## 1. Overview

Pinterest Integration for Magento 2 is an innovative tool. This solution helps sellers connect their Magento store with Pinterest business accounts and share products with millions of audiences. Pinterest doesn't support any purchase or sales processes so this Integration solution takes customers directly to sellers' Magento store and facilitates easy checkout.

### Key Features-

- **Multi Account Section:** This extension enables you to create multiple Pinterest accounts and manage all of them through a single platform.
- **Bulk Products Upload:** You can upload any number of products from Magento 2 store to the Pinterest account in bulk saving your time.
- **Automate Inventory Status Update:** The inventory status is automatically updated at regular intervals of time.
- **Redirecting at Checkout:** You can manage all the payments and shipments through your Magento store.

## 2. Extension Installation

### Key To install the extension,

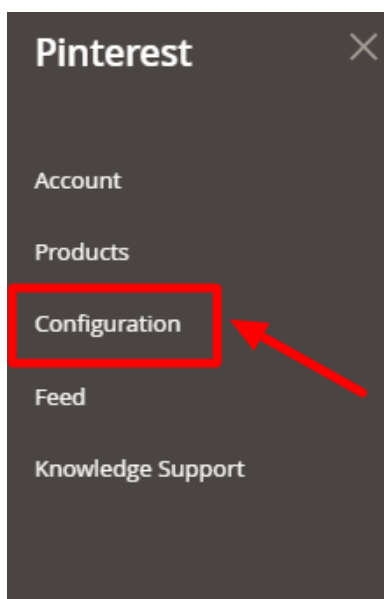
- Upload and Extract the **Pintrest.zip & Integrator.zip** file inside the [magento\\_root/app/code/Ced/](#) Directory.
- Run the below command from magento root directory.  

