sent to the admin if an order is placed on Etsy marketplace for the product after it gets fetched from Etsy to Magento 2.
- **Shipment Automation:** Admin can automate the shipment process with Shipstation, Shipwork, Stamps.com, Linnworks, Xtento, ShipRush.

2. Extension Installation

To install the extension

1. Log in the **FTP**, and then go to Magento 2 root folder (generally present under the [public_html](#) folder).
2. Create a new folder named [code](#) under the [app](#) folder; under [code](#) folder, create a folder named [Ced](#).
 - Upload or Drag and Drop [app/code/Ced/Etsy](#) and [app/code/Ced/Integrator](#)
 - Add The SDK Lib in vendor Directory : [<magento-root>/vendor/cedcommerce/etsy-php](#)
 - Update composer.json File By Adding The code Written Below Under Autoload PSR-4 Section-
[Etsy\](#): "[vendor/cedcommerce/etsy-php/src/Etsy/](#)
3. After successfully uploading the contents into the directory and performing the above steps, run the following upgrade command in cmd
[composer dump](#)


3. Get Etsy Credentials

The merchant has to first create a seller account in the Etsy seller panel. Once the seller account is created and is approved by Etsy, the store owner has to retrieve the API Credentials. The merchant has to enter these **API Key details** on the **Etsy Developers** page.


1. Go to the <https://www.etsy.com/developers>(<https://www.etsy.com/developers>) link.




2. Enter your Username and password to sign up for your Etsy account.




4. Configuration Settings



 - d. In the **Shipment Method for Etsy Orders** box, select the shipment method for Etsy order.
 - e. In the **Payment Method of Etsy Order** box, select the payment method for Etsy order.
 - f. In the **Create Real Customer** box, select the **Yes** option, to create a real customer of Etsy.

 - c. In the **Auto Inventory/Price Sync** box, select the **Yes** option, to auto-update inventory or price on Etsy while product edit.
 - d. In **Auto Import Etsy Reviews**, select **Yes** to import the reviews automatically otherwise select **No**.
- Click the **Save Config** button.
The configuration settings are saved.

5. Manage Etsy Profiles

Admin can create a new profile and assign the required products to the profile. While creating and editing the profile, admin can map the Magento 2 attributes to the Etsy attributes. These attributes are applicable to all the products that are assigned to the profile.











4. In **Return Policy Id**, the id will be mentioned for a particular product for which the return request had been sent.
5. **Accept Returns**, specifies that the seller accepts return in case damaged, defective or products that fail to match the product descriptions.
6. **Accept Exchanges**, specifies that the sellers are accepting exchanges if the product is not tampered with, defective or broken.
7. **Return deadline** is the designated time period for sending the product back to the sellers.