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade  
php bin/magento setup:di:compile  
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f  
php bin/magento index:reindex  
php bin/magento cache:clean  
php bin/magento cache:flush
```

## 3. Configuration Settings

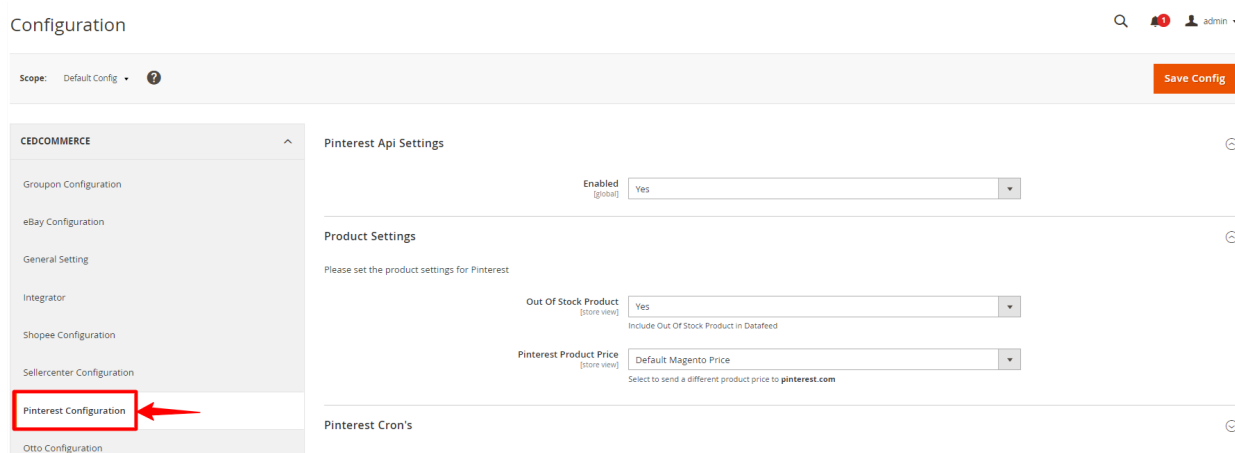
### To configure the extension settings,

1. Go to the **Magneto Admin Panel**.
2. On the navigation bar, click on **Pinterest**.  
The menu appears as shown below:



3. Click on **Configuration**.

The **Configuration Settings** page appears as shown below:



4. Under the **Pinterest API Settings**, in the right panel under Pinterest API settings do the following settings:
- In the Enabled List select **YES**. **Note: NO** option hides all the relevant fields that will appear under Pinterest API Settings. The **Pinterest Integration** menu does not appear in the left navigation bar.



5. Click on **Product Settings**, the section is expanded as shown below:

Pinterest Product Price [store view]  Select to send a different product price to [pinterest.com](https://pinterest.com)

Modify by Fix Price [store view]

6. Under **Product Settings** do the following steps:

- In **Out Of Stock Product**, select **Yes** if you want to add the out of stock products in the data feed.
- In the **Pinterest Product Price** list select one of the following options:
  - Select the **Default Magento Price**, if you want to keep the price the same on Pinterest as Magento.
  - **Increase by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
  - **Increase by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears.  
Enter the numeric value to increase the price of the Pinterest product by the entered value % of Magento 2 price.  
**For Example,**  
Magento 2 price + 5% of Magento 2 price.  
Magento 2 Price = 100  
Select the Increase By Fixed Percentage option  
Modify by Percentage Price = 5  
 $100 + 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 + 5 = 105$   
Thus, Pinterest Product Price = 105
  - **Decrease by Fixed Price:** If selected, then the Modify by Fix Price field appears.
  - **Decrease by Fixed Percentage:** If selected, then the Modify by Percentage Price field appears.  
Enter the numeric value to decrease the price of the Pinterest product price by the entered value % of Magento 2 price  
**For Example,**  
Magento 2 price – 5% of Magento 2 price.  
Magento 2 Price = 100  
Select the Decrease By Fixed Percentage option  
Modify by Fix Price = 5  
 $100 - 5\% \text{ of } 100 = 100 - 5 = 95$   
Thus, Pinterest Product Price = 95
- In **Modify by Fix Price**, enter the required price.
- In **Modify by Percentage Price**, enter the numeric value Required for adding/subtracting % on Magento price.

7. Click on **Pinterest Cron's**, the section is expanded as shown below:

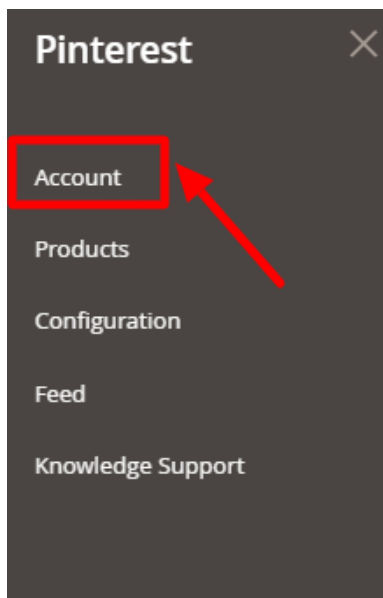

8. Under **Pinterest Cron's** do the following steps:
  - In the **Product Cron**, select **Enable** if you want to automatically fetch products at regular intervals of time.
9. Click on the **Save Config** button.  
The selected configuration settings will be saved.

## 4. Account Settings

To manage accounts,

1. Go to the **Magento Admin Panel**.
2. On the navigation bar, click on **Pinterest**.  
The menu appears as shown below:



3. Click on **Account**.  
The **Manage Account** Page appears as shown below:

4. To add a new account, click on **Add Account**.

5. In the right panel, under **Account Information**, do the following steps:
  - In the **Shop Page Name** box, enter a shop page name.
 

**Note:** Please use only letters (a-z), numbers (0-9), or underscore(\_) in this field, the first character should be a letter.
  - In the **Account Status** box, select **Enabled** to enable the status of the shop.
  - In the **Account Store** tab, select enable the store view.
6. Once you successfully create an account it gets listed on the accounts page.
7. To edit an account, click on the **Edit** option under the **Actions** column.

2. On the **Manage Accounts page**, under the **Actions** list, click on **Delete**.

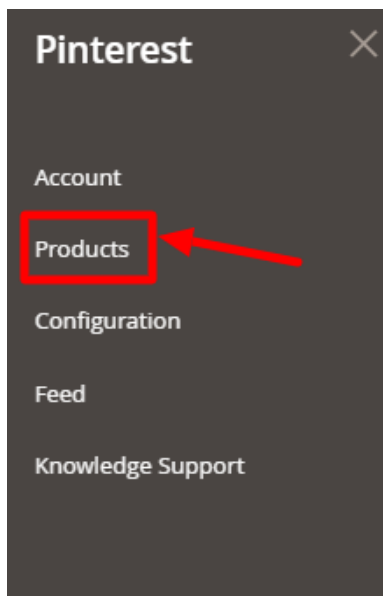


3. The selected Accounts will be deleted.

## 5. Manage Products

To manage product listings,

1. Go to the **Magento Admin Panel**.
2. On the navigation bar, click on **Pinterest**.  
The menu appears as shown below:



3. Click on **Actions**. Choose the products that you wish to include on Pinterest.  
Select **Include to Pinterest** from the drop down box. This feature enables you to select all the products through mass action from the product grid that you wish to send to your Pinterest marketplace. The following page opens up:

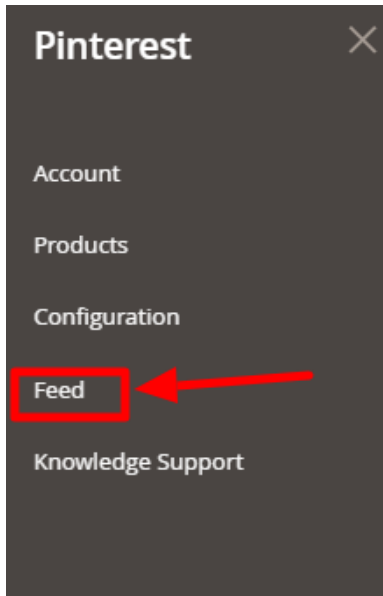

The menu appears as shown below:



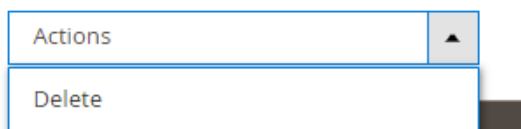
3. Click on **Feed**.

5. To delete the feed, mark all the desired feeds and click on **Delete** under the **Actions** list.

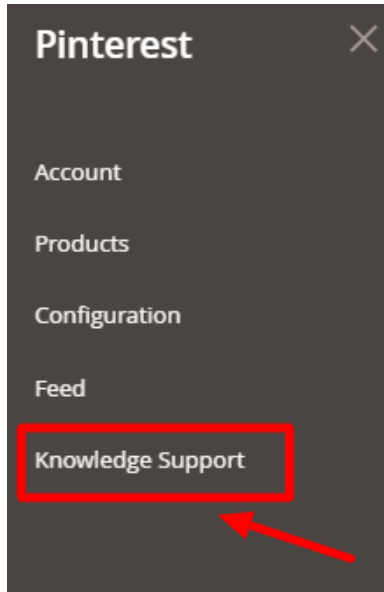


6. The selected feeds will be deleted.

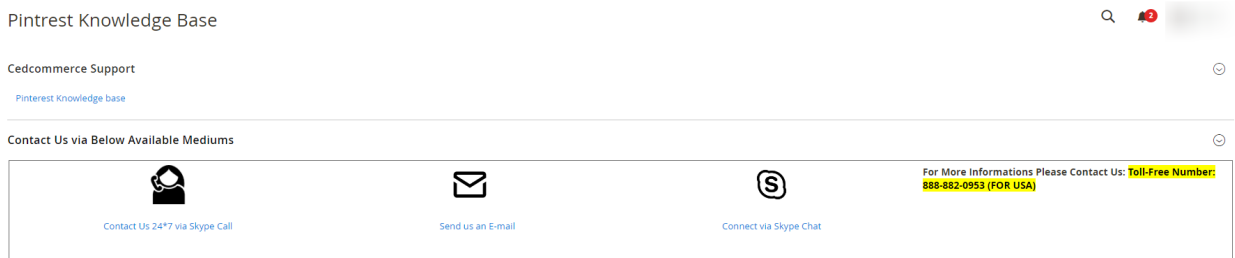
## 7. Knowledge Base
